

FOREWARD

The family name "Randolph" originated from Randolph the son of Ribald who was a cousin of William the Conqueror of England, both descended from Rolf the Norseman who conquered Normandy in the year 912 A.D. The family name Fitz Randolph (Fitz being the Norman-French prefix meaning "Son of") originated with Robert Fitz Randolph son of Randolph and grandson of Ribald. It was Robert Fitz Randolph who built the Castle of Middleheim about the year 1190 on land inherited by his grandfather Ribald.

Ribald came into possession of large areas of land in the northern part of England, probably about 100,000 acres which had been given to his brother, Alan Rufus, by William the Conqueror in return for services rendered by Alan whose army comprised nearly one third of the forces of William the Conqueror in the conquest of England. These large estates remained in possession of the Fitz Randolph family through many centuries of English history. Just here we might also mention that Bardolph, a brother of Alan and Ribald, was ancestor of the Lords of Ravensworth from whom the family of George Washington descended. The Fitz Randolph families in England were connected by blood and marriage with numerous royal families, among them Edward IV and Richard III, kings of the House of York, also Henry VII and Henry VIII.

The name Fitz Randolph is one of the very few that continued in prominence from the eleventh century throughout English history. Many other family names came into being only to lose prominence after a few years or to be lost entirely, but the family of Fitz Randolph remains of importance in English and American life to this day. Many members however have dropped the prefix "Fitz". It should be continued at least by the initial "F" if not by the entire word. I am sorry that I did not know earlier of the history connected with the name.

In this pamphlet an attempt has been made to follow the direct family line from Edward Fitz Randolph, the Pilgrim, who came to Plymouth Colony in 1630 and is progenitor of the family in America, to Daniel F. Randolph, my great grandfather. From Daniel's family forward to this date the writer has attempted to list every descendent. Important date and marriage connections are given for nearly everyone with biographical sketches for a few. The information is not complete. Further facts and corrections from everyone will be appreciated.

One branch of the descendants of Thomas, Daniel's older brother, is included following the descendants of Daniels. A few of the descendants of Mary (Randolph) Hill, Daniel's aunt are also included.

FIRST GENERATION (In America)
No. 1

EDWARD(1) FITZ RANDOPH, the Pilgrim, (Son of Edward, great grandson of Christofer of Langton Hall, Nottinghamshire, England.) The exact date of his birth is not known but according to record he was baptised July 5, 1607. Among the seven hundred passengers who came over on the eleven vessels which comprised the "Winthrop Fleet" and which was known as "The Great Emigration" of 1630 is the following entry, "Edward Fitzrandolph of Sutton-in-Ashfield, Notts, Scituate. This gives Edward's former home and his destination in the new world.

He settled in Plymouth Colony (now Massachusetts) and was married May 10, 1637 to Elizabeth Blossom by Lothrop. She was the daughter of Thomas and Ann (Heilson) Blossom, born in Leyden, Holland in 1620. Thomas Blossom and his family started to America in 1620 with the first voyage of the Mayflower and Speedwell but was one of those who were forced to turn back because of the unseaworthiness of the Speedwell. On May 1, 1629 six vessels left the shores of England, among them the famous Mayflower and it is thought that Thomas Blossom and his family were on this ship.

In 1639 Edward and Elizabeth moved from Scituate to Barnstable, Plymouth Colony where their several children were born. In 1669 they moved to Piscataway, East Jersey. Here he died about 1684-5. He was buried at Piscataway town. No stone is there, but at a battle there with the Brittish an earth breastwork was thrown up over his and other graves and is there yet. Some of the stones of Thomas's family are partly buried. Elizabeth survived him, living to the age of ninety three.

Samuel enlisted in the War of the Revolution and served as ensign in the Second Regiment of Sussex County, N.J. After the war Samuel purchased over a thousands acres of land in Pennsylvania and moved to the southwestern part of the state. He and his wife were constituent members of the Woodbridge town Seventh Day Baptist Church, Fayette Co., Pa. established 1789. He also purchased land in western Virginia. He moved there in 1792, joining a migration of the Shrewsbury, N.J. church in establishing the village and Seventh Day Baptists Church of New Salem, Va. now New Salem, W. Va.

*Preston F. Randolph, a grandson of Jonathan, was a great educator in his community. Teaches trained by him were in great demand. He introduced vocal music in the public schools. He was also very active in establishing Sabbath Schools in West Virginia. Cor-less F. Randolph, another descendent of Jonathan, was author of the book, "Seventh Day Baptists of West Virginia."

**The author has not been able to verify the place of David's death, whether in Iowa or not. One report states that he died at Lebanon in Van Buren Co., Ia.

DANIEL(6) FITZ RANDOLPH, (David(5), Samuel(4), Jonathan(3), Thomas(2), Edward(1) of Shelbyville, Ind., and Bloomfield, Iowa. b. Mar. 30, 1803; d. Sept. 17, 1855; m. Mar. 16, 1831 Elizabeth Wishard, b. Jan. 26, 1807, d. July 25, 1889 dau. of Abram and Sarah (Reynolds) Wishard. Elizabeth was the oldest of ten children and at one time lived on the Licking river not far from the Mammoth Cave in Kentucky. Daniel and Elizabeth are buried in the Lester Cemetery two miles southwest of Belknap, Iowa.

Daniel brought his family to Iowa from Shelbyville, Indiana about 1854. As a small boy I remember of my grandfather, Alva F. Randolph, Daniels son, telling about his older brother driving their oxen and covered wagon across bank full streams as the family came from Indiana.

Daniel and his family lived for a number of years on the farm two miles north of Bloomfield, Ia., now owned by Roy Denny (1951). He operated merchandise vans which traveled through the country selling goods. He is reported to have hauled goods from Keokuk, Iowa to Des Moines. After he died his widow and family purchased the one hundred acre farm west of Pulaski where they lived for several years. This farm was later purchased from the heirs by Alva (7) F. Randolph.

When Alva was about twelve years old he became ill at school and started home alone. He became exhausted and lay down in the snow, the effects of which left him deaf for the remainder of his life. He could speak to others but he always carried a small slate in his pocket for those who could not use the finger alphabet. When the youngest son, Alva Jr., was about two years old the family moved from Appanoose county to the farm near Pulaski formerly owned by his mother. He lived there until he retired to Bloomfield about eight years before his death.

While in Appanoose county the family lived in a true pioneer fashion. They lived in a log house. The family cut wild grass along the Chariton river for winter hay for livestock. Corn was planted with a hand planter in tracks made by a marking cart. He and his older sons cut, hued, and smoothed railroad ties with a broad axe. In the evening, by kerosene lantern light, they would often shave barrel hoops from hickory saplings. These were sold for an income from their forty acre farm. On leaving Appanoose county the forty acre farm was traded for a team of horses, a set of harness, a wagon, and a saddle.



1. Rolf, b. 860. First Duke of Normandy
The Norseman who conquered Normandy in the year 912 A.D. Died 932.
2. William "Longsword" - Duke of Normandy. Died 943.
3. Richard "The Fearless" - Reigned in Normandy fifty years. Died 996.
4. Richard "The Good" - Reigned in Normandy thirty years. Died 1026.
5. Geoffrey, M. Avicia dau. of : Richard, Duke of Normandy, Son of
Richard "The Good". Geoffrey : Richard The Good, m. Judith.
was Duke of Brittany. : Reigned two years. Died 1028.
:
6. EUDO; Duke of Brittany. Son : Robert - Son of Richard, and
of Geoffrey and kinsman of : Judith.
William the Conqueror. Mar. :
Agnes, dau. of Alan. Died 1079. : William, the Bastard and later
: called "William the Conquerer."
: William's mother was Harlotta.
Children of Eudo:
 - (1) Stephen - Ancestor of important line of Dukes and Princes.
 - (2) Alan Niger - Died without issue.
 - (3) Alan Rufus - First Earl of Richmond. Eudo joined hands with
William the Conqueror and sent Alan Rufus and 8000 Bretons
(about one third of Williams army) in the conquest of England.
Alan commanded this army and distinguished himself in the
battle at Hastings. William later transferred to Alan 440
manors, 140 knights fees, and not far short of 100,000 acres
of land in northern England. Alan died without issue and gave
much of his estate to his brother Ribald.
 - (4) Geoffrey - Issue did not persist.
 - (5) Bodin - Died without issue.
 - (6) Ribald - Inherited much of the estate of Alan Rufus.
 - (7) Bardolf - From Bardolf descended the Lords of Ravensworth and
the lineage whose most noble culmination was George Washington.
7. RIBALD, Lord of Middleham. Mar. Beatrix, spent his last days in
retirement at St. Mary's Abbey, York, D. 1131.
8. RALPH or Randolph, Lord of Middleham. Mar. Agatha, dau. of the
first Robert of Bruce.
9. ROBERT FITZ RANDOLPH, Lord of Middleham. Built the castle of
Middleham. Mar. Helewisa, dau. of Ralph de Glanville.
10. Randolph Fitz Randolph, Lord of Middleham. Mar. Mary (or Margery)
dau. of Robert Bigot, Duke of Norfolk. Died 1251.
11. Randolph Fitz Randolph, Lord of Middleham. Mar. Anastacia dau. of
William Lord Percy. Died 1270.
12. Mary Fitz Randolph, dau. of Randolph and Anastacia. She was a rich
and benevolent woman who married Robert de Neville in 1260. She
died A.D. 1320 having survived her husband 49 years.

13. RANDOLPH de NEVILLE, Lord of Middleham - only son of Mary and Robert Neville. Summoned to House of Lords by Edward II. Mar. 1st Euphemia dau. of John Clavering. Their only son Robert Fitz Randolph died childless 1318. Mar. 2nd Margery dau. of Marmaduke Thweng. They had one son.
14. RANDOLPH de NEVILLE, Lord of Middleham - Hero in Battle of Nevilles Cross in 1346. He enlarged the castle of Middleham in 1400. Mar. Alicia dau. of Hugo de Audley. Died 1368.
15. JOHN de NEVILLE, Lord of Middleham - Who with his father captured Scottish King David in battle and held him for a large ransom. Mar. Matilda de Percy. Died 1389.
16. RANDOLPH de NEVILLE, Lord of Middleham. Appointed first Earl of Westmoreland by King Richard II. He had two wives by whom he had an even score of children nearly all of whom became titled and powerful. Mar. 1st Margaret - Lady Stafford - a descendant of King Edward I. Mar. 2nd Joan of Beaufort dau. of John of Gaunt who was a son of Edward III.
17. JOHN, Son of Randolph and Lady Stafford. Mar. Elizabeth dau. of Thomas Holland, Earl of Canterbury. Died 1433.
18. JOHN, heir presumptive to the dukedom of Westmoreland. Was hero of the battle of Towton in the year 1461. Mar. Anna, the widow of John de Neville.
19. RANDOLPH, Duke of Westmoreland, son of John and Anna. Mar. Margaret dau. of Booth de Baron of Lancaster.
20. RANDOLPH, heir presumptive. Mar. Edith dau. of Earl of Sandwich.
21. RANDOLPH, Duke of Westmoreland, son of Randolph and Edith. Mar. Catherine, dau of Edward, Duke of Buckingham. Died 1524.
22. RANDOLPH, fifth son of Randolph and Catherine. The first son being Henry, whose son Charles was the last in the line of these Dukes of Westmoreland, and the other sons being Thomas, Edward, Christopher, and Culthbert. Died about 1565.
23. CHRISTOPHER FITZ RANDOLPH, son of Randolph, fifth son of Duke of Westmoreland. Mar. Joan, dau. and heiress of Cuthbert Langton of Langton Hall. Died 1588.
24. EDWARD FITZ RANDOLPH of Langton Hall. With whom was found and in whom was confirmed by the "Visitation" of 1614 the Fitz Randolph Arms substantially as borne by the Lords of Middleham and by the Pennithorne branch of Fitz Randolph. Died probably about 1635.
25. EDWARD FITZ RANDOLPH, "The Pilgrim". Mar. May 10, 1637 at Scituate, Mass. to Elizabeth Blossom, dau. of Thomas and Anne Blossom Moved to Piscataway, N.J. 1669. Died 1675.
