CHAPTER I

DOUGHERTYS

Leading Family in Ireland

As a result of communications with National Library of Ireland, and Trinity College Library, Dublin, the following information of the Dougherty family has been ascertained:

Flamhan Doherty, a brother of Muriatus Doherty who is 99 on the (No. 1) Pedigree was the ancestor of O'Dochartaigh; anglicised Docharty, Dogherty, Doherty, Dougherty. and O'Dougherty. It is very important to know that all these names are of the same family of people. O'Dogherty was an important family in Donegal county, and was also in Mayo county, Ireland, from the 11th to the end of the 16th Century. O'Dougherty in Donegal county, was one of the most important families in Ireland at the beginning of the 17th Century. In the O'Dourvan Edition of the Annals of the Four Masters there are copious references to the O'Dougherty's leading Donegal family at the close of the 17th Century. A bit of important Irish and Dougherty history is found in this connection.

Dougherty Armory Motto: "Arm Dutches" (For my hereditary right). The Coat of Arms of the Dougherty family in Ireland as given by Burke's General Heraldry of England, Scotland and Ireland, interpreted means "I hope for my Country."

JAMES DOUGHERTY

An Immigrant From Ireland

MY GRANDFATHER, JAMES DOUGHERTY, was born in Ireland June 11, 1771, and came to America in young manhood with his brothers, William and John, and sister Nancy. He was married to Elizabeth Hamilton May 27, 1796. She was born at Ramsey, in Wise county, Va., July 1, 1779. Her father and mother sleep at that place. The young husband and wife settled on a farm on Copper Creek some three miles west of Nickelsville, and reared a large and respected family that proved to be as good citizens as this part of the county has produced. They moved later to a farm north of Copper Creek, near Valley Creek, where they spent the remainder of their lives and were buried.

My Grandfather Dougherty was a hatter by trade. I can remember that when he had made a lot of hats, he would get on his horse and go out and sell them. He would sometimes go to Russell county and sell them out.

My Grandmother, Elizabeth Dougherty, died April 1, 1845, and was the first to be laid on the hill on the old home place. Grandfather, James Dougherty, died December 14, 1857, and was laid to rest in the cemetery on the hill. Grandmother was allotted 66 years and 3 months and Grandfather 86 years, 6 months and 3 days. They were both Methodist in their religious views, and especially was Grandmother a great

Christian woman. Even in her old age, she would walk two or three miles to attend preaching services, on week days at that. She closed a long and useful life in the service of God and the Church, and died in full triumph of Christian faith.

I had intended to say nothing about Grandfather's brothers and sister, but I find recorded in his old Bible that Nancy died in Russell county, February 1, 1847, where she had married Samuel Leese (later a Senator in the Virginia Assembly) and settled west of Lebanon. William died July 6, 1847, and was buried on the hill by the side of Grandfather. His wife died June 1871, and was laid to rest by his side. Their daughter, Ruth T. Dougherty, (the old school teacher), died June 12, 1871, and was buried by the side of her mother.

Nancy Dougherty=Harris

NANCY DOUGHERTY was born March 9, 1798, married to John Harris by Robert Killgore February 5, 1822, died January 8, 1863, and was buried on the farm on Copper Creek on which they had settled and raised their family. In her church relation, she was a member of the Missionary Baptist Church. Nancy was a sweet spirited Christian woman, broad in her views, a great shouter and church worker. She died in full assurance of a glorious life after death.

Elizabeth, Phebe, Charles W., and James A, are the names of their four children.

Margaret Dougherty=Allen

MARGARET DOUGHERTY was born February 22, 1800, married to William Allen by Robert Killgore October 3, 1816. After living in Scott county, Virginia, for some time, they moved to Tennessee and died there. I fail to find the date of her death. She was a sweet spirited Christian woman, a member of the Methodist Church. She lived a pure life and died a triumphant death, leaving the assurance that she was going to spend a happy eternity.

Their children are John, James, Nancy, Bettie, Margaret, Sallie, Polly, Jennie, and Sena.

John Dougherty

JOHN DOUGHERTY was born January 8, 1803,

and was married to Patsy Wampler, by Robert Killgore, December 21, 1824. He died December 16, 1856, and was buried on his home place on Copper Creek. He was a member of the Methodist Church, a good spirited Christian man who every body seemed to love.

Their eleven children are Elizabeth, William, Sallie, Nathan B., Rosanna, J. Monroe, George W., James, Louemma, Hiram T., and Jesse M.

Sarah Dougherty-Killgore

SARAH DOUGHERTY was born April 20, 1805, and was married to Charles Killgore by Robert Killgore, January 24, 1824. I fail to find any record of her death. She was buried at the old home place where her father and mother were buried. She was a member of the Primitive Baptist Church, a good Christian woman, always seemed to enjoy herself, even in her affliction with rheumatism. I have seen her happy and shout when she had to be carried on her bed.

Their eleven children are Hiram, Bettie, Rebecca, Jim, Henry M. C., Nathan D., Nancy, Sallie, John, Martha, and William.

Elizabeth Dougherty-McGlothlin

ELIZABETH DOUGHERTY was born October 22, 1807, married to Israel McGlothlin September 18, 1823, died December 7, 1887 and was buried at her son Nathan's, Stevensville, Texas. She was a Methodist, a fine Christian woman, who was always ready to do her duty as a Christian worker.

Sallie, Tilda, Sylvester P., Morgan, Margaret, Martha, Henry, Elizabeth, Nathan, and Eliza are the names of their children.

Nathan Dougherty

NATHAN DOUGHERTY, my father, the sixth child of my Grandfather, James Dougherty, was born March 7, 1810, and was married to Susan McConnell February 25, 1836. He died a very triumphant death July 14, 1866.

My mother, Susan McConnell-Dougherty, the youngest child of George McConnell and Susan Snavely-McConnell, and twin sister to Samuel R. McConnell, was born October 1814, and died March 5, 1891. My father and mother were Methodist in their church relations, great and good Christian people. They were buried at the old home place.

The names of their seven children are Eliza, Carson, Sylvester P., William C., John, Mary, and George M.

Susannah Dougherty-Harris

SUSANNAH DOUGHERTY was born March 20, 1812, and was married to William Harris August 27, 1833. She died April 24, 1895, and was buried on the farm some two miles west of Nickelsville on which they had settled. She was a good Christian woman, a member of the Methodist Church.

They had six children, James, Charles W. S., John D., Nathan M., Lucy, and Sarah.

James Dougherty

JAMES DOUGHERTY was born January 27, 1816, died November 24, 1862, and was buried at the old home place where father and mother were buried. "Nor could'st thou wish Couch more magnificent. The hills, the vales, the venerable woods, the flowing streams, the meadows green, the beautiful decorations all of the tomb of man; and the golden sun, the planets, all the infinite hosts of heaven are shining on the abode of death".

William Dougherty

WILLIAM DOUGHERTY was born February 13, 1817, married to Sarah Jarvis January 29, 1839, died September 8, 1891, and was buried on his farm near the mouth of Valley Creek. He was a member of the Methodist Church, and was a good Christian man.

Nathan, Patton, Daniel, Lizzie, Henry W., Mary, Samuel, and John C. are the names of his children.

Lucy Dougherty-McConnell

LUCY DOUGHERTY was born May 30, 1819, died October 23, 1890, and was buried at their home place on Copper Creek. She was married to Dr. A. B. McConnell December 4, 1836, and to this union were born fourteen children, Sallie, Elizabeth, Milton, Martha, Polly, George, Eliza, Serepta, Rev. Sylvester W., Abram B., Florence, J. Hop, Meigs, and Nathan D.

Aunt Lucy was a real sweet-spirited, good Christian woman.

Jane Dougherty

JANE DOUGHERTY was born March 28, 1832, and died when a little girl. I find no record of the date of her death. Yet she probably has been of greater service than any, gone on before as a messenger, to welcome her many kindred and loved ones. Her folks are now with her, and she is happy at the windows of heaven, clapping her hands, cheering her people and others as they enter from over the river.

Martha Dougherty-McConnell

MARTHA DOUGHERTY was born July 18, 1825, married to George D. McConnell August 6, 1840, died March 13, 1872, and was buried in the cemetery near Morgan's Chapel. She was a noble spirited, good Christian woman.

Their thirteen children are Elizabeth, Polly, Susie, Lucy, Sylvester P., Nathan, Henry S., George J., Louemma, Louisa, J. Monroe, W. Sevier, and Charles Y.



CHAPTER V

William C. Dougherty

WILLIAM C. DOUGHERTY was born December 21, 1845, and died January 20, 1928, aged eighty-two years and twenty-nine days. His body was interred in the family cemetery by friends and relatives on January 22, Rev. W. C. Thompson, a former pastor, assisted by Rev. W. L. Norwood, conducted the funeral.

He was the son of Nathan Dougherty and the grandson of the first Dougherty to migrate from Ireland to this country. The elder man was a hatter by trade. His mother was Susan McConnell, daughter of the first McConnell to settle among these hills. On March 21, 1867, he was married to Nancy Dingus. To this union were born eleven children---Nathan, John, Carson, Logan, and Wilson Dougherty, and Mrs. W. P. Blankenbecler, Mrs. E. W. McConnell, Mrs. James Bevins, Mrs. C. H. Fraley, Mrs. L. B. Colgin, and Mrs. Ernest Ramey----all of whom survive him except Mrs. Blankenbecler.

He was converted to the Christian faith during a revival held at Farley's Chapel about fifty years ago by Rev. F. D. Crumley. Shortly

afterwards he affiliated himself with the Methodist Episcopal Church, South. In him this Church found its most loyal member of this section. For more than half a century, serving as steward, that man guided the destiny of that divine organization along the rugged valleys, across the barren hills until to-day it is second to none in this country. It has been truly said of him that "he was the bishop of stewards of the mountain people."

The influence for good that William C. Dougherty wielded cannot be fully appreciated to-day nor to-morrow; only eternity will show the harvest of his labors. Men who grew up with him say that even as a child he was a gentleman. Those principles of Christ taught him at his mother's knee ever guided his footsteps, ruled his every action, and to-day the brightness of his deeds is a shining halo ever beckoning to a higher plane of Christian activity. Surely God must have smiled when he said to him: "Well done, good and faithful servant."

The many men and women whose lives he has brightened will miss his words of cheer and wholesome advice. The Church will miss his unparalleled influence. The neighborhood has lost its best neighbor and citizen. The youth of our land, whose penetrating eyes are eagerly searching the ever-changing horizon for that trail leading into infinite happiness and joy, will find in the life of Uncle William a pathway well marked with the signals, honesty, integrity,

faith, hope, and charity, which will inevitably guide their wandering footsteps into a land of eternal light. An ideal life is finished. A haven of rest awaits him. ---M. D. ROIE.
