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INTRODUCTION

The two authors of this work, who are extremely distant cousins, happened to learn of each other's existence in 1963 through a magazine advertisement. H. Vern Crary, a descendent of Aaron Kimball Crary⁵, could trace most of Aaron's descendents, and Alsace L. Daniels, a descendent of Joseph Smith Crary⁵, could trace most of Joseph's descendents. It was decided that since no one else seemed to know anything about the line of John Crary of Boston, perhaps our data should be preserved for the future. This booklet is the result.

We have tried to be accurate and to give sources whenever possible. A list of the references used will be found at the end of the book. We are sure that the information on the descendents of Aaron Kimball Crary and Joseph Smith Crary is quite accurate. We are less certain about the line of Leonard Proctor Crary⁵, and have had to accept some hearsay evidence without being able to prove it. We hope our booklet will stimulate interest in the line of John Crary of Boston and will lead to more data being uncovered. The authors would very much like to hear from anyone who can give additional information on any of these lines or can offer corrections. Perhaps someone will be able to give us two important names we have been unable to find, the last names of the wives of John¹ (101) and Roger² (202).

In using this book, note that each generation has a one-hundred number. All children in each generation are numbered consecutively, and children who are carried down with additional information on their descendents have a + sign before their numbers. If there is no + sign, no additional information is available at this time.

Our thanks go to many living descendents who have sent us information on their families, and especially to Mr. Luther F. Cary, who supplied the data on the line of Benjamin Crary³ (301), the eldest son of Roger Crary² (202) by his first wife.

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THE DESCENDENTS OF JOHN CRARY OF BOSTON

According to family tradition, the name CRARY was originally McQUARRIE, later changed to McCRARY, and finally to CRARY. The Clan McQuarrie claimed descent from Kenneth McAlpine, the founder of the Scottish monarchy. The Clan is believed to have lived on the Isle of Ulva and a part of Mull on the west coast of Scotland.

At the time of Oliver Cromwell in the mid-seventeenth century the family name was McCrary. It is believed that John Crary and his probable brother, Peter Crary, were supporters of Cromwell, and when Charles II was restored to the throne in 1660, they left their home in Northumberland County to emigrate to America. Perhaps they dropped the "Mc" from their name to avoid recognition as followers of Cromwell.

FIRST GENERATION

101 John Crary was living in Boston between 1671 and 1678. He was probably a brother of Peter Crary of Groton, Connecticut, and was possibly a brother of Roger Crary of Elsinburgh, New Jersey. There is no real proof of either relationship.

A daughter Sarah, child of "Nicholas and Esther Crary" was born at Boston on Nov. 14, 1677. The relationship of Nicholas to John above, if any, is not known.

Roger Crary³ served in Col. Eleazer Fitch's Company in the French and Indian War as a private. (See Conn. Historical Society Collections, Vol. 9, Rolls of Conn. Men in the French and Indian War, p. 98. 20 of the 70 men in his group were from Woodstock, Mass.)

Polly Proctor Crary later m. 2nd after 1810, Elihu Stewart, who d. in 1816 and is buried in Swinburne Cemetery, Denmark, N.Y. By him she had two children, Elihu Stewart Jr. and Mary Stewart. Polly was m. a third time after 1816 to William Root or Roots, an attorney. She and her 3rd husband were still living in 1850 and appear in the census of Farmersville, N.Y.

Joseph Crary⁴ was a surveyor by profession. He served in the Revolutionary War as a surveyor under the Surveyors General, Simon DeWitt and Phillip Schuyler. The office of Surveyor was revived by law 21 Mar., 1781 for raising regiments on land bounty rights. Apparently the land being surveyed to be given as land bounties was in Vermont, because Joseph Crary, referred to in Vermont Records as "Major Crary", surveyed Mendon, Chittenden, and other cities. He later surveyed lands in Lewis, Herkimer, and Jefferson counties in New York. He died of pneumonia while surveying the road that passes through these counties to Sacketts Harbor on

Lake Ontario.

Joseph Crary may also have served with the Conn. forces earlier in the war. A Joseph Crary was in Col. Samuel McClellan's Regiment in 1778 (Collections of the Conn. Historical Society, Vol. 8, pp. 184-86). A Joseph Crary was a private in Capt. Richard Hewit's Co. in the regiment commanded by Col. Jonathan Latimer. He is listed as serving from Aug. 24, 1778 to Nov. 7, 1778, a service of 2 months and 15 days. He appears to have enrolled at New London, Conn., on June 17, 1778, and was given travel money for 160 miles. (Information from National Archives).

According to information supplied by Elihu Stewart, a distant relative, he was a prisoner in the infamous "Sugar House" in New York City, where he nearly starved to death. He was mistaken for a friend by a lady who used to send him presents of provisions. At length she obtained an interview, where she discovered her mistake, but she continued to befriend him afterward. Elihu Stewart says that he was a fine scholar, educated in the college at New Haven (Yale?), and he did writing for the British officers and came through alive. When he returned home, his family had given him up for dead, and he was so changed they did not recognize him at first. To date no proof of this story has been found in government files, nor does Yale have a record of a Joseph Crary as a student.

After residing 21 years at Cavendish, Vermont, Joseph Crary and his family moved to Lewis County, New York, where he continued his work as a surveyor. A record has been found of land taken up in the name of his wife and children, but no record has been found of land held in his own name.

Leonard P. Crary lived with his grandfather, Leonard Proctor, at Cavendish, Vt., until he was 21. After that he studied law with his uncle, John Crary, at Salem, N.Y. He practiced law at Buffalo, N.Y. and was later Collector of the Port at Black Rock, Erie Co., N.Y. at the time of his death.

She was probably the dau. of Elihu Stewart, the second husband of her mother-in-law, Mary Proctor Crary Stewart, whose first husband was Joseph Crary⁴ (#419). Her mother's maiden name may have been Mehitable Shepard.

Joseph Smith Crary lived in Denmark, N.Y., until some time after 1825, when he moved to Rushford, Allegheny County, N.Y. He had a fine farm there, but in 1835, as his daughter Adelia puts it in her autobiography, he got "Illinois fever". He sold his farm and moved west by covered wagon to Homewood in Bloom Township, Cook County, Ill. There he built a log cabin for temporary use, and had just begun a framed house when he got sick with fever in 1838. A doctor was sent for from Lockport, some distance away, but was unable to save Joseph.
