PREFACE - Second Edition

In 1950, a pamphlet, "Some Descendants of Abel Eastwood", was published to preserve all that the writer and his brother then knew about this branch of the Eastwood family. Further research has produced additional information sufficient for a revision and enlargement of this pamphlet.

The statement in the original preface that this family came up the Connecticut river valley is incorrect as evidence has been found to show that its first location was in Canada.

While much has been added, there are still gaps in the history of this family that future research should remove. In the course of this study, the writer has accumulated notes on some seventy different family lines in America, many extremely incomplete but a few extensive enough to warrant publication at some future time.

Most of the Eastwood families, where the first ancestor in America is known, came from Lancashire and Yorkshire. Two main groups came in the eighteenth century and before; one, into Canada and New York; the other into Virginia and North Carolina. Some ancestors came from elsewhere in England and a few came into other regions in the United States. That the tide of Eastwoods coming to the New World is not over is indicated by the finding of two families that came in 1912.

—PREFACE—

The Eastwood family in America is of English origin. Persons of that name are found in earliest Colonial times in Massachusetts, Rhode Island and New Jersey, but no connection, as yet, has definitely established that shows that they belong to the same family of that name.

Another branch of the family settled in northern New York in the latter part of the eighteenth century. It is thought that these people came up the Connecticut river valley and are connected with the earlier families. Family tradition has it that the first Eastwood in America was an Englishman who was born at sea on a ship coming from Wales to the colonies and that he had a son, Abel Eastwood, who was probably born in Vermont.

There is also a tradition that Abel Eastwood had a family bible which contained a record of those who came before him. Many persons were thought to have had this volume but diligent search has failed to bring it to light. Mrs. Eva Manson, of Warsaw, New York, who visited the Abel Eastwood descendants in the Province of Ontario, Canada, said that this bible was left in the possession of Adria (Eastwood) Smith and that it had been worn out or destroyed by her children. This is likely as she was the youngest daughter and remained with her parents in Canada where she married and left many descendants.

Research has been conducted for some sixty years by the late Charles Kirk Eastwood, of Owego, N. Y., and his two sons, Sidney Kingman Eastwood and Eric Kingman Eastwood. What has been learned leaves many gaps that, perhaps, can be filled.

This pamphlet, containing all that has been learned of the descendants of Abel Eastwood, is published with the hope that it will stimulate interest in the family and result in additional information being brought to light, particularly in regard to what connection

there is between the New York families and the earlier families of Massachusetts, Rhode Island and New Jersey.

It is hoped that the names of the parents of Abel Eastwood may be learned. It is also thought that he had brothers and sisters who were in the same region at the end of the eighteenth century. Further there is much to be added in regard to members of the more recent generations. All of this could lead to the publication of a much more extensive work on the family.

THE ABEL EASTWOOD FAMILY

Family tradition, as stated by Mrs. Roxy (Eastwood) Cochran, grand-daughter of Abel Eastwood, has it that the first Eastwood was from Yorkshire and came on a ship from Wales to Canada where he settled at Elizabethtown, located on the St. Lawrence river four-six miles east of Brockville. He had a son, born at sea, who later moved to Vermont where he had a son, Abel Eastwood. For two generations this family was engaged in lumbering and rafting on the St. Lawrence river into Montreal and, also, via Lake Champlain into New York. Elizabethtown does not appear on recent maps.

ABEL¹ EASTWOOD, probably born in Vermont, died at Elizabethtown, Ontario, prior to 1836. He married, in Vermont, before 1780 Edith (Eldridge) Brayton, who died at Elizabethtown in 1836. She was a widow with two sons, Kelep (Caleb) and Benjamin Brayton.

He removed to Otter Creek, Washington County, New York, prior to 1780 where all of his children are supposed to have been born. He was a strong supporter of the English cause and, sometime before the war of 1812, moved to Canada where he took the oath of allegiance to the King and settled at Elizabethtown.

ABRAM² EASTWOOD, son of Abel¹ and Edith (Eldridge Brayton) Eastwood, was born 20 August 1780, probably at Otter

Creek, and died 22 August 1858 at Livonia, New York and is buried at Mt. Morris, New York. He was married 17 December 1805 by Squire Leonard Gibbs at Fort Ann, Washington County, New York, to Ruth Worden, daughter of Jesse and Ruth (Dart) Worden who who was born 17 August 1789 at Stephentown, New York, and died 13 December 1882 at Mt. Morris, New York.

The first two children were born at Fort Ann. Sometime after 1810, the family moved to Elizabethtown, Ontario, where the third child was born. When the War of 1812 broke out, he refused to take the oath of allegiance to the King and was ordered to leave the country. The time was short and he lost all of his possessions except a little money in getting into New York State in the winter of 1812-13. He crossed the river and made his way to the home of his brother-in-law, William Worden, in Saratoga County. There he made arrangements for his family. Ruth Eastwood, with three small children, came to the river in a sleigh where the soldiers confiscated the horses and sleigh but permitted her to keep a chest containing money and other things.

They settled at Mayfield Mountain, Montgomery County, New York, where two children were born. In 1818, they were in Perry, New York, where a sixth child was born. In 1820, they were at Bristol, New York, and, a few years later, moved to Livonia, New York. It is thought that they returned to Perry for a short time as one child died there in 1827.

ton) Eastwood, was born about 1783, probably at Otter Creek, New York, and died 13 February 1847 at Conewango (now Warren), Pennsylvania. He married at Elizabethtown, Ontario, Lottie Giles who was born about 1790 at Montpelier, Vermont, and died 3 March 1863 in Michigan. His first three children were born in Canada.

When the War of 1812 broke out, he was drafted and served three months, went home and before night was drafted again. He hired a boat and was rowed across the river to Ogdensburg, New York. His farm was confiscated but his wife and children were permitted to follow him. He settled at Canandaigua, New York and moved from there to Perry, New York. In 1837 he moved to Conewango (now Warren), Pennsylvania.
