He married LYDIA TRUE, 1790-1854 who was of the Collins--True family of that town Her parental ancestry was from Henry True of Salem, Mass. and Israel Pike. Their son Henry Jr. 1644-1735, (Pike-True) married Jane Brad bury 16 March 1667 Henry True, Jr was a Freeman of Salisbury, Mass. 1675. Jabez 1685-1749

(Bradbury—True) married Sarah Tappan 8 Janu ary 1707. Jabez Jr., 1714—1770 (Tappan—True) married Sarah Eaton 1740 and they moved to New Gloucester 1756. Jabez 3d 1750—1823 (Eaton—True) married Abigail Collins who died 1798. Lydia was the eleventh of her twelve children and of the sixth generation in New England, Christepher Collins, 1608—1666, was of Boston 1640 and removed in 1664 to Scarboro, Mainewhere he died. Abigail Collins was thus of the fifth generation in New England.

Perkins was named for a brother of his father who died without issue and probably spouseless. His ancestry was from Sylvester and Susanna Eveleth, Boston 1642. They moved to Gloucester, Cape Ann 1646 where they died. Joseph their son 1640-1745 (11) married Mary Bragg and lived in Ipswich, Mass. Isaac [3] 1676 1755, married Sarah [Parkman?] and moved to the home of his grandfather Sylvester in Gloucester about 1698. Isaac [4] son of Isaac and Sarah married Elizabeth Parsons and died 1759. Capt. Nathaniel [5] was born in Gloucester, Mass. 23 August 1736. Parsons-Eveleth, went to New Gloucester in 1756 and married Sarah Mason. After her death he married again and Mary Glass bore him five sons of whom Perkins was the second. Capt. Nathaniel Eveleth died 23 November 1824 in New Gloucester.
