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A Personal Word

The preparation of this genealogical record which has been in the process of compilation for over seven years is the expression not of pride but of sociability. When retirement in 1941 from a life of teaching in college afforded some leisure it suggested also an opportunity to make a better acquaintance with many relatives whose names I had heard my parents and older brothers and sisters mention but whom I had never met. The first step in this acquaintance was to learn the exact relationship each bore to me. This was done by interviews when possible and by correspondence with others regarding both the living and the dead. This correspondence has been the chief source of the information herein presented. In addition it has been a pleasure to me though no doubt my persistence has exhausted the patience of some of you.

The publication of this record has been stimulated by the many generous words of appreciation which have come to me from time to time as progress has been made and tentative records have been sent out to relatives whose addresses I had. A personal hobby became unexpectedly a family and social obligation as well as an expensive entertainment. A further stimulus to publication came in studying the background and the hardships endured by these early settlers in making new homes in the wilderness of America. There grew a conviction that the lives and the Christian character of these pioneers, God-fearing men and women whose names seldom appear in contemporary news publications, constitute the very fiber of American democracy and of our cherished freedom. The cost of this heritage should be known and should become the inspiration of present and future generations of Holland-Americans. A rich heritage imposes a heavy obligation.

The centennial edition was conceived and undertaken as a suitable memorial in the form of a permanent and public record of the growth and spread and influence of one family of Holland immigrants in 100 years in America—1848 to 1948. The de Swarte family might be regarded as typical of the many who left the Netherlands and the other countries of Europe and came to America during the years 1845 to 1850, and later, for political, economic and religious freedom and opportunity. Their contribution to the American way of life is out of all proportion to their number, and their value is not recognized by many.

Pictures of all the children of Pieter Bartholomeus de Swarte as far as they were available have been included in this edition. Since the daguerreotypic process was not invented until 1839 and the earlier methods did not secure permanent pictures, photographs of members of this family before this date were probably not made. Any likenesses would be either drawings or paintings. Such drawings and paintings of persons were confined largely to the wealthier and upper classes. It may be said, however, that a marine painting made by Abraham de Swarte, (number 30), in 1842, and in my possession shows the possibility of paintings by him of members of the family. The following persons (referred to by number as used in the body of this genealogy) died before the daguerreotype was invented: 22, 25, 32, 33, 35, 36, and T38. Photographs have been found and cuts made of Susanna Thomas (1803-1888), 28, 30, 31, 34, T37, 39, 40, and 41. No portrait of Pieter B. de Swarte or of his first wife, Jozina Haartsen (1788-1826) have been located. We are reasonably sure that we have cuts of all persons of the first generation of whom photos are in existence. Pictures of the second and later generations to the present were requested in our correspondence with relatives. The expense of such cuts was to be borne each by those who submitted them. It is disappointing that not more of these photos were submitted since such would present not merely the likenesses of some of the more than 900 descendants but would also be a pictorial history of costumes and customs. Should there be an interest in adding these pictures later it could be done and made a part of this brochure. I hope that after the booklet is sent out those who do not have their family groups represented here will want to add them to this.

The system of numbering the individuals for identification to distinguish between persons with the same name, and between generations, by the use of serial numbers on different arithmetical levels, is my own. I make no claim to superiority of this system and attempt no justification of it in the face of a generally established system. It has seemed to me better suited to my purpose of genealogy, as distinguished from lineage, and it has been helpful in keeping different persons with the same name in their proper generation. Indentation of successive generations on the page helps the eye to distinguish individuals and families.

Figures in the tens, 21 to 41, mark the children of the first generation, the children of Pieter Bartholomeus de Swarte (1787-1860) by his first wife, Jozina Haartsen (1787-1826), and by his second wife, Suzanna Thomas (1803-1888). Numbers in the hundreds are used for the second generation; in the thousands for the third generation; in the ten thousands for the fourth generation; in the hundred thousands for the fifth generation; and in the millions for the sixth generation. "Two" hundred, "two" thousand, etc., were used instead of "one" hundred, "one" thousand, etc., because the "one" was used in a similar genealogy of the van der Velde line.

The record of dates and places seems to give undue importance—out of all proportion to their intrinsic value—to the elements of time and space. This is perhaps true. More important both for themselves and for society are the facts regarding vocation, public service, religious leadership, and honors. It was my purpose to gather these latter data for each person and to tabulate the facts regarding these characteristics. I have considerable information of this sort which has come to me quite incidentally in my correspondence. Perhaps some other member of the de Swarte “gezin” will be induced to undertake such a study and make it public.

Doubtless there are errors in this record. Some may be typographical only. Some may be errors of omission due to my failure to secure all the information desired, though I probed every source. Some errors may be due to transmission and copying the data by those who secured it for me. I have checked all these data carefully against the several sources and corrections where such were sent in. Still other errors may be due to transmission and copying the competent authorities. It seems strange that brothers and sisters may disagree on the date, e. g. of a parent's birth, marriage, or death. But such is the case and I was required to make a choice of the most probable date. It was not possible to check all information against grave-stone and county records though this was done in some cases. I hope everyone who examines this record will note errors and send in corrections, additions, etc.

The spelling of names is not uniform throughout the booklet. Jozina and Josina, Johannis and Johannes, Adriaan and Adrian, and Isaak and Isaac are illustrations of such non-uniformity. Where an original record was available I followed it. Names sent in by the immediate members of the family or family group were spelled as the informer spelled them. The original spelling of the name “de Swarte” was not used by any family of the second or later generation so far as I can determine but the designation “De Swarte” was common. Fox Point, Town Eight and Milwaukee County are frequently identical in their reference. Randolph Center later became Friesland, about 1911, I am informed. Abbreviations of towns, and omissions of the state where the state is quite evident, have been made for compactness,—sometimes saving a line. The letter “a” means “adopted”; “b” is “born”; “m” is “married”; “d” means “died”. Figures after some names, e. g. 17:35, indicate the volume and page in the Milwaukee County Court House records.

The loose leaf form has been used instead of any other binding since it permits insertion at the proper place of later additions to the families. Blank pages may be inserted for any notations each one may wish to make.

My deepest appreciation is hereby expressed for every assistance given me by many relatives who took the time and trouble to provide accurate information. This record would not have been possible were it not for this assistance. I would like particularly to express special appreciation for the extensive, prolonged, prompt and patient cooperation of Mrs. Marian Blersch, Miss Jennie De Swarte, Miss Anna Ketelle, Mrs. Hubert Ketelle, Mrs. Jennie Leindecker, Mrs. Jake Oosterhuis, Peter F. Rispalje, Mrs. Anthony Voskuil, and of the late Mrs. Jennie Cupery, Mrs. John Gysbers and Mrs. Nellie Zondag. Their contributions constitute my largest folios of correspondence.

I hope this record will give to those who use it the pleasure I have had in preparing it, and that the future use of it will justify the time and money spent. This edition has been limited to one hundred and fifty copies.

Copies of this genealogical record will be sent to the Library of Congress, and to the state historical libraries of the states where most of the descendants were born, married, lived and died.

A Brief Historical Sketch

There are many good histories of the people of the Netherlands, of their economic hardships, of their political dependence and oppression, and of their religious persecution, both before and about the time of the “Great Migration” dated roughly about 1845 to 1850. These histories are so well written and authenticated by reference to the original sources, that it would seem useless to attempt to give any account of these facts within the limits of this introduction. However, there are probably some of the families interested in this genealogy who do not have access to these histories and there may be also others who would like a concise statement of the general circumstances surrounding the migration of the de Swarte family.

The de Swarte family shared the hopes, experienced the disappointments and underwent the hardships which belong to the emigrant of those days. A general description of these experiences will, therefore, in the absence of authenticated traditions of the de Swarte family both before and during the migration, suggest the atmosphere under which our brave, pious and foresighted ancestors secured for us the heritage of birth in a free land, the United States of America.

The motives for migration of the de Swarte as well as of the other families and colonies of other national groups, are multiple. Economic, political, cultural, educational, social and religious factors entered in to cause the wave of migration which swept Europe in the period following at some interval the French Revolution. One motive dominated one person or family, and another motive, others.

The poverty of the peasant class was terrible in all countries. In the Netherlands no opportunity for acquiring land adequate to provide food for a growing population made the prospect ever darker. Sons or daughters could secure farms only by dividing the paternal holdings. A temporary decline in food supply increased immediately the distress of poverty. The potato blight and famine of 1845 and 1846 were major disasters causing extreme hardship with starvation, disease and death. There was widespread unemployment due to industrial conditions. The advertised "vast prairies and fertile lands" with excellent markets in America, particularly in the Great Lakes region and in the Mississippi Valley, made a powerful appeal.

The rising tide of demand for freedom and independence and for participation in government which had been stirred up by the revolutions in America, in France and elsewhere possessed the politically and socially oppressed and the opportunity-less lower class. America in the 1840s was for Europe "the land of freedom and opportunity". The Netherlands the "land van slavernij en dwingelandy".

In the Netherlands under the alliance of the house of Orange and the upper classes, the Hervormde (Re-organized) Church replaced in 1816 the Gereformeerde (Reformed) Church. The Hervormde Church was the established church, financed and administered by the state. It was aristocratic, liberal and heretical in its theology according to some, and non-evangelical in its forms and influence. Against the free and pious orthodox spirits among the lower and middle classes who seceded and sought to worship in independent church organizations, the government invoked Articles 291 and 294 of the Napoleonic code. "No association of more than twenty persons whose object is to meet daily, or on special days appointed for the observance of religious, political, or other purposes, shall organize themselves without the consent of government." "Any person who without the consent of the municipal authority shall grant or consent to the use of his house . . . for the meeting of members of an association . . . for the celebration of a cult, shall be punished by a fine of from sixteen to two hundred francs."

These and other conditions, violating the ideals of liberty, equality and fraternity, over many years made effective the glowing reports in letters to Holland relatives of the few adventurers who had gone to America in the 1830s and before. One such letter which may be regarded as typical of the enthusiasm of those who had made the fearsome voyage to America is quoted here since it illustrates and describes the conditions in both the homeland and in America.

"Nearly all people eat meat three times a day; . . . And everybody is kind, and helps us out with everything; what we do not have, they lend us; chairs to sit on they brought to our room until we . . . had bought six others for 3 dollars, and a bedstead for a quarter less than 2 dollars; for here are no enclosed bunks and bedsteads, as in our country, but open couches; I guess this is on account of the heat; and they sleep with a feather bed underneath and a straw ticking on top; but quite correct and nice; Arnhem can't compare with it. One sees no poor here, no beggars, nor any collections or poor boxes, not even in the churches which my husband visited. . . . Schools are free here . . . there are no taxes . . . pubs for drunks, such as at Arnhem, one does not find here. . . . One sees great luxury, magnificent buildings, doors have silver knobs, houses of five stories high, beautiful churches. . . . The finery is great, one cannot discern any difference between a cobbler's wife and the wife of a prominent gentleman; most people go bare-headed; I hope to remain an exception to this custom of theirs, even though I attract everybody's attention. . . . The arts and sciences are flourishing; my husband has experienced a good deal, but never saw people work as they do here: entire houses, even four stories high, are moved here several blocks with a machine to which sometimes as many as 16 horses are hitched; foundations are loosened and then are moved in their entirety, not only frame buildings but also brick; my husband saw this himself. . . . Washings hang out on the line all night, nobody steals here; there is no need for this; no sentries in front of the houses; no night watchmen; gatebells need not ring: here are no gates; for one does not see any custom officers, no cops, only a few policemen, who look more like gentlemen, but their hat is marked in front with the word: Police. There are soldiers here but not many; handsomely dressed; volunteers, some married; they serve three days a week to keep their guns clean and to give band concerts in the city, I never heard more beautiful music. . . . Evenings everything is quiet; stores close at 9 o'clock, but open again at daybreak."

At least three organized colonies, two Protestant and one Catholic, left the Netherlands and arrived in America in the period 1846 to 1848. The Western Michigan settlement around Holland, Michigan, under Dominie A. C. Van Raalte and "numbering 450 souls" sailed from the Netherlands in April 1847 and arrived in New York and Michigan in June and July. The Pella, Iowa, Colony with eight or nine hundred persons under Dominie Henry P. Scholte arrived in Baltimore a little later and settled on a 12,000 acre tract purchased for the colony. This story is beautifully and dramatically told by Louis Adamic in his book, "From Many Lands". A Roman Catholic Colony settled in the neighborhood of Green Bay, Wisconsin, in 1848.

Migration in colonies with a religious organization seemed the safer and more desirable plan in many ways. However many emigrated as individuals or as families or groups of families with a loose and temporary organization. This latter type was the one in which the contingent of Pieter Bartholomeus de Swarte and his wife (second) and family of 13, besides a son-in-law and four grandchildren came to America. According to two documents prepared by different members of the de Swarte family group—the exact number of persons or of families is not known—the contingent left Nieuwvliet April 10, 1948. They arrived in New York on May 28th and in Milwaukee on June 12th. They moved to Town Eight, as it was called, in Milwaukee County, on January 12, 1849. The voyage across the Atlantic took thirty-eight days which was “within the ordinary time”. Here in Town Eight and Milwaukee County they made their home and here they continued to live for many years. Here many of them died and were buried in what has been known in the family as the “Fox Point” or “Town Eight” Cemetery, and which was finally marked a few years ago by a large monument—**DEDICATED TO THE MEMORY OF THE EARLY PIONEERS OF BETHLEHEM CHURCH BY THEIR DESCENDANTS 1846-1928.**

While we do not have very much specific information and tradition bearing on the fortunes and misfortunes of the de Swarte family on their voyage, we may assume that their experiences were not unlike those of others, except in minor details, or similar crossings about that time.

Transportation from Rotterdam to New York averaged about 35 guilders for each passenger according to Wabeke. Food was ordinarily provided by each family or family group for itself. This amounted to about 20 guilders additional. All cooking was done in a public kitchen on the deck and in the open air. When families pooled their food for the journey the members of the group took turns preparing the meals. In stormy weather hot meals could not be served, and no doubt, many did not care for food at such times, for seasickness was common.

Passengers were expected to share in the routine scrubbing of the deck and in the care of their own quarters. As might be expected of the Dutch this chore was done to perfection. Religious services were held on shipboard daily. The ships were dirty when the Hollanders went aboard, but long before they reached Baltimore, they were clean as the proverbial Dutch kitchens. The health officers at Baltimore were so impressed with the cleanliness of the ships that the immigrants were allowed to land without the usual inspections. A reporter for the Baltimore Sun who visited one of the ships which brought the Scholte party to America wrote, “we have seen many emigrant ships, but we never saw one more cleanly in its appearance than this, and have never seen in any ship so fine a body of emigrants”. These groups were select groups in purpose, in religious ideals and in determination.

Crossing the Atlantic in the vessels used at that time was not undertaken without fear. It has been estimated that one out of every hundred sailings ended in shipwreck, and one out of every twenty shipwrecks involved the loss of the crew and passengers. The news of the Phoenix fire disaster which took place five miles off the harbor of Sheboygan, Wisconsin, on November 21, 1847, and which brought terrible death to over one hundred of the one hundred and fifty Dutch immigrants aboard, was naturally reported in the Dutch papers in the homeland. This reduced the flow of emigrants but for only a short time. In the face of such disasters it required all the faith in God these pious Dutch possessed to begin such a voyage. Their daily prayer for safety and their hourly intercession at times in the midst of storms which tossed their ship, sustained them as they “took [the] step in God’s strength”.

Seasickness was common, and disease and death from this and other causes overtook some on the voyage. Of the Scholte colony “two aged persons and eighteen children died during the voyage”. It is estimated that in sailings from the European ports 2% to 3% died. John Hospers sailing from Rotterdam in 1849 kept a diary in which he describes a funeral at sea. “At seven o’clock the passengers come out on deck; the first mate fastens the child’s body [wrapped and sewed in canvas] to a canvas sack filled with stones and places the corpse on a board, which lies with one end resting on a cask and the other extending overboard. The captain stands at one end near the cask, reads solemnly in high German, and then commands the seamen who stand on opposite sides of the board to let the corpse slide into the water. All stand with uncovered heads. At the captain’s word Maasdam announces the singing of Psalm 103:8 and 9. The solemnity is impressive.”

On arriving in New York or other American ports the unwary immigrants were in danger of being fleeced of their money by individuals or groups, both American and Dutch, who tried to take advantage of their ignorance of customs, costs, and money exchange. Most of the immigrants were warned in advance, and societies organized for the protection and guidance of the Hollanders were formed by those of Dutch ancestry who had been in this country longer or were born here.

As compared with other nationals there were not many Holland immigrants even during the “Great Migration”. From 1846 to 1850 it is estimated there were very few more than 12,000 Dutch who migrated to America. During the same period there were 450,000 Germans and nearly a million Irish who came to America. As compared with the normal annual increase in the population of Holland the emigrants

amounted to "less than one-tenth of the yearly increase". This was about 1 in 1,500 persons annually. The majority of the emigrants were people of small means—"minder goede". Some of the very poor who were not able to pay transportation were helped by those who could. Sometimes the debtors placed themselves under contract to work for a certain length of time without pay or until such transportation advances were covered.

In a few years the industrious de Swarte descendants became prosperous. In a few decades they assumed positions of prominence in business and professional life. Building contractors, architects, painters, merchants, traders, bankers, lawyers, professional men, artisans and other crafts in Milwaukee numbered among them successful Dutch. In every walk of life could be found the descendants of the little company which settled at Fox Point. The majority of them however as in our general population were farmers. The impression one receives in reading the correspondence connected with gathering the material for this family record is that there is a very much larger proportion of professional men among the descendants than is to be found in the general population. For example, at least four of the de Swarte descendants are known to have been connected in technical capacity with the Oak Ridge project during the war.

To supplement this brief historical comment those who may be interested in fuller accounts of the migration of which the de Swarte family was only a small part, are referred to excellent accounts to be found in many libraries. I recommend a 60 page booklet "Hollanders—The Development of Their Objectives in Europe and America" by Rev. Jacob Van der Muelen, available by writing to him in Holland, Mich. Wabeka's "Dutch Emigration to North America 1624-1860" published by the Netherlands Information Bureau, 10 Rockefeller Plaza, New York 20, N. Y., contains a fine bibliography as well as a fine historical summary. Arnold Mulder's "Americans from Holland" published by Lippincott, 227-231 S. 6th Street, Philadelphia 5, Pa., in 1947, is highly praised in reviews of the book.

So far as we are able to discover there are no pictures of Pieter Bartholomeus de Swarte (1787-1860) and of his first wife, Jozina Haartsen (1788-1826) extant.
Married April 28, 1813. Jozina died October 5, 1826.

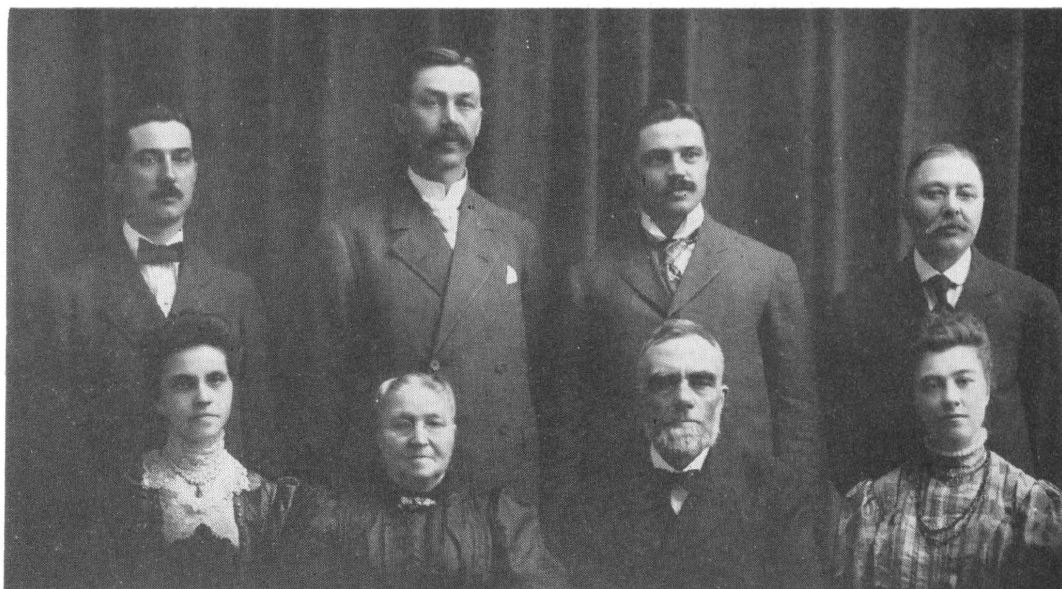

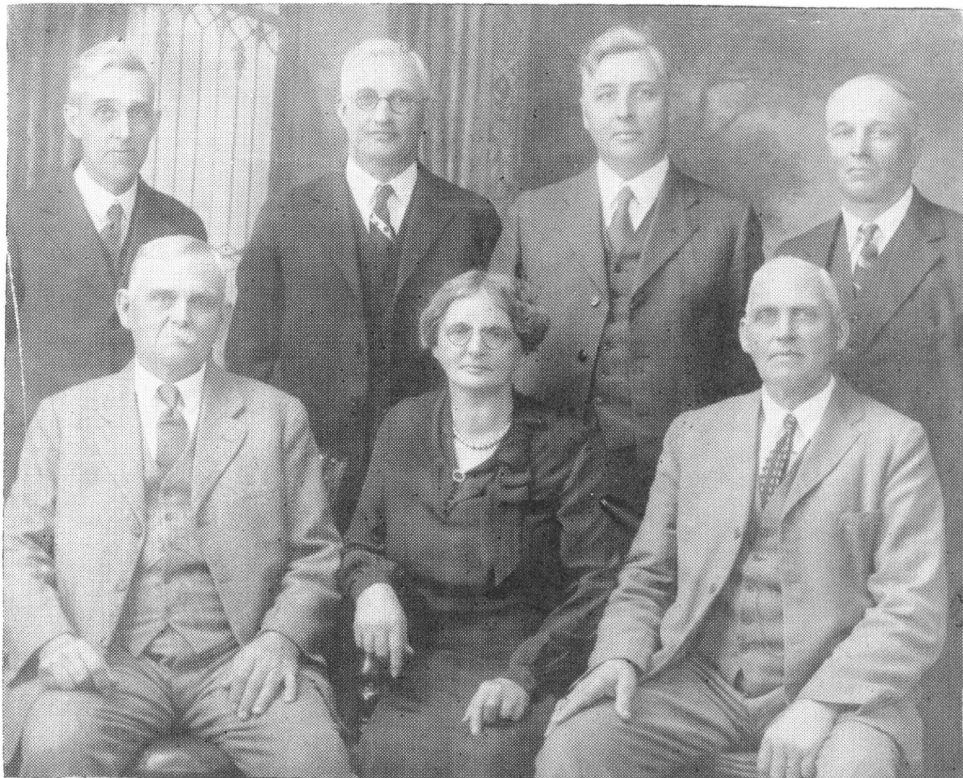

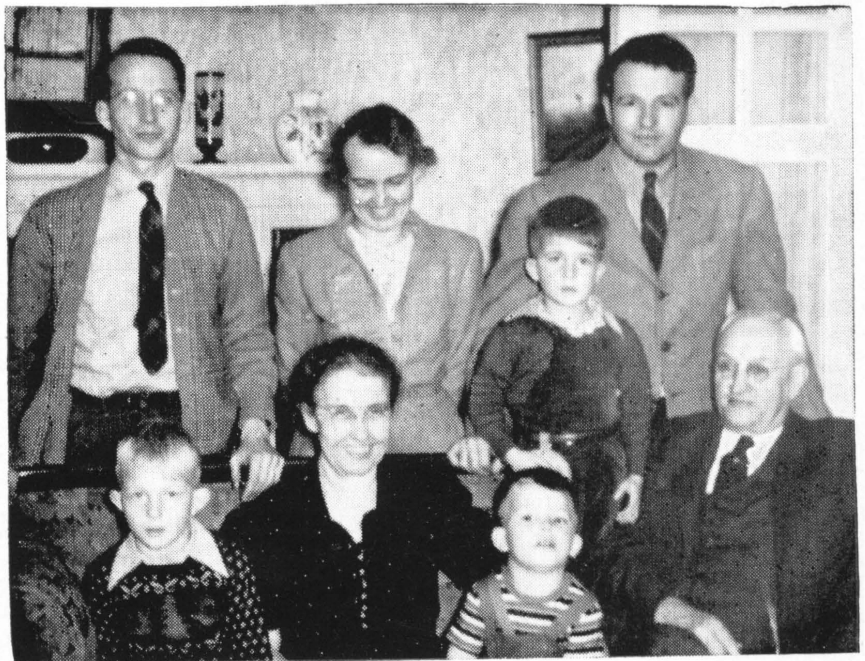

In 1927 the compiler of this genealogical record visited the family and community burial ground in Fox Point, Wisconsin, for the first time. The lot was unkept. The demand for residential lots in this fine development and the real estate interests were pressing hard on the cemetery. Some of the grave stones and wooden grave markers had already been removed and it looked as if by neglect and default this sacred spot would be obliterated. The attention of some of the relatives who lived in Milwaukee was called to this situation. Steps were taken to guard against further encroachments upon the resting place of the hallowed dead. The plot was fenced. A monument was erected. Stones were straightened and the whole was put in excellent condition. During the summer of 1947 another visit was paid to the cemetery by the author of this story. It was a glorious experience inducing a solemn dedication of life to the ideals and the faith of those to whom we owe so much.



The inscription on the monument reads: "Dedicated to the Memory of the Early Pioneers of Bethlehem Church by their Descendants, 1846-1928"

On a piece of heavy paper 14 x 17 inches Johannes de Swarte prepared a document in 1857 which gives the date of marriage, voyage to America, and the children born to him. This document has been turned over to me by (2008) John Vennema, grandson of Johannes de Swarte.

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PIETER BARTHOLOMEUS de SWARTE DESCENDANTS

After this booklet went to press I received the following account of the migration of the de Swarte family from Mrs. Jennie Leindecker and her daughter Dorothy who prepared it as the substance of the tradition which had been given them, perhaps through the Koeslag family line. The variation from the two documents given in the appendix may indicate that the families on reaching New York separated and came to Milwaukee at different dates. It is included in this booklet because it gives concrete experiences of the party of immigrants.

"In 1848 four or five families, including the De Swartes, Vrewinks, Koeslaga, and Telliers, embarked from Netherlands (Amsterdam) for New York. Many became seasick and one infant died and was buried at sea.

Arandt Derk Koeslag acted as overseer on the voyage and prepared the meals. The party landed in New York about 33 days after leaving Amsterdam.

The families, remaining together, made their way to Milwaukee, Wisconsin, arriving there on November 4, 1848. The Koeslag family, after arriving in Milwaukee, got as far as 10th and Galena Streets and the next day, on November 5, Henry John Koeslag was born. (These strangers who took the family in said later they wouldn't have done it had they known a baby was to be born.) The family later lived with the Abraham Guequierre family who operated a livery barn.

The men of these four families later 'blazed' their way to Town 8, which is about 8 miles from Milwaukee, to choose the location where they wanted to settle their families. Taking claim to some land near the shore of Lake Michigan, they built their homes. On a half acre of land, given by Mr. Vrewink to these settlers, a building was erected which was used as a school and church. A part of this land was also used as a cemetery.

When Maria Koeslag was about five years old, the settlers in Town 8, now known as Fox Point, fled to Milwaukee for several days when word was received that "the Indians are coming".

The families tilled their land and some of the men, including Pieter Tellier, also made a living in a brick yard there.

Many years later the Vrewink family sold their property to a Dr. Schneider, and Dr. Schneider later donated this land to Milwaukee County to be used as a County Park, called Doctors' Park. Because many of the original families had moved away at the time this was being developed into a park area, the heirs of these original settlers were given the alternative of keeping up the cemetery or having it vanish and the land included with the remainder of the property which Dr. Schneider had donated. A Mr. John Cappon, about the year 1927, took personal charge of contacting the heirs of the families buried in the cemetery and many of the families donated to the cause and a beautiful monument was erected, dedicated to the settlers who were buried in Bethlehem cemetery.

Mr. Cappon also donated a wire mesh fence to enclose the cemetery. The cemetery has been kept up since and more lots sold for burial for the descendants of these families." (Letter dated June 24, 1948)

Note: The compiler of this genealogical record will be glad to receive other traditions and accounts which have come down through the generations giving some details of the voyage, the settlement, and any other experiences of the families in this party. C.V.
