FIRST GENERATION

1. JAN ELTEN, ancestor of all the Ulster County Eltings, was born at Holland at Beyle, a dependency of Switchsaelen in the province of Drenthe, on July 29, 1632 (old style). He was the son of Roelif and Aeltje Elten. First mention of him in Albany is on a transaction dated 9-6-1665. He signed the treaty made by the Palz Huguenots and the Indians in the spring of 1677. Jan. Elten married in 1672 at Kingston JACOMINTJE SLECHT, daughter of CORNELIUS and TRYNTJE (TYNEBROUCK) SLECHT. She was a widow with four children. Her daughter, TRYNTJE, married SOLOMON DuBOIS of New Paltz. A monument of Jan Elten in the Elting Burial Ground at New Paltz was erected to his memory by his great-great-grandson Jacob Elting.

From the records of the Reformed Dutch Church at Bergen:

"Bergen County, N. J. in the village of Bergen, November 10, 1672. The Banns of the following persons have been published for three Sundays, and as no objections have been raised, they have been married on the date and in the year as follows:

1672, November 10, Jan Rollofse Eltingh, y.m., and Jacomyntje Slech (widow of Gerrit Fookin), both living at Esopus, received certificate to be married at Esopus November 24, 1672."

Ulster County N.Y. wills, page 39, footnote:

"He (Jan Elten) resided first at Flatbush, L.I.....declared in 1679 under oath that he was the son of Roeloff Elten and Aeltie his mother."

Roelif and Aeltje Elten had three children:

Jacomyntje Slecht married 1st 3-14-1663 at Kingston) Jan Barentsen Kunst. She m. 2nd after 10-27-1668 Gerrit Focken of Ritsen, E. Friesland.

Jan Elten died prior to 8-2-1729. His will devised one half of his estate to his 5 children and the other half to the 9 children of his wife, 5 of his existing marriage and 4 by his wife's previous marriages. One of the 5, AALTJE had died before 4-21-1701 and her share reverted to her only son, GERRIT VanWAGENEN.

And they are to pay the appraised value except their equal share."

The exact death date of Roelif Elting is unknown, but his will is dated 10-29-1745 and probated 1-13-1747. This will made provision for the support of his widow and gave to his son Noah the homestead (the Bevier house which passed into possession of the Eltings about 1740.

Children bearing the name Elting are numbered and listed in the generation following that of their parents. A name underlined indicates that children are listed in the next generation.

Daughter's children are unnumbered and listed under the parents.

We have endeavored to give sources for most of the statistics. Unless otherwise specified baptismal records are from the Dutch Reformed Church of the place named. Cemeteries and private burying ground are noted following death dates.

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The Elting family ceased to be just a genealogical cross-reference to us on the day we moved into the "Brick House" on Huguenot Street, New Paltz. Every item of information we gathered about this family who have been a part of New Paltz history for 230 years, increased our appreciation of our dream home. From the old Huguenot Burying Ground next door, from the New Paltz Reformed Church down the street, from our neighbors - descendants and friends of the Eltings, from libraries and public records, we have gathered the information here presented. It is only a beginning, but it may serve as a starting place for some future genealogist, a focal point which may some day become the nucleus of a more complete family history. We sincerely hope that information not included herein will be made available to us by our readers.
