During the past three years the compiler has been carrying on a work among the dead. The undertaking has been self imposed, inspiring and most interesting. Most of the time has been spent in the long forgotten cemeteries on the farms of the pioneers of Ulster County, New York.

Almost every old farm has its hallowed spot. The small enclosure, with its now fallen and decaying fence, is usually found upon a knoll or on the slope of a hill-side. To-day, the ancient markers stand as sentinels in the midst of almost impassable underbrush, defying the neglect, mutely testifying to the love and care once shown the spot by those who now sleep beneath the tangled mass of briars, weeds and poison ivy.

On August 5, 1924, the old cemetery at Montgomery, Orange County, New York, was visited in search of the graves of two soldiers of the American Revolution, when records indicated that they might be found there. The compiler was informed that the old burial ground was in the churchyard of the German Reformed Church, founded two hundred years ago.

The ancient brick structure, which stands upon an elevation, back from the highway, was easily located; but a general survey showed no signs of a cemetery. At the extreme right of the church is a stone wall, bordered by a row of beautiful trees, whose great roots bear witness to their age. Below this wall, on the slope of a hill, beneath almost impregnable underbrush of many years growth — dense briars and brambles, poison ivy and poison oak, were found the graves of the earliest settlers of Montgomery — the very founders of the church! The resting place of heroes of 1776 — neglected and forgotten!

The compiler has had occasion to visit scores of abandoned cemeteries, but in none has been found more deplorable conditions than existed in this historic burying ground -- in the very shadow of one of the oldest churches of this valley. After fighting for nearly five hours, through the thickest brush ever encountered in any cemetery, the gravestones sought were finally located. During the search the records discovered were of such unusual interest that the resolve was made to thoroughly investigate the ancient burial ground and save the fast fading inscriptions for posterity. This volume is the result.

In the early spring of 1925, before the undergrowth was fully leafed, the compiler spent almost an entire week in this interesting old place-- fighting the way foot by foot through thorns and poison ivy with a spading fork and rake.

The town of Montgomery has had another cemetery for years; burials being no longer made in this old burial ground. Among the scores of stones only sixteen bear dates later than 1890, and these in each instance bear witness to the last members of some old family, who have been laid to rest among their ancestors.

The compilation was an arduous task as all of the markers were completely hidden by brush many feet high; the ground was very uneven, and as ones path was entirely obscured one could never be certain of ones footing. At the top of the hill beneath the trees the sunlight barely penetrates; Here, the undergrowth was not so dense; but the remainder was exposed to the full rays of a morning sun, this was a dense thicket of thorns and briars, in places eight feet high, through which poison ivy and oak stretched their menacing arms as a barrier. Underneath this indescribable neglect the compiler found the records of exactly FIFTY soldiers of the AMERICAN REVOLUTION! There are

doubtless other patriots resting there. Some in unmarked graves, perhaps. From countless stones all inscriptions have long ago disappeared. Many markers, broken and fallen to the ground, were so deeply imbedded that it was impossible to obtain the mute testimony they once bore to the passer-by. Some of the inscriptions were deciphered with the greatest difficulty as the old sandstones are so badly crumbled and almost completely covered with moss and lichen.

It has not been the habit of the compiler to copy the quaint verses found on many of these old gravestones; but in closing, attention is called to the record of the young pastor, Reverend Jesse Fonda, to whose memory "the females" of his parish erected a tomb. Also to these unusual verses found on two of the oldest stones. The first on that of a very young mother who sleeps with her babe beneath the stone --

"The pains of childbirth were her end"
"The cause-it did from Eve descend."

And this one, which marks the resting place of a mother surrounded by children, grandchildren and great grandchildren, and whose posterity still lives in Montgomery --

"The dame that lies beneath this tomb,"
"Had Rachel's beauty and Leah's fruitful womb."
