Doubtless this Genealogy of the ELA family would be incomplete without an acknowledgment of its incompleteness. therefore to say that after more than thirty years, during which the materials have been accumulating, I am yet unable to fill all the Doubtless also many errors will be gaps in the family records. found in the dates and names and many facts will be found wanting I can only plead the limitations which should have been recorded. of human nature and assure the kindred, near and distant, that diligent use has been made of all available information. to make acknowledgment of my obligation to ELAS who have aided me in the preparation of the work and interested themselves in securing its publication. Especial acknowledgment is due to Mrs. Emily C. Ela of Rochester, Wis., Richard Ela of Cambridge, Mass., Alfred Ela of Boston, and to James H. Ela of Manchester, N. H. I shall be very greatly obliged to any who will take the trouble to send me any additional information or corrections of any errors dis-D. H. ELA. covered.

INTRODUCTION.

The name ELA first appears in the records of the town of Haverhill, Mass., in 1656, and has been continued in that town till this day. Of the origin of the name and family earlier than above stated, no trace has thus far been discovered. I have been unable to find the name among English surnames. Inquiry through "Notes and Queries," London, has failed to bring information on The most probable supposition is that it is a corruption of Ely, a name which appears among the early immigrants into the Salem Colony-or possibly of Healy, a name quite common in the region of Amesbury, or that the three are alike forms of the Norman Elié. In the history of Dunbarton, N. H., occurs the name Paul Ela once. Elsewhere the name is Paul Healy, and his descendants spell their name Healy. A somewhat numerous Ela family in Fryeburg, Me., are descended from Joseph Healy, of Dun-There is no connection between this family and that of Israel Ela, though the descendants of both lived at the same time in Conway, N. H., and both spelled their name Ela.

Richard Ela, Esq., of Washington, D. C., in a letter to this writer, suggested that the names Healy, Ely and Ela have a common origin in the French, Elié, a family which has representatives in Gen. Sir John Elley of the British army, and in the distinguished Frenchman, Elié de Beaumont. Earlier, however, than these, Ela was the Christian name of a good many Norman ladies, e. g. Ela, heiress of Salisbury, wife of William Longsword.

Whatever its origin, the Haverhill family has uniformly retained the spelling Ela through all the history of that town.

Daniel Ela settled in Haverhill as early as 1656, being then married and about 23 or 24 years old. He continued to reside in Haverhill till 1698, soon after which time he removed to Boston, where he died, aged 80, December 22, 1710. His wife, Elizabeth, died in Haverhill July 7, 1698. His will, dated December 17, 1710, left his estate to his wife Eleanor.

He had a son John to whom, before his second marriage, he sold his Haverhill estate, retaining a life interest.

John married Jane —— and had two daughters. Elizabeth died in her infancy and Jane, born February, 1704, married, June 13, 1823, Nathaniel Doane, of Cape Cod. John having no male issue, the name is not preserved in his line.

Daniel Ela seems to have been a man of energetic, perhaps aggressive, character, and of ability and influence in the town. He accumulated a considerable property, for those times, and was frequently entrusted with office by his fellow townsmen. In 1662 and again in 1673-74 he is town committee to lay out lands. He is prosecuting attorney—perhaps we should, in modern phrase, say townagent—in 1674-75, and also town auditor of accounts of the In 1680 he is committee on parsonage, and also to selectmen. procure an assistant for the now aged pastor. In 1699 he is moderator of town meeting. His homestead adjoined the meeting house lot and the old graveyard, now the cemetery on Water street. 1667-68 he is a licensed inn-holder, and in 1680 is fined for illegal sale of liquor. He is once fined for swearing and using reviling speeches, and once for ill-treatment of his wife; but none of these things prevent his serving the town in the matter of procuring a minister. His deed of homestead to his son John describes him as a tanner.

There is no positive proof that Daniel Ela was the father of Israel, but its probability is very great. First, the name is very rare, practically unknown as a surname elsewhere. It is therefore doubly improbable that two unrelated families bearing this unusual name should have been located in one town. If the name is a corruption of some other, the probability is still further increased. Their respective ages make it probable that they are father and son. Daniel is forty-four or five in 1677, when Israel is twenty-one. He also has a son, John, younger than Israel but probably older than twelve, the age then of his future wife. Israel was neighbor to Daniel, and their names appear on the same legal documents. Israel died in 1700, nearly ten years before Daniel, and neither he nor any of his five children is mentioned in Daniel's will; but neither is John nor any of his family. As it has not been possible to prove any relationship between Daniel and Israel, this Genealogy begins with Israel.

NOTE TO INTRODUCTION.

Mr. Alfred Ela makes the following note to Introduction, page 3: "Being convinced that the suggested origins of our surname were each practically impossible, I made three conjectures, viz: (1) that there is a final guttural in "Ela," latent, but sufficient to preserve the "a" through centuries of mispronunciation; (2) that this name "Elagh" was Irish; (3) that traces of this name could be found at or near Londonderry, Ireland. Lack of space prevents giving either the reasons for the above or the results thereof other than to say that these conjectures appear to be confirmed.

"Four miles from the City of Londonderry are town lands called 'Great and Little Elagh,' whereon are ruins of a royal palace-for-tress still called Elagh which antedates all certain local history and is of Cyclopean build and seemingly 'the Palace' on Ptolemy's map of about A. D. 150. The present resident at Elagh Hall in Londonderry has given me what little information he has but much more is here accessible in the elaborate Ordnance Survey of Londonderry, made by the Royal Engineers and published officially in 1837; the latter contains illustrations and details of topography and history and supports sundry conjectures subsidiary to those above noted.

"Suffice it here to say, without more, that there should be made a critical and careful examination of the voluminous evidence relating to the origin and history of Londonderry and its inhabitants, the indications being that our ancestors can certainly be connected therewith, though whether as kings or serfs cannot be foretold. Unwelcome to some as this origin might be, it would serve to account for the 'Irish' in many of us; for mental traits as well as 'names are enduring—generations come and go!'"
