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Sentence of Consecration of St Pauls Church in Worcester Parish, Worcester County, given agreeably to a Rubrick in the service for the Consecration of a Church or Chapel By the Rt Rev James Kemp Bishop of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Maryland to wit-

Whereas it has been represented to me by the Vestry of Worcester Parish, that under the protection of Almighty God, they have created a new Church in the Village of Berlin, and whereas I have been requested to consecrate the same to the worship of Almighty God: Be it therefore known, that in compliance with their request, on the 21st day of June in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Twenty Seven in the presence of the Rector, the Vestry and a large concourse of other persons, I have consecrated it agreeably to the established form of Consecration, thereby separating it henceforth from all unhallowed, or ordinary and common use; and setting it apart to the religious sevice which belongs to the worship of that great Being, who, although he has Heaven for his throne and earth for his footstool, has condescended to promise his especial presence with those who assemble in his name in acts of prayer and praise agreeable to the Gospel covenant. Witness my hand and seal the day and year above written
