Rev. John CORDELL, 'of Wiltshire', 1720, married Elizabeth EDWARDS, son George Edwards Cordell born 17 Feb. 1742; emigr. to America 1743.

"On the above statement I have made wide research but have been unable to identify these people. As no doubt you know, the clergy of that time had almost all of them an academic education, but there is no JOHN CORDELL to be found at Oxford, Cambridge, Eton, Harrow, Winchester, Dublin, or the big London schools. No reference in a large number of Wiltshire lists and indexes searched for the CORDELL name, and I have searched the period 1700-1750 in all local Wiltshire Probate Courts without finding a single CORDELL-- I fail to trace any CORDELL in Clergy Lists of the period---".

Sir: The claim for Land Bounty of the heirs of my deceased father John Cordell, a Chaplain in the Army of the Revolution, I have just learn't has been rejected. I am also informed that a supplemental report of the Commission for Revolutionary Claims on John Cordell's case (founded on Documents received by him since his original Report was made) has been furnished you.

With the hope that this additional evidence of the services of my father may alter the determination of the Executive, and as I am detained a great distance from home on expenses, with no other business, I must beg the favor of your Excellency to reconsider this case with as convenient despatch as may comport with your other engagements.

"John Cordell died intestate, possessed of 717 arpents of land on waters of Creve Cour. Seven children: Steptoe, Harriett, Hiram, Polly, Lucy, Arthur, and Fanny (who married John Ward)."

Information from Mrs. J.C. Higgins, St. Louis, Mo.

"I will give you a copy of the letter my sister (Nannie Stevens) wrote Dr. Eugene Cordell in 1895- Letter' My great grandmother's name was Judith Blackwell. She was born in Northumberland Co., Va. Her first husband was Mr. Price, by whom she had two daughters viz: Mrs. Elizabeth LeWright and Mrs. Ann Ball. Her second husband was Rev. John Cordell the second. Mrs. Ball was stepgrandmother of Mr. Lucius L. Bates. Mrs. LeWright in 1895 had one living son, Wm. LeWright, in Liberty, Mo. The LeWrights have never been very intimate with the Cordells, owing to some misunderstanding about money. I do not know the trouble. Mr. Price was in those days

considered wealthy. After her second marriage to Rev. John Cordell second, they lived in Winchester, Va. where her children were born. After that they moved to Kentucky and lived one year with her sister, Mrs. Col. Churchill, grandmother of the late Col. Sam Churchill, Atty.Gen. of Ky. They moved to Missouri in 1797 which was then under Spanish government and from which he received a Spanish grant of 1200 A's of land-(I, Jennie C.Higgins at the present time own 140 A's of this grant and my great grandfather John Cordell is buried on my place). He being a chaplain in the Rev. War, the D.A.R. put a marker at his grave. I neglected to say both Rev. John Cordell first and second were Episcopal ministers, and my sister, Mrs. Corinne C.Smith, has in her possession John Cordell's prayer book. "

Translation.

"Upper Louisiana District of St.Louis of the Illinois. Mr. Antoine Soulard, Special Surveyor of the Establishments of Upper Louisiana.

I certify that on the 15th of January of the present year, (by virtue of a previous order of the Honorable Zenon Trudeau as Lieut. Gov. of these Establishments) I went to the land of Mr. John Cordell to make a measurement and survey of it, pursuant to his petition for eigh hundred arpens in area, which survey was made in the presence of the proprietor and his neighbors according to the measure of Paris and the perch of 18 feet following the custom adopted in this Province of Louisiana, (with a magnetic variation of 7 degrees 30 minutes), which is shown on the preceding figurative plan. The land is situated 21 miles West of the village of St.Louis, and is bounded on the North by open lands of the Royal Domain, on the South by land of Isaac Decker, on the East by George Gordon's Grant and on the West by land of John Ward, all of which is shown on the foregoing plat, indicating the dimensions and the natural and artificial boundaries of said land.

"Inventory of the estate of John Cordell, Santiago Macay, Capt. of dragoons, commander, etc., having been informed that Mr. Cordell had died at his plantation having left wife and children of tender years, repaired to the said plantation accompanied by Daniel Cole and Ivan Renaud as attending witnesses for the purpose of taking an inventory of the property of the said deceased may have left and having requested Madam Judith Blackwell, his widow, to exhibit to me the property belonging to the Community, she exhibited such few things and having proved to me that she never possessed anything more in this Country and find moreover that she is bothered with children, for whose care she ought to provide, I consider that the title which she had was indispensable for the comfort of her family and that no inventory could be taken without it being highly prejudicial to her in consequence of the expense, consequently I made none leaving her in possession of the little property she has, etc.

St. Louis County Court records Book 1 page 451 (Original filed in City Registers Office, St. Louis, Mo. Copy filed in County Highway Engineers Office, Clayton, Mo.) Minutes dated Monday, Nov. 16th 1835.

"Robert Leright stated under oath to prove that Judith Cordell is widow of John Cordell, deceased, late Captain and Chaplain of Virginia Continental Line and that the heirs at law of said deceased are Hiram Cordell, Mary the wife of Stephen Lanham, the children of said John Cordell deceased, Fanny, wife of Simon Brewster and others--- Robert Leright became acquainted with John Cordell deceased, about the year 1786 in Frederick Co. Va. where he lived at that time and where lived at that time a number of Revolutionary soldiers, General Daniel Morgan, Col. Richard Mead, and Col. Charles M. Thurston.

Also same party stated under oath in Book 2, p. 114 same statement to prove that Judith Cordell was the widow of John Cordell. Wed. Aug. 16th 1837. "

Information furnished by J.E.Cordell, Macomb, Ill.

" My grandfather, Alexander Cordell, said the name CORDELL was a French name. The Cordells first lived in the valley of the Rhine river. They spread into France, then into England and from there to America. Grandfather Cordell was born and raised on a plantation near Leesburg, Va. He was a typical southern gentleman, well educated and a silversmith by trade. He made knives, forks, and spoons. My mother once had a set of them and I have eaten many a bowl of bread and milk with one of grandpa's silver spoons." Records relating to Presley Cordell.

March 25, 1853 "Final settlement in estate of Presley Cordell. Cash, per inventory \$45; notes, per inventory, \$2,560.84; Slaves, per appraisement, \$1,300; Personality per sales bill, \$225.27. Total \$4,131.11

Inventory of real estate: Two story brick house and lot in St.Louis on 11th street between Market and Clark."

Diary of Thomas Keyes Humphreys, Jefferson Memorial Library, Forest Park, St.Louis, Mo. "Presley Cordell arrived at St.Louis, Mo. by boat on Monday, Nov. 9, 1835 along with part of his family and other relatives."

Will of Presley Cordell.

"I, Presley Cordell, of the County of St.Louis and State of Missouri, being of sound mind and memory do make and publish this my last will and testament as follows, to wit:-

First: I desire that my funeral expenses and all other debts be first paid. Second: As I have heretofore not advanced any money or given any property to my son Henry Cordell, it is my will that as soon as may be the sum of \$1,000 be raised from my estate to be given to my said son Henry. Third: It is my will that at the death of my wife, those of my children who have not received from me \$1,550 (this being the largest amount that any have received) may each receive from the estate that may be left at my wife's death, so much as will make the portion received by each amount to \$1,550 or as near that sum as may be. The advances in money and property heretofore at sundry times made by me to my children are as follows to wit:

First: To Levi C. Cordell, cash paid for his medical education \$1,000; one negro boy named Henry valued at \$500, one bed, bedstead and bedding \$50, amounting in all to \$1,550.

Second: To Enos B. Cordell, cash \$1,500. One bed, bedstead and bedding \$50, amounting in all to \$1,550.

Third: To Asa B. Cordell, cash \$1,500. One bed, bedstead and bedding \$50, amounting in all to \$1,550.

Fourth: To Mary E. Boteler, furniture \$300, cash \$600, hire of a negro man one year and horse, amounting in all to \$1,000.

Fifth: Helen A. Humphreys, furniture \$300, cash

\$600, hire of a negro man one year and other small matters making together \$100 and amounting in all to \$1,000.

Sixth: To Richard L. Cordell, cash paid for his mathematical education \$100. Cash for entered land \$200. 120 acres of land in Saline Co. at \$3.00 per acre; one bed ,bedstead and bedding \$50 amounting in all to \$710.

Seventh: To Virginia Bay, furniture \$300. 254 and 75/100 acres of land in Miller Co. at \$2.00 per acre, making for land \$509.50 and amounting in all to \$809.50.

Eighth: To James H. Cordell, one lever watch and cash worth together \$70. 160 acres of land in Cole Co. at \$2.00 per acre amounting in all to \$390.

Ninth: To Presley T. Cordell for collegiate education and other expenses \$1,000.

I give and bequeath to my wife Amelia Cordell the farm on which I now live with the two additions to it, one of which I purchased from Joseph Conway and the other from Philip Morris. I also give to my wife 150 acres of land on the Meramac river. I also give to my wife one undivided fifth part of a lot of ground in the town of Leesburg, County of Loudoun and State of Virginia. I also give to my wife \$300 in turnpike stock in the Leesburg and Snickersville Turnpike Road Co. I furthermore give to my wife my three negro men, Armistead, Israel and Lloyd, a negro woman named Kitty, and two negro girls Eliza and Mary Ellen. I also further give to my wife all my farming utensils together with the live stock of all kinds, all gathered and growing crops, with everything used in carrying on the farm. Also all household and kitchen furniture of every description. I also give to my wife all debts which are or may come due to me. I do hereby appoint my wife Amelia Cordell executrix of this my last will and testament, revoking all former wills by me made. It is my request that my said executrix be not required to give security for executorship. At the death of my wife it is my wish that my remaining estate may be divided equally among my

children, as she, my said wife holds it only for and during her natural life. At the death of my wife, I request that Thomas K. Humphreys; Enos B. Cordell; James H. Cordell and Samuel Conway to act as executors of this my last will and testament.

In testimony whereof I have herewith set my hand and seal this ninth day of October eighteen hundred and forty six.
