The Frost Genealogy.

In the autumn of 1761 James, Moses, John and Jeremiah Frost, of Kittery, Maine, settled in Argyle.

By 1771 several other heads of families had arrived there, among whom was John Spinney, from Portsmouth, New Hampshire. Philip Brown, Walter Larkin, Benjamin Seeley, John, Hugh and Daniel Nickerson, sons of Elisba Nickerson, sen., of Liverpool, were among the early arrivals.

James and Moses Frost soon returned to New England, John and Jeremiah were brothers, and sons of James and Margaret (Goodwin) Frost, of Kittery.

1. JOHN FROST 1st, of Argyle, was baptized at Kittery in 1716, and died at Argyle 13 July, 1779. His wife, whose name appears as Lydia, died 16 June, 1786. He was ordained at Chebogue 21 Sept., 1769, and preached there about one year. He was a Justice of the Peace at Argyle and many of the earlier marriages of the township were solemnized by John Frost, Esquire.

After their wedding they started from Chebogue, in an open boat, for Argyle. In the boat with John Frost and his bride were his brother Simeon, Miss Rebecca Hobbs, Prince Robbins, brother of the bride, Samuel Ring, son of Capt. George. All were drowned. JEREMIAH FROST 1st, of Argyle, was born at Kittery, Maine, about 1725 or 6 and died at Argyle 6 Sept., 1776. His wife, whose maiden name was Miriam Harding, was born arout 1728, and died at the home of her son, Andrew, in June 1800. With his family and his brother, John Frost (No. 1), he removed to Argyle in Oct., 1761. The old records style him "Esquire," and doubtless he was a Justice of the Peace.

6. Andrew Frost (Jeremiah), was born 10 Nov., 1751, and died at Argyle in Aug. 1836. He married 1st, in 1775, Lucy Bartlett, or Lucy Roberts. Married 2d, Sarah Redding. When a young man he went to Kittery, where he married his first wife. She died there about one year after marriage. While in Kittery be was drafted for military service in a company destined to operate on the Penobscot River. He hired a substitute. The attacking force was repulsed and his substitute killed. Desiring to return to his home, he joined a privateer as pilot, and was put on shore at Jeddore. Thence he went to Halifax and finally reached Argyle, after an absence of several years. The parents of his 2d wife, Sarah Redding, have not been traced. Her father died in New England, leaving two daughters and two or more sons. The daughter, Lucy, married A. M. Barnes. A son, George Redding, was proprietor of a business in Boston, in one of the markets. Another son, Timothy, frequently visited in Argyle.

He was a deacon of the Argyle Baptist church. With his sons and brothers, he was much engaged in navigation. He was master of the Lord Nelson. This vessel, owned by the Nelson. This vessel, owned by the Frosts, was lost at Grand Passage. His house, thought by some to have been the oldest house in Argyle township, was demolished about 1878.
