THE DOYLE FAMILY OF HARPSWELL, MAINE

AND DESCENDANTS

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According to the data preserved by the descendants and others, there were six Moyle brothers who located in the northern part of Harpswell, Maine., two miles south of the Brunswick, Maine, town line. The farm was carried on in a very energetic manner. The names of these brothers were: Jotham Doyle, who removed to .another town; and of whom no data has been preserved; Elisha Deyle, who removed to Lisbon, Maine, and was a worthy citizen there, marrying at Harpswell, Vaine, March 6, 1786, Mercy Dunning, who was been Aug. 17, 1764, and died April 17, 1936, no data of the family found; Elijah Deylemwhe is said to have removed from Harpswell, Maine, to an island near Portland, Maine; the ear marks of his cattle were recorded at Harpswell, June 24,1778; enlisted in the Revolutionary War, May 17,1775, a private in Capt. Curtis's company; ne further data found; Captain Jonathan Deyle, James Doyle, Jr., and Michael Doyle, whose records are given below this list. All records show that these brothers were of the same hardy, patriotic type as the other well-known pioneer settlers of Warpswell, Maine. They are said to have removed to Harpswell from Salem, Mass. This would seem to be correct, as the brother, James Doyle, enlisted at Salem, Mass., in the Revolutionary War. The name of the father of these worthy sens is given as James Doyle, but the name of the mether has not been stated.

CAPTAIN JONATHAN DOYLE, Born 1760; died at Bowdoin, Maine, Nov. 2,1788, aged 28 years; buried in the Old South Cemetery at Bowdoin, Maine, beside his wife. He enlisted as a privateer at an early

date in the Revolutionary War. This vessel had been at sea but a few days when she was captured by an English man of war, where he was kept till the close of the war. He then returned to Harpswell, Maine, but his hardships had been so severe that he was never strong. Soon after, he removed to a farm at Rowdoin, Vaine. Married Jan. 15, 1784, Huldah Randall, b. Harpswell, Me., Nov. 7, 1764; d. at Bowdoin, Me., Dec. 13, 1849, aged 85 years and 26 days; the daughter of Major Paul Randall and Mary McFarland, and a woman of sterling qualities.

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THE RECORDS OF JAMES DOYLE, Jr., HARPSWELL, MAINE.

James Doyle, Jr. Statement of relatives, "He enlisted on a privateer at Salem, Mass., early in the Revolutionary War. The vessel had been at sea only four days when she was captured by a British man-off -War, who took all the men to served on board their ship. He was on board for some seven years. Was then taken to England, and pair off. As he could find no vessel going to a Northern port in America he went to the West Indies, and from thence to Boston. He had been gone about nine years, and his people had never heard from him. It was joyous time when he walked into the old home. He built a good house on the Doyle Farm at N. Harpswell, Me., After the death of his wife he went to Bangor, Me., with his son James Doyle. He was a fine man and highly esteemed by all who knew him."

Married at Harpswell, Me., Jan 6, 1785 Anna Dunning who was born at York, Me., Sept 17, 1756; d at Harpswell, Me., Sept 20, 1792; the daughter of Deacon Andrew Dunning and Hannah Shepherd, and a fine representative of this famous Dunning Family.
