PREFACE

Thomas Marion Murphree (1843-1914) organized the Pike County Confederate Soldiers Reunion Association in 1898 and served as its commander. A project of this association was the "Record of Confederate Soldiers from Pike County, Alabama, 1861-1865." This book which was written in long hand by Tom Murphree is on file in the Office of the Judge of Probate, Pike County, Alabama. It exists in a single copy and has been used extensively in the matter of pensions and in historical research.

The publication of these valuable records is a project of the Pike County Civil War Centennial Commission. The Pike County Boord of Commissioners composed of Probate Judge Ben Reeves, M. C. Carter, A. L. Boyd, S. E. Green and Norman Wilson voluntarily offered to provide funds for financing the publication of the Tom Murphree records.

The records are reproduced in this volume essentially as they were originally written. Spelling, punctuation and format duplicate the Murphree record with few exceptions. The Regiments have been rearranged numerically using W. Brewer's "Alabama 1540-1872" as a guide. Brewer's brief history of each regiment will be of interest to those who use these Pike County records.

Murphree listed the officers of each company first, followed by the list of privates whose names were arranged in "rough" alphabetical order; that is all the A's together, followed by all B's, etc. Companies that do not have this system of rough alphabetical order, have been rearranged to this order for the convenience of the reader.

It is fortunate that the one with interest enough to write the original copy of the record was blessed with excellent penmanship. Only two trouble spots exist in the interpretation of the records. It is difficult, at times, to distinguish between Murphree's capital "M" and his capital "W." Even with the aid of a powerful magnifying glass, one has finally to make the decision by guess. If a reader is searching for James M Smith and finds instead James W Smith, it is likely that we have guessed incorrectly. Another trouble spot lies in the base "a" and the base "u." Here, too, we have sometimes resorted to guessing whether a name is Harley or Hurley. It is impossible to attain any exact statistics from the Tom Murphree records but a summation is of interest. Murphree listed some 2963 names of men from Pike County who served in the Confederacy. Of these, he listed 2841 serving with Alabama units, 87 with Georgia groups and 35 with other states. Even making an allowance for duplications and other errors, it seems that at least 2650 Pike County men saw military service of some nature. This number seems reasonable in light of census returns which show Pike County's population for 1860 to have been 15,646 whites and 8,789 blacks. At this date, Bullock County and Crenshaw County were not in existence, and the population figures are for Pike County as it then existed. Murphree's records may include companies which were on soil which was later Bullock and Crenshaw.

A summary of casualties reported by Murphree shows a total of 816 deaths in the war. These fall into three categories: 392 "died in service," 357 more were "killed in battle" and 67 died in military prison. Of those who died in prison, 42 met their deaths at Camp Douglas, located near Chicago, which was infamous for its high mortality rate. During one month, one prisoner out of ten at Camp Douglas perished.

In instances of death in battle, the notation is often "killed in battle" with no place or date given. Others show an exact place of battle, and still others a date of battle which may suggest a location but it has not been assumed in this summary. The reader will note several errors in dates of battles — these have been reproduced exactly as Murphree gave them. He reported 30 casualties at Atlanta, 27 killed at Chickamauga, 19 Petersburg, 17 Franklin, 14 Island No. 10, 13 New Hope Church, 12 Port Hudson, 10 Murfreesboro and 10 Vicksburg. Many other battles are listed showing the wide range of service of men from Pike County.

Battles in the Civil War are often designated by more than one name. The battle which Murphree listed as "First Cold Harbor" is commonly considered part of the Seven Days Battle around Richmond. Many Pike County soldiers died at Haymarket, Virginia, where sick men were kept with no care except that given by convalescent soldiers. Measles was the great killer at Haymarket.

The original Tom Murphree records were written in ink with a penmanship which resembles professional engraving. Where the notation "died at home" occurs, it is written in pencil with penmanship which clearly reflects the increasing feebleness of the writer with the years as indicated by the date given. We must assume that "died at home" refers to a death after the war and, where no date is given, it is likely to have been after 1900.

The initials A. N. V. refer to the Army of Northern Virginia. This term was in general use after the close of the war as a means of designating whether an outfit belonged to the Western Army or the Virginia Army.

It will be noted that the term "resigned" is used only in connection with officers. Officers were permitted to resign on good excuse. The frequent use of the term "honorably discharged" is a real puzzler because that term was not in use in the Civil War. Although his use of an expression which was not then in official use is an enigma, his meaning is clear. A man might be discharged on account of wounds or disability and a good many South Alabamians were discharged in 1863 and 1864 on the excuse of having to go home and take care of the family.

We are indebted to Dr. Peter A. Brannon for his assistance with terms and with military organization. His knowledge is a great asset to the State of Alabama. His kindness and courtesy to us in this particular instance is greatly appreciated.

In our effort to reproduce the Tom Murphree records in toto and unchanged, we have kept personal comments to an absolute minimum. Where it was deemed necessary, for the sake of clarity, to insert an opinion of the one who has transcribed these records, I have clearly marked such statements with my initials.

The members of the Pike County Civil War Centennial Commission proudly present to you the war record of the men from our county.

Comrade Murphree did gallant service with the Sixth Alabama, at Seven Pines, First Cold Harbor, Malvern Hill, Boonesboro, Sharpsburg and Fredericksburg.

Early in February, 1863, by reason of his having been commissioned, he was transferred to the Army of Tennessee. From that period to close of the war, he served with that army. Mr. Murphree is a most enthusiastic veteran, and has compiled a record of all the soldiers from Pike County, Alabama, who served in the Confederate Army.
