

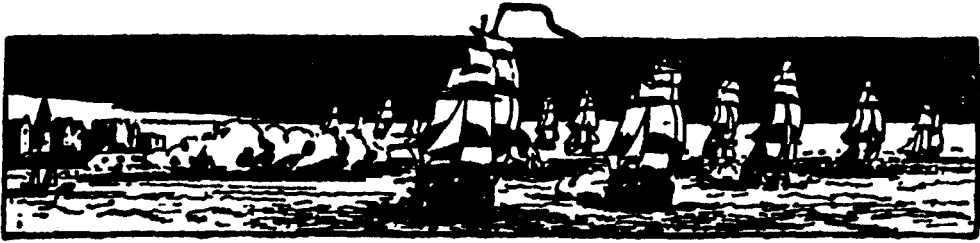

## INTRODUCTION

**I**N gathering material for my late work, *The Ancestors of Marguerite Eyerman*, I found it necessary to visit some of the old grave-yards in Northampton and adjacent counties and I was astonished at the number of grave-stones which had either entirely, or in part, lost their inscriptions. How many more would succumb to the action of the elements within the next decade! In the majority of cases, these inscriptions being the only record extant, so far as the births are concerned.

Realizing the great loss to compilers of family genealogies, and the absolute necessity for a permanent record of these stones, I immediately decided to copy the dates of birth and death and in many cases the entire inscriptions.

Some of the yards having as many as one thousand stones, it has been deemed advisable to record only those which stand for persons born prior to 1780; and it is safe to say that 98 per cent of such are recorded herein.

Genealogical notes have been added to many of the names; and the original spelling has, in every case, been retained.

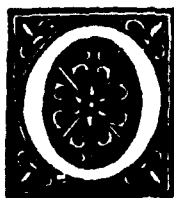

NE of the oldest grave-yards in *Northampton Co.*, one of no little importance, containing, as it does the graves of many of the earliest Scotch-Irish settlers, is that of the Presbyterian congregation of *Lower Mount Bethel* township.

This historic spot is situated near the village of *Martin's Creek* about seven miles N. of *Easton*, and was undoubtedly in use prior to 1750, for "as early as 1738, services were held by the Rev. *Gilbert Tennent*, in a small Church adjoining the yard".

The present condition of the yard is disgraceful and, as such reflects great discredit upon the Church under whose control it is.



THE DRYLAND Church-Yard is situated at *Hecktown*, in *Lower Nazareth*, township, eight miles W. of *Easton*. It was laid-out between the years 1760 and 1770.

The present Church, a well-built structure, adjoining the yard, was erected in the year 1842. The entire property is well-kept. Unfortunately, the inscriptions on some of the older stones have become quite illegible: this is particularly noticeable on the *Potfdam* sand-stone.

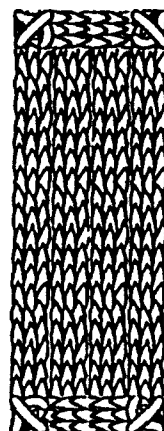
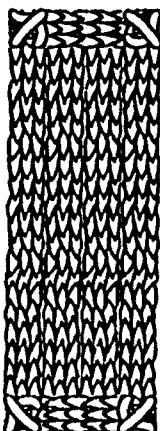

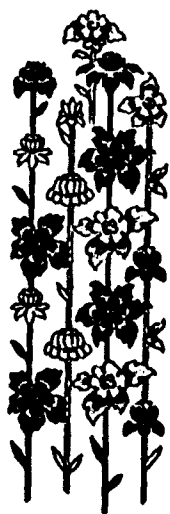

## EASTON GERMAN REFORMED




THE old GERMAN REFORMED Grave-Yard is situated in the western part of *Easton* (old town) occupying one of the highest points therein and, overlooking the beautiful *Bushkill* valley.

Jungle-like might be an appropriate word to apply in describing the condition of this spot.

To explore this yard, during the Summer months would be, not only a difficult, but a hazardous, undertaking; difficult, because the tree-like brush is so dense as to be almost impenetrable; hazardous, because the *Reptilia* have become legion.

The list given, here-with, undoubtedly does not represent all the interments, as is evidenced by the fact that there are several piles of grave-stones in the yard: whether these stones represent the action of the elements in overturning them or, whether they represent the removal of the remains to other yards, is not known: It is known, however, that some of the remains have been re-interred in the *Easton* Cemetery.

The date of erection of the first Church is unknown: the second, a log one, was erected in 1772.



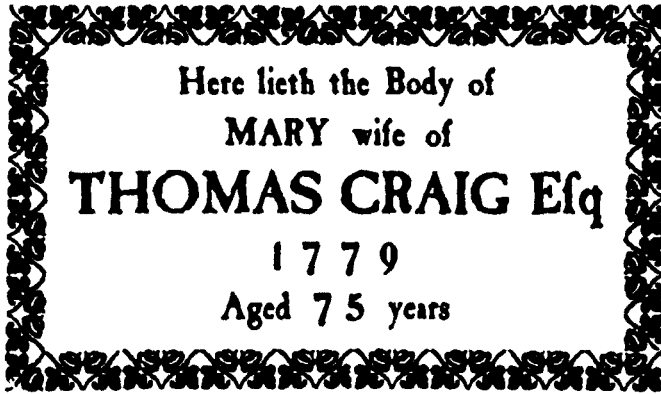

## WILLIAMS



WILLIAMS TOWNSHIP contains but one old grave yard; that of the 'old *Williams* congregation', situated in the south-western part of the township, near the *Lower Saucon* line.

Many of the grave-stones are entirely hidden from view by tall-growing grass and brush; and the inscriptions on some of the stones have become entirely obliterated.

The present Church was erected in the year 1813, replacing the original log structure.

## LOWER SAUCON



**L**OWER SAUCON township had within its limits no less than seven grave-yards, three of which were abandoned in the latter part of the first half of the present century.

The oldest of these was laid-out in 1747, near the present site of the *Lehigh Valley Rwy. Co's* offices, at *S. Bethlehem*; the second, on the *Beidelman* farm; the third near *Shimmersville*; not a stone remains to mark the exact spot of their location.

---

The *LOWER SAUCON* Yard was laid-out prior to the Revolution; it is situated two miles N. E. of *Hellertown*.

The public highway separates the old yard from the Church and 'new' yard. Services were held as early as 1740.

**S**T. PETER'S Grave-Yard, one of the best kept in the County, is situated in *Plainfield* t<sup>sp</sup>. about ten miles N. of *Easton*. It was laid-out about the the middle of the last century: Some of the oldest bones are now devoid of inscriptions: the oldest entirely legible inscription bears the date, 1753.

The present Church, a large well-built structure erected in 1832, is separated from the yard by the public highway.

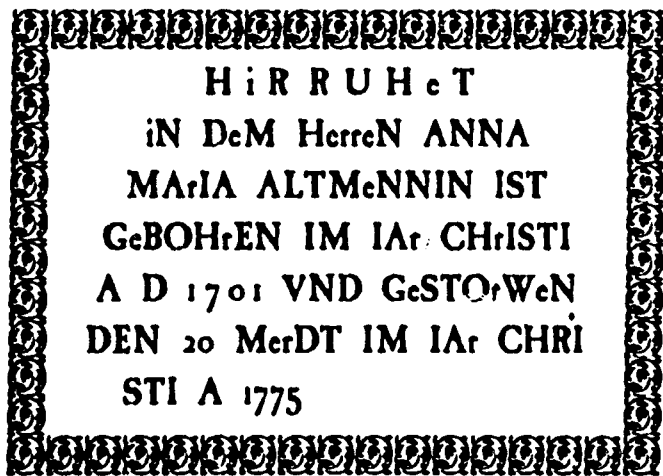
T. PAUL'S Church-yard, known also as the Indian Land yard, is situated at *Poplar Grove* in *Lehigh* tsp. about 17 miles N. W. of *Easton*. The yard lies in the rear of the Church, and extends from the public highway about 100 yards up the hill-side. The property dates from the middle of the 18<sup>th</sup> century, and, as is generally the case in the older yards, a number of the oldest stones have lost their inscriptions.

The corner-stone of the Church bears the following inscription

GEGRUNDET 1772 NEUERBAUET 1833

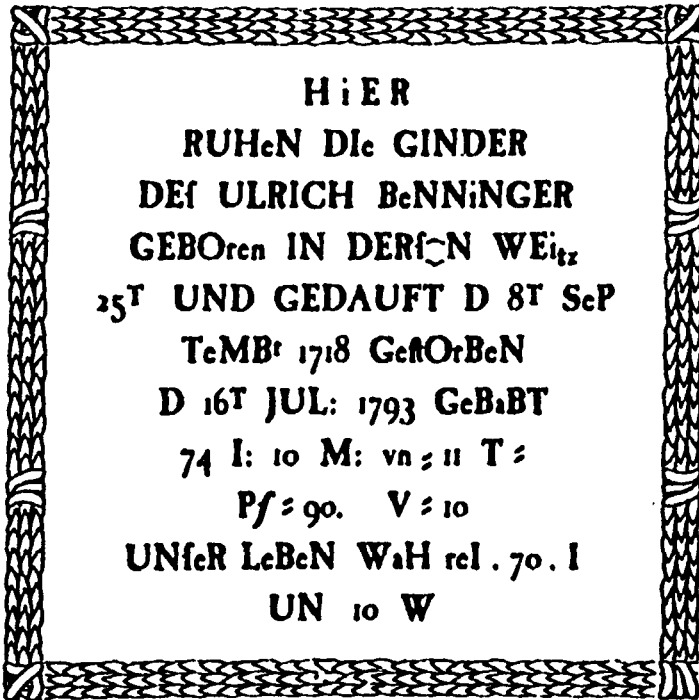

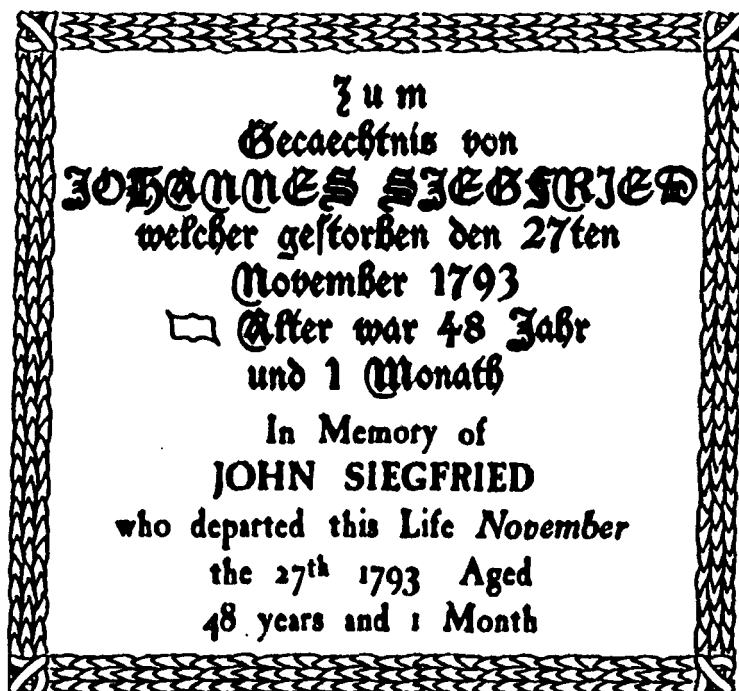


THE Old MENNONITE Yard at *Siegfried's* in *Allen* township was laid-out prior to 1760.

The oldest stone bears the date of 1794, about the time of the erection of the Stone Church.



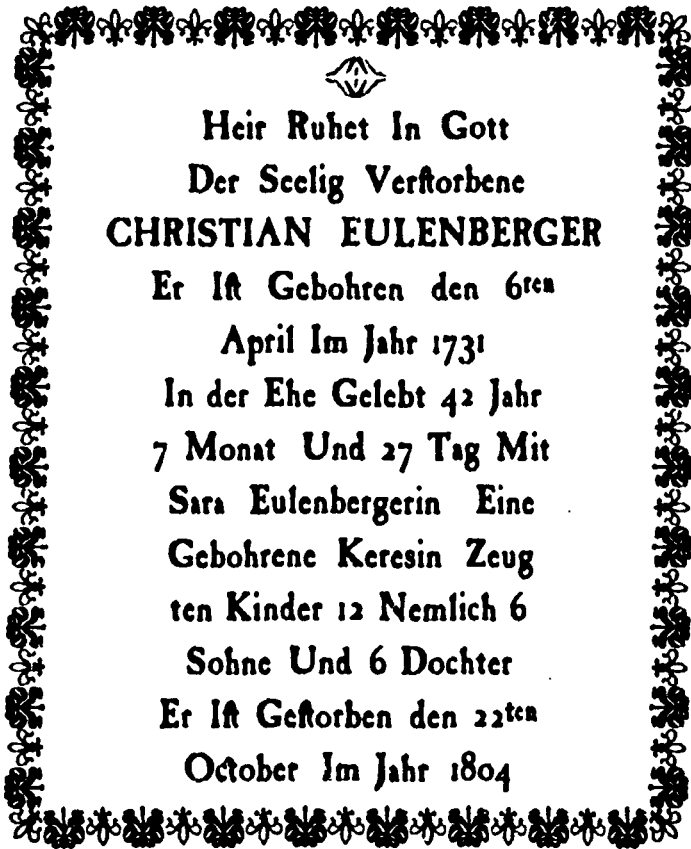



Most appropriate is the name of this Church, for it stands on quite an eminence, and overlooks the beautiful and fertile *Hokendauqua* valley.


The yard, a very large one, was laid-out between 1760 and 1770: the first Church was erected in 1771.

## EASTON CEMETERY



EASTON, the county seat of Northampton, has no less than eleven graveyards within its limits. The largest of these, the Easton Cemetery, was laid-out in 1849, on an elevated spot, at the N.

terminus of Seventh str. overlooking the old town and the Bushkill valley.

The older stones represent the re-interments from the old yards of the town and in a few cases, from the County yards.

At the extreme South end of the Cemetery are thirty-four stones, which were removed a few years ago, from St. John's yard, Easton; these are marked with an asterisk \*.
