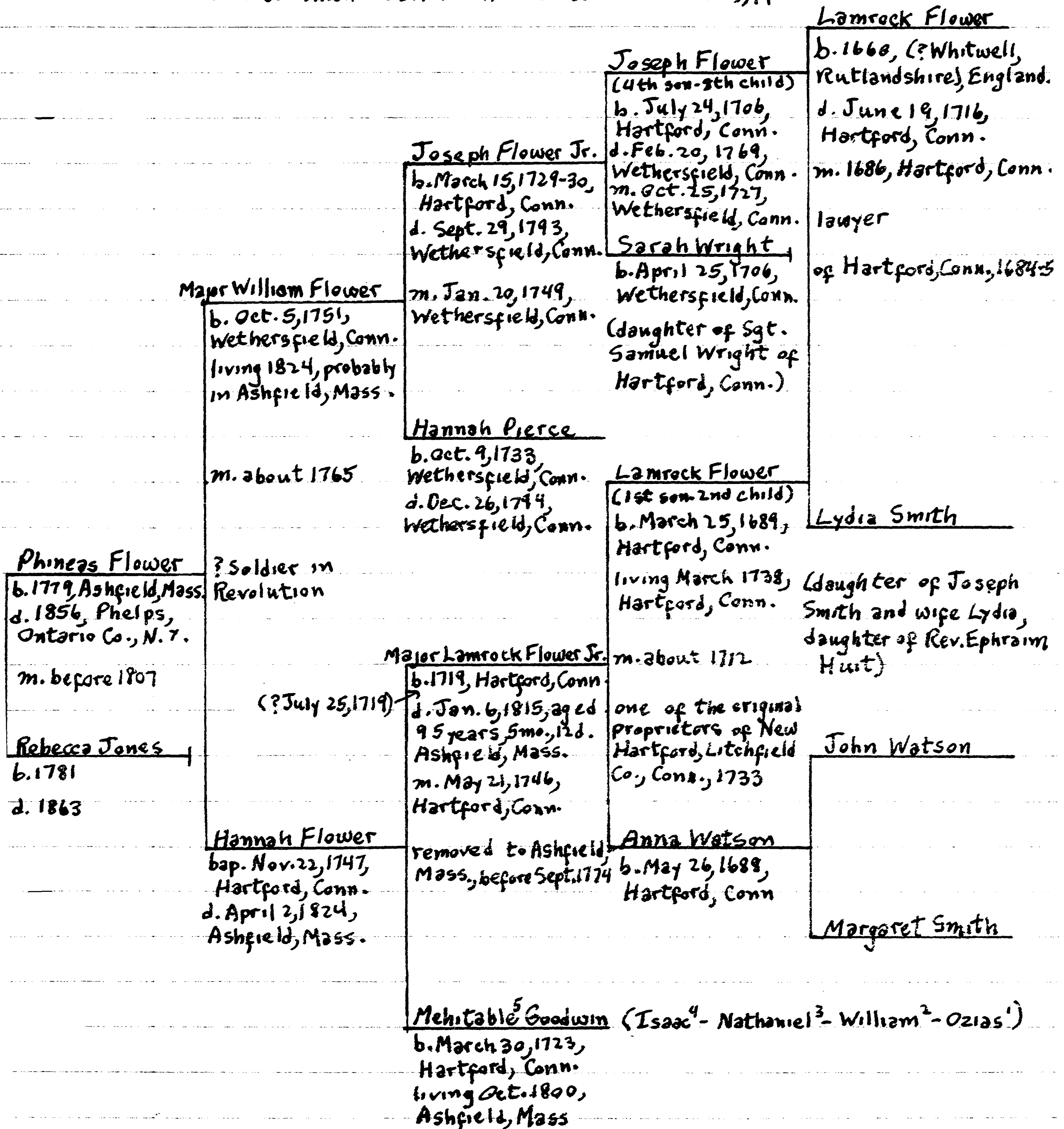

The first information we have of this individual is at page 37, of the 3rd Edition of "An account of the Convincement exercises, etc. of that ancient servant of 'Lord Richard Davies'". Roger Prichard is there spoken of as "one that was called a Quaker" who was come from Ireland to Llarelling, a town in the county of Montgomery", but went back again to Ireland, as he was going back he suffered great losses by sea, and lost his good condition also, but the Lord visited him again.

At page 140 R. Davies writes: "The concern of that part of the country in Herefordshire lay much upon me and I was often there, and when the people of Almeley Wooten saw me come, they would say to another, "Come let us go to Mr. Prichard's for we shall have prayer there tonight, and the house hast been soon near full of people."

As for Roger Prichard the Lord blessed him in basket and in store.

"And his heart and house were open to Friends and he built a fine meeting house at his own charge, and also gave a burial place, and settled both upon Friends for that purpose and lived and died in love and favor with God, and in unity with the Brethern".

He purchased the estate of Almeley Wooten for £480/10/0 s (in 1661, it was worth about £ 4000 s) of James Rawlius of the cittie (sic) of London, Merchant Taylor (sic). The conveyence bears date 19 February in the 20th year of the reign of Charles II, viz, 1670.

He married Mary Clark, on whom he settled a Moity of the estate in consideration of a dowry of £40 s which he had with her; the deed of settlement is dated 28 May in the 20th year of Charles II, viz. 1670. He died 7 February 1679.

Mary, the widow of Roger Prichard leased moity of Almeley Wooten to her son Edward. The deed is dated January 7, in the 36th year of the reign of King Charles II, viz 1686. It is conjectured that Edward Prichard inherited the other moity.

The will is dated September 28, 1725.
