



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

it therefore known, that in compliance with their request, on the 21st day of June in the year of our Lord Highteen hundred and Twenty Seven in the presence of the Rector, the Vestry and a large concourse of other persons, I have consecrated it agreeably to the established form of Consecration, thereby separating it henceforth from all unhallowed, or ordinary and common use; and setting it apart to the religious sevice which belongs to the worship of that great Being, who, although he has Heaven for his throne and earth for his footstool, has condescended to promise his especial presence with those who assemble in his name in acts of prayer and praise agreeable to the Gospel covenant. Witness my hand and seal the day and year above written James Kemp (Seal)

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

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
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
