## FOREWORD

This book contains the first recorded marriage records that were filed in the Court Houses of Clackamas and Wasco Counties of Oregon. Some of the records are for marriages solemnized as early as 1848 and a great many of these marriages took place before Oregon became a state (1859).

These records were all hand written by the Recorder or his Deputy and in some cases extremely difficult to read. Care was used in this abstracting and when it was impossible to determine exactly what the Recorder had intended more than one spelling of the name is given. Those using these records must keep in mind that often the person writing the record spelled the name as it sounded to him.

On some the notation "5¢ U.S. Stamp affixed" or "10¢ U.S. Stamp affixed" or "5¢(10¢) U. S. R.(Revenue) Stamp" followed the regular record. Mr. David Duniway, State Archivist, provided us with the following reference which explains this tax:

United States Statutes at Large Chapter 119,  
Schedule B, approved 1 July 1862, Vol. 12, p. 480  
"Certificates of any other description than  
those specified, 10¢." This was changed to  
5¢ by Chapter 74, Sec. 6, approved 3 Mar. 1863,  
p. 720. It appears again at 5¢ in Chapter 173,  
Schedule B, approved 30 June 1864.

This was part of a tax levied to help finance the War between the States.

Mrs. Emmett Stoddard, Organizing Regent of Tualatin Chapter, abstracted the Clackamas County marriages and those for Wasco County were done by Mrs. Wayne E. Gurley. The photolithographic copies were prepared by Mrs. Harold L. Friend.
