From Genealogical and Family History of State of Connecticut Vol. I, Year 1911.

The history of the old Province of Bretagne or Brittany in France by Morier mentions the surname of de Acquitnay, pronounced DeAckeny, as existing at or near Louviers in the Province of Normandy in the year 802 A. D. and states that one Hervius DeAcquinay lived in the year 1058. A village called DeAcquinay now exists in France. The names spelled DeAquinay, Deacuns, Aken, D'Akeny, Dakenyne, DeAkin and Dakin are connected armorially. One Baldwin Dakin fought in the battle of Hastings in year 1066. The families of Dakeyne, Deakune or Dakyns are of considerable antiquity in county Derby, England, and at an early period held large possessions in Bedford, Buckingham, Cambridge and Norfolk counties. William Daken, grandson of Baldwin Dakeny mentioned above was Lord of Wighton, Norfolk, in the reign of Richard and John which title and estate his son William

Deken or De'Akeny forfeited by his rebellion in the reign of Henry III.

The motto of the widely extended family of Dakin is — "Strike Dakyn the Devil's in the Hemp" is said to have originated in an incident in a sea-fight. Devil meaning Enemy and Hemp the ropes or cordage. The motto was used in the time of Edward VI, probably much earlier.

"There is always an atmosphere of mystery about these old family escutcheons, which enhance their interest, and our desire to penetrate their meaning, at best vague and unsatisfactory, and so we never weary of anything bearing on the subject. For this reason we give the opinion of one writer on heraldry, that the full figure of a Lion denotes some past connection with a royal family.

This Copy of the "Coat of Arms" is inserted in this Book to be a memento of the family from that far away time of which we can now learn so little."

Thomas Dakin 1 (ancestry unknown) born according to his will in 1624. He married first Sarah who died Oct. 18, 1659. He married second June 11, 1660, Susanna widow of Richard Stratton.

Thomas Dakin died Concord, Mass. Oct. 21, 1708.

Susanna died Concord, Mass. Feb. 26, 1697.

We do not know when Thomas came to Concord or where he came from. Shattuck's History of Concord says he was there before 1650.

Simon Dakin 4—(Simon 3—Simon 2—Thomas 1—)b. Jan. 27, 1721. d. Sept. 19, 1803. m. Dec. 16, 1642 Rebecca b. May 2, 1724, dau. of Benjamin and Deborah (Johnson) Perry of Sandwich, Mass. Simon Dakin 4 came with his father to Franklin (now Patterson) Putnam Co., N. Y. in 1737. He was first a member of the Presbyterian Church from which he with several others withdrew and formed what was then called "The Separate Church." Subsequently he embraced Baptist sentiments and was one of the constituents members of a Baptist church organized in Phillips Patent Westchester Co., N. Y., Nov. 6, 1751. In 1753 he was ordained pastor of the church and with it removed to North East, Dutchess Co., N. Y., in 1773. His official relation with the church continued until his disease in the 50th year of his ministry, leaving behind him a name around which pleasant memories linger of a character most estimable and honorable. The Baptist church was then situated within the Spencer Corner's Cemetery. The Church site and part of the present Cemetery were given to the Church and Society by Rev. Simon Dakin 4. His grave is there.

Y., his name is mentioned in "New York in Revolution as Colony of State", page 248, vol. 1, 1904, 6th Regiment Dutchess Co., Millerton, as one entitled to "Land Bounty Rights". This will be of interest to those of his descendants who would like to be a "Son or Daughter of the Revolution."
