THE BUCK FAMILY OF YORKSHIRE

The following entries have been extracted from the digests of registers of births, marriages and burials of members of the Society of Friends residing within the Quarterly Meeting of Yorkshire: in some cases the entries have been either abbreviated or filled out for clarity - otherwise they are as they appear in the digests.

It should be noted that, until the year 1752, the year began on 25 March. In Quaker dating a complication arises; the Society of Friends from its beginning referred to the months numerically, refusing to use their "heathen" names. Up to 1752, therefore, First Month stands for March and Twelfth Month for February. After 1752 First Month stands for January and Second Month for February, etc.
