I. Emigrant Nicholas Hale (Heale, Heil, Hails, Hail), died 1657; York Co., Va., 1648; Lancaster Co., Va., 1651-53.

Married Mary \_\_\_\_\_ (maybe Travers ?), and had issue: George, John, Francis, Joseph, Richard, Nicholas and Mary King.

I have been told Lord Baltimore gave this family a grant of land.

II. George Hale (Heale), 1647-1697, married before 1682, Ellen Rogers (daughter of John and Ellen Rogers), died 1710. George was a Burgess in 1659; lived in Lunenburg Co., Va. Had issue: Nicholas, Hannah (married Col. William Ball), Capt. George (married Catherine Chinn), John (unmarried), Joseph (no issue), Ellen (married John Opie), Elizabeth (married William Davenport), Sarah (married Newman Brockenbrough), and William (married Priscilla Downman and had a large family. One son, George, married Sarah Smith).

III. Nicholas Hale, 1680- March 29, 1730, married Frances Broad, Baltimore Co., Md. Had issue:

Nicholas, Jr. was in Baltimore Co., Md. in 1730, emigrated from Baltimore to Augusta Co., Va. in 1748, was in Lunenburg Co. 1749, Halifax Co., 1752, and Bedford Co. Had issue: Nicholas, Susanna, Mary Ann, Shadrack, Meshack, Abednego, John, and possibly Francis. (Nicholas, Jr., Shadrack, Meshack and Abednego emigrated to Washington Co., Tenn. ca 1780-1790.).

Nicholas Hale III married Ruth \_\_\_\_\_ (maybe Acres ?) and had issue: Richard, William, Nicholas, Jr. IV, Amon, Joshua, Elizabeth, Ruth, Sarah, John, Nathan. Some of this family emigrated to Rowan Co., N.C., Giles Co. and back to Baltimore Co., Md. before emigrating to Washington Co., Tenn.

Nicholas Hale III, Shadrack, Meshack and <sup>Abednego</sup>~~George~~ Hale, four brothers, and I believe a cousin - some of these coming from Bedford Co., Va. <sup>George</sup>

George Hale, Jr. was the son of George Hale, Sr. of Baltimore Co., Md. George, Jr. married Ann Grant (daughter of Alexander and Eliza or Elizabeth Grant).

Alexander Grant died in 1738 in Baltimore Co., Md., leaving two minor daughters, Ann and Mary. Ann married George Hale, Jr. and Mary married Lloyd Ford, who came to Washington Co., Tenn. and witnessed the will of Nicholas Hale, Sr. III.

George Hale became George, Sr. in Washington Co., Tenn. I find Meshack Hale, brother of Nicholas, Abednego and Shadrack. This Meshack Hale, born 1738, married Catherine Gibson (daughter of James) of Bedford Co., Va. Their children were: Nathan, Nicholas, John, William (married Sally Brown), Susanna, Nancy, Elizabeth, and Stephen Gibson. They emigrated to Davidson Co., Tenn., where he died.

Shadrack Hale had a son Meshack Hale, born 1759 in Lunenburg Co., Va. He married Mary Kincheloe in Tenn. They emigrated to Washington Co., Tenn, which was later Greene Co. Their children were: Lewis, Nancy Haws, Charles, Enoch, Sarah, Mary, Jackson, Meshack, Jr., James and Elizabeth.

The above Meshack line can't be mine; wrong list of children.

I find one other Meshack Hale, son of George Hale, Sr. in Washington Co., Tenn. Since the two other Meshack Hales can't be my ancestors, I have taken this Meshack Hale as my ancestor.

George Hale married ca 1753, Ann Grant in Baltimore Co., Md. Since he was George, Jr. then and George Hale, who married Elizabeth Chawfinch in 1735 in Baltimore is the only George Hale I can find who would fit in here (to be George Hale, Sr.), I believe George Hale and Elizabeth Chawfinch could be the parents of George Hale, Jr., who married Ann Grant. Here is a partial list of their children:

Meshack Hale (I'm assuming my Meshack is this one since I've ruled out the other Meshacks), son of George; 1793 had 420 acres on East side of Buffalo Ridge on Sinking Creek. Land Records, 1787: Meshack Hale (son of George), 420 acres. Meshack Hale died 1824, Washington Co, Tenn. His heirs (no wife mentioned) were:

Relatives say this Matlock family is of Scotch descent. I find Zachariah Matlock in 1785 Halifax Co., Va. Tax List. There is a Zachariah Matlock in Louisa Co., Va., who was a Revolutionary War soldier, married Lucy Wash and emigrated to Caldwell Co., Ky. He is not my ancestor.

A John Matlock, Louisa Co., Va., 1789, left a will naming a wife Ann, son Zachariah and deceased daughter Elizabeth Shelton's children.

I find John and Jane Matlock as head of households in Halifax Co., Va. in 1790, also Matthew and Henry.

The earliest I have my Zachariah Matlock is in 1790 Tax List in Capt. Stone's Company - 150 acres on Boons Creek in 1795, Washington Co., Tenn. Zachariah Matlock had wife Eady in Washington Co., Tenn. He died in 1837. Their children were:

Isham Matlock was a soldier in the War of 1812. He enlisted in Carter Co., Tenn., served from Oct. 18, 1813 to Jan. 18, 1814 as a Pvt. in Capt. Jesse Coles' Company of Tenn. Militia. He also served as Cpl. in Capt. Henry Hunter's Company.

Isham (Isom) Matlock, born ca 1782-86, Va., died 1874, Phelps Co., Mo., married Nancy Ellen Hale, born 1787, Md. Isham lived with son Jesse in 1870. Their children:

Most of these families emigrated by ox cart from Tenn. to Mo.

John Matlock, born ca 1809, <sup>Washington</sup> Davidson Co., Tenn., died 1900, married Apr. 12, 1827, Jonesboro, Tenn., Melinda Ellis, born ca 1810, Tenn. (her parents also born in Tenn.), died 1898. They emigrated to Crawford Co., Mo. in 1839, and lived at Dillon, Mo. After the Civil War they crossed the river on the ice to Norman Creek area, 15 miles Southeast of Rolla. In 1848 John Matlock was Justice of the Peace, was in the first Phelps Co. Court, Nov., 1857. They spent the last years of their lives on the Simily farm, where they are buried in unmarked graves in the Simily Cemetery.

"Melinda Ellis Matlock was very old, sitting on a chair by the kitchen door in her little bonnet, as remembered by my mother, Opal Gahr Duckels when she was four years old at her Grandmother Endimile Matlock Dean Adams' home. Great Grandma Dean had light blue eyes, was short and plump. She loved to hide things from her daughters and was quite a tease. She told me the names of her parents.

I made this list of children from the 1850 Census and memory of family members. I can't find a Bible list. If anyone has a Bible, they haven't told me.

My Great Grandma had a sister, born in Mo., married about 1860, \_\_\_\_\_ Dean. She died young, leaving two children, John Sod, who married Mary Wallace Herritt and Laura, who married Hamilton Adams, his first wife, and had Susie Adams Hawkins and Nora. These children, Laura Dean and John Dean, born 1862-1864, were living in their Grandparents' home - John Matlock - in 1880. I believe this sister was Sarah Jane, who married Moses Dean Jan. 1, 1860. I have no proof of this. One sister was called Ellen. One sister married John Bell, parents of Tomie and Nannie. They moved to Boston, Mass. I can't tell which of the above married \_\_\_\_\_ Bell and who was called Ellen. The initials in the Census could be wrong; some were wrong that I have corrected. Initials were given instead of names in 1850 in the Mo. Census.

Aaron Dean, born ca 1782 in N.C., was living in Davidson Co., Tenn. in the 1830 Census. He was a carpenter in the 1850 Crawford Co., Mo. Census.

Moses Dean, born Mar. 6, 1804, Wilkes Co., N.C., died Dec. 22, 1857, Crawford Co., Mo., married Oct. 27, 1826, Nashville, Tenn. to Mary Benkley, born Apr. 4, 1810, Tenn., died Oct. 15, 1868, Mo. Moses had 250 acres of land on the North side of the Cumberland River on Dry Fork of Little Marrowbone Creek - Northwest corner of Davidson Co., Tenn. - probably later was Cheatham Co. - sold to Eli Brinkley in 1842. Emigrated to Crawford Co., Mo. in 1844. I believe Aaron Dean was the father of Moses. I have no proof except my grandmother, when she was quite old, told me she had a grandfather, Aaron Dean, who was Irish. (She would have meant great grandfather). My aunt said he was a cousin of President Thomas Jefferson. Robert Dean was a brother of Moses Dean. Aaron Dean had a son Aaron, Jr.

Gahr Genealogy - The Family Name was Jahr, pronounced Yahr in Germany. The letter "G" is pronounced "J", so the difference in pronunciation may be the reason the name was changed in the U.S.; I do not know what year.

George Jahr married Rosine Bachman. They lived at Spora, Saxony, Germany. He was a Hutman, maker of hats. They had at least five children, viz:

My great grandfather, Valentine Gahr, Sr. was short, had brown curly hair and dark eyes. Great grandmother Amelia (Emilie) had fine brown hair, brown eyes and sallow skin. She used to say to my Grandmother Minnie Gahr, "Now Minna, now Minna" when Grandma wanted to correct Uncle Myron. She talked in broken German and English. Grandpa George Gahr had brown curly hair, brown eyes, was a large, sturdy build. He had a slow, easy going way about him, a wonderful disposition, and was a hard worker. He was a farmer and loved gardening, raising chickens and his truck patches. Grandma Minnie Dean Gahr was of small build, had auburn hair, very fair skin, light blue eyes - a quick temper, and quite witty.

When "Pop Goes The Weasel" came over the radio, she'd grab me and we'd dance around the kitchen floor. Both loved their family and enjoyed them. Grandpa used to come get the grandchildren and great grandchildren to take home with him for a day or more, sometimes taking them in his wheelbarrow. He had so much garden, he'd bring his produce to his children and grandchildren. I can remember him sitting and peeling fruit and fixing vegetables for us to eat after he'd raised them. He'd have another breakfast each place he stopped. We didn't ever tell Grandma about this. He wasn't allowed to smoke or chew at home, but he'd hide his chewing tobacco in various spots so he could enjoy this away from his house.

Grandma loved to dress up, to sew, enjoyed raising flowers, piecing quilts and cooking. I can still taste her burnt sugar cakes and sugar cookies.
