PREFACE.

It is a matter of regret that all intelligent families of America do not make a permanent record of their ancestors and living relatives. Some have a few genealogical notes tucked away in places where they can rarely be found when wanted and which eventually find their way to the furnace or some unknown place. But the majority know little and care less about their family history.

A full and accurate family record placed in all of our public libraries would be of great value a hundred years hence and if such a record is not made NOW it will then be unobtainable. What a blessing it would have been if one or two centuries ago our ancestors had made and preserved a full and accurate family history! What a blessing it will be to our descendants of one or two centuries to come if we do this now!

Why can not every family select as its official genealogist some member with spare time and interest in the work and who by a study of various Court and Church records and by correspondence with distant cousins might compile and publish such a family record?

An elaborate volume with portraits and colored coats of arms may serve to impress a few readers but such a book is expensive and unnecessary. Type written or printed family sheets, bound in a loose-leaf octavo pamphlet with a flexible cover, would cost but little and being acceptable to all public libraries would serve the main purpose of perpetuating the family history.

Whoever is able to make additions or corrections to this family record is earnestly requested to send such to the compiler.

NOTE I.

A MALE LINEAGE CHART

is convenient for reference as it shows at a glance the various lines of descent and enables one to find any adult son. The sons who died young are omitted as are also the daughters all of whom will be found in the family sheets.

NOTE II.

THE FAMILY NUMBERING

is unusual but very convenient. If ---- e.g. is numbered 1 3 5 it shows that he is in the third generation and is the fifth son of the third son of the first American ancestor as far as known. Omitting one or two right hand figures gives the number of his father or grandfather.

Thomas Fox of Concord was made a freeman in 1644 and was therefore born as early as 1623 for it was not until 1645 that a man under twenty-one years of age could be made a freeman. It is probable that he was born about 1619 and that he married his first wife Rebecca about 1641. He appears to have been a man who stood well among his neighbors and was evidently educated above the average. Although "feeble and weak in body" he signed his will with his own hand, his name being neat and legible. His descendants may be congratulated that their first ancestor in America did not have to make his X mark.

The coat-of-arms impressed on the seal of his will is entirely unlike that of the Rev. John Foxe, the martyrologist, is whom some have claimed to have been his ancestor. The arms on the will seem identical with those of the family of the Rev. Peter Bulkeley with whom he was evidently in close friendship and as The Rev. Edward Bulkeley signed the will as a witness and not unlikely drew the will itself, as was the custom of many of the early clergy, it is probable that he used his own seal.

The will, dated 1658, now in Middlesex Co. office made his wife Hannah executrix. She and her young sons Thomas, Samuel & John moved to New London, Ct. where she became the third wife of Andrew Lester and had three sons by him, Timothy 1662, Joseph 1664 and Benjamin Lester 1666 (half-brothers of the children of Thomas Fox of Concord) and later married a third husband. (See "Thomas Fox and his Descendants" by William F. Fox with preface by Simeon M. Fox.

David was a soldier in the Phipps Expedition to Quebec and probably never went to New London. Isaac moved there from Medford after 1695. That the son Thomas died young is conjecture. He and his sister Hannah were certainly in New London in 1662 as is shown by County Court records. He may have gone to Newport where a Thomas Fox lived or have been one of the unidentified Thomas Foxes of Boston.

As the first Thomas Fox was a brother-in-law of Moses Wheate it is very likely that his first wife was Rebecca Wheate. Possibly she was a sister of Wheate's wife Tamasin. He probably married her in England but possibly a sister Rebecca of Moses Wheate came with his family and married Thomas Fox in Concord.

It should be noted that there were two men named Thomas Fox who lived in Concord soon after its settlement.

The elder one of these, as is shown by various Court records, came from England to America in one of the vessels of Gov. Winthrop's fleet in 1630. He was one of Gov. Cradock's men and probably settled on the Mystic river near where Medford now stands and where Gov. Winthrop located the Cradock grant. Gov. Cradock never came to America but sent over a colony of servants. It seems quite certain that this was the Thomas Fox, b c1608, who later moved to Cambridge and is known as "Thomas Fox of Cambridge" in distinction from the younger "Thomas Fox of Concord". He was made a freeman in 1638. The Cambridge Church records state that his son Jabez had been baptized at Concord. He evidently had an unidentified wife there and after removal to Cambridge married (2) Ellen, widow of Percival Green.

Each of these men named Thomas Fox, as well as Richard Fox of Glastonbury, Ct. has a distinct line of widely scattered descendants. They may possibly have been related to each other but proof of this is lacking.
