Peter (Bergmann) B-ca 1726-Mansbach or Morsbach, Pfaltz, Germany. The son of Johannes Bergmann and Katherine Schott. Married Anna Ursella at Mansbach on Sept. 7, 1746. After 2nd Publications of Bann's. Archives Ziebrucken. Dr. Scheidt, archives Director. Came to the Colonies 1749 with wife and two children. Penn. German Folklore Soc. Vol. I. 1936.P.124 list of Emigrants, and from Ziebrucken Archives. Settled Fredrick Co. Maryland. Appears on Payroll Muster French and Indian Colonial Wars as Pvt. Peter Barrickman, in Capt. Moses Chaplin's Co. 1767. Liber 198. P. 279-80 Annapolis, Maryland, Hall of Records. Sold land "Barkman's choice" 1772. Recorded Land Record P. Folio 279. Land Rec. Fredrick Co. Md.

Purchased land, Westmoreland Co. Pa. First wife Anna Ursella, dec'd. 2d wife Elisabeth ANTIS signs Waiver of Dower rights as proof of 2nd marriage Purchased first land Sept. 10, 1771. Vol A P.316. Vol A P.353. Westmoreland Co. Pa. Sold land Oct. 9, 1784 prior to leaving Knox Co. Ind. Vol. A P.406. Also see Pa. Arch. 3rd Series Vol. 22 P.370. Vol 26 P.396. See Knox-Davies Co. Ind. County History-Goodspeed P.140-41. Proof of arrival and description of land Knox Co, Ind. for Peter and Elizabeth Barrickman.

Will of Peter Barrickman dated Sept. 8, 1791. In Probate and Circuit Court from Mar. 1812 until 1817 to clear and divide land for all living heirs.

Peter Barrickman served as a Patriot during Revolutionary War. (See annals of the Carnegie Museum Vol. 1 P.537. Pub. by authority of the Board of Trustees of the Carnegie Institute.) He lived on the Military Road to Ft. Dunsmore (Ft. Pitt) here he had a Ferry Service on the Monongahela River running parallel to the Dunsmore Military Road to Ft. Pitt. His ferry was used to ferry troops and supplies 1776-7. After 1785 Peter Barrickman had a river station on the De Shes, Knox Co. Ind.

Following are the Bible records of the son of Jacob Barreckman, also named Jacob Barrickman, of Kentucky to Indiana; the Bible Records of Henry Barkman-Barikman, a son of Peter Barrickman-Bergmann; the Bible records of John Barkman, a son of Peter Barrickman, and of Lambert Barekman, the great-grand-son of Peter Barrickman.

JACOB BARRICKMAN was born February 17, 1763 in the colony of Pennsylvania (or perhaps in Frederick county, Maryland). He was a son of Peter Bergman (Barrackman, Bargman) who had emigrated to the American colonies in 1749/5- from the Palatinate in Germany. Jacob's mother was Ursula, she passed away a few years after his birth. Jacob Barrickman grew up in the wilderness of frontier Maryland and Pennsylvania. The Conococheague Territory was one of the most untamed areas in the colonies and the scene of frequent Indian uprisings. At the time of the French and Indian War (in which Jacob's father was a soldier), the Indians rose up and scattered most of the settlers over into the wilds of Bedford and Westmoreland counties of Pennsylvania; Peter Barrackman and his growing family were among this group of displaced settlers. Jacob's father was a typical rough German-American pioneer. As young Jacob grew up, he probably spent many long hours tilling the soil with his brothers and helping his father run the ferry boat, which he operated near Fort Pitt.

Then the horror of war swept into the fertile valleys of Western Pennsylvania. Jacob Barrickman, at the tender age of seventeen years, helped the American colonial cause by enlisting in military service in the Revolution. He served with the near legendary, Capt. Jeremiah Lochrey from April to October of 1780, in the defense of the Pennsylvania frontiers. The battles in which the young man took part were bloody ones, and Jacob had to worry about the illusive Indian as well as the regiments of British troops.

Jacob Barrickman married Jane Swan, of Pennsylvania, March 24, 1784 at Newport, Kentucky. They were blessed with eleven children: Martha, Mary (Polly), Sarah, Jane, John, Jacob Jr., Keturah, Nancy, James T., William and Eliza May.

Jane Swan Barrickman was born March 1st, 1757. Her parents were Hugh and Martha (Benson) Swan. Her grandparents were Henry and Elizabeth (Bowen) Swan. Her great-great-grandparents were Colonel Charles and Sarah (Van Meter) Swan.

Jacob Barrickman and his family were still in Campbell County, Kentucky, in 1791, where he was referred to as "one of the chief men of Newport". They remained in the area of Campbell County, Kentucky, until 1812, when they moved to Franklin County, Indiana.

Frontier Indiana was also a wilderness. Almost as if he felt to the restlessness, "on the move" pioneer spirit which Frederick Johnson Turner wrote about, Jacob moved to the Hoosier state for "elbow room". He received two government land grants, one in 1811 and another in 1814. Jacob's father had also moved to Indiana, at an earlier time to the vicinity of Knox County.

Jacob could watch his many offspring and grandchildren grow and prosper in the new area around Fairfield township. His wife died May 29, 1833 and Jacob followed her on Feb. 23, 1842. He was buried on the Cory farm in Franklin County. He was a typical example which characterized our early America.
