There were many doubtful points in the first manuscript edition of DESCENDANTS OF JACOB GRETER and I hesitated about releasing it and in fact did not do so for some time after writing it. After its release however an unexpected and most welcome opportunity came to me to visit the Eastern part of Pennsylvania and I was able to obtain at first hand much additional information. From County records I obtained briefs of wills and deeds; also I visited many of the old cemeteries in that vicinity and obtained dates from old headstones.

This information obtained on the ground proved many points that I had already suspected. It proved that the Jacob Greter whe died in 1760 was the one that Lewis Crater showed as the original immigrant ancestor of this branch of the Greter-Crater Family. On page 4 I show that the family shown in the will of JACOB GRETER (Book L page 386 Phila. Co. Records) was the same family and was shown in the same order as in the birth record in German taken from the old family Bible by Lewis Crater. Further this will and that of JOHN GRETER (Book 5 page 59 Montgomery Records) both show that Barbara Greter (b.1740) married Isaac Hunsicker and that Mary Greter (b.1760) married Frederick mubler; they also show that it was the Catherine Greter (b.1750) daughter of John and not the Catherine Greter (b.1750) daughter of John and not the Catherine Greter (b.1750) daughter of John arried Dillman Ziegler.

Reader is referred to Hunsicker Genealogy for further information on descendants of Lewis Grater (1775-1847) and on descendants of Warren H.Grater (1843-1886).

The first wife of Isaac Grater (1810-1896) was Deborah Groff(1810-1858) and his second wife was Elizabeth Hauff (1816-1861); his children were born in the order as shown by Lewis Crater; SCHWENKFELDER FAMILIES is in error on these points.

In regard to the family of John G.Greter (b.1838) there is a discrepancy between the dates shown in SCHWENKFELDER FAMILIES as being taken from a family Bible and those on headstones at Trappe.

Under the caption of WHO ARE THEY short genealogies of three other Crater families are shown; as these families lived in the same township as some of Jacob Greter's descendants it may be they are also his descendants. It is hoped that further information may be obtained regarding these three families.

INTRODUCTION

In 1894 Lewis Grater (1843-1919) of Reading, Pa. wrote and published a small genealogy entitled "History of the Greter, Grater or Crater Family"; it was a genealogy of the descendants of Jacob Greter who lived at Gratersford, Montgomery County, Pa. Lewis Crater says; "The genealogy is not intended to include the whole family but takes up the line of Jacob Greter and traces the descendants of his son. Johannas."

It is evident that Lewis Crater obtained the information for the first three generations of his genealogy from an old family Bible record written in German and this part of his work was undoubtedly very accurate; however he assumes that the Jacob Greter whose name appears on the passenger list of the ship Samuel on the trip arriving at Philadelphia on August 17,1735 was his ancestor and there is very good reason to believe that he may have been mistaken about this; Pennsylvania Archives show that this Jacob Greter was 21 years old in 1733; one would not expect to find him married and the father of two children, one of them four years old, at the age of 21 and further there is no record of his wife on the passenger list of the Samuel or on the lists of other ships arriving later.

Abram Clemmer writing in The Perkiomen Region dated April 1932 on the ancestry of his father, shows that one of these ancestors was Jacob Greter, who came to America prior to 1728.

In compiling this genealogy I have searched the public records of four Pennsylvania counties, corresponded with many of Jacob Greter's descendants and searched many cemeteries; I have attempted to correct many errors previously made and to extend the lines. My thanks to those who have helped me in this work. Trusting that my own errors are not too numerous, I will appreciate any corrections or any additional data that may be sent me.

HISTORY

Jacob Greter made his first appearance in America about 1720 as one of the signers of a petition by inhabitants of Colebrook Valley to Governor Patrick Gordon for protection from the Indians; this petition mentions the trouble that had come upon "the back inhabitors about Falkner's Swamp and New Goshoponin". The date of Jacob Greter's arrival in America is unknown as is the date of his death. It is evident that his widow married Christian Allebach of Lower Salford Township, whose will (Book H page 151 Phila. Co. Will Records) mentions step-children Jacob Greder, Martin Greder and Barbara Greder. This will was proved Sept.10,1746.

Martin Greter and Jacob Greter jr. were naturalized June 21,1743 which indicates that they were born in Germany. (See Penna. Archives 2nd Series Vol.2 page 360). No further record of Barbara has been found. Martin Greter sold some property in Upper Hanover Township in 1746 to Melchor Shultz and Veronica Greter signed as Martin's wife. (Vol.G-8 page 286 Phila. Co. Deed Records).

Jacob Greter jr. had a farm and mill at Gratersford, Montgomery County, Pa. and it was for him that the
borough was named. In a census of Skippack Township made in
1756 he is listed as a weaver, having seven children and as
the owner of 220 acres of land of which 80 acres were cleared.
He died in 1750 leaving a wife and eight children. (Will
dated Jan.11,1750 and proved Feb.19,1760 Will Book L page 386
Phila. Co.Will Records.)

Most of the early members of this family belonged to the Lower Skippack Memonite Church and many of them are buried in that cemetery.

SPELLING OF NAME

The German spelling of the name was probably Grater or Graeter. The early German immigrants spelled it Greter, Grater, Greder and Grader as well as other ways starting with "G". English speaking immigrants insisted that the name should start with a "K" or with a "C" and it was so spelled in the early records of that section. Even now signs erected by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania inform us that the Borough of Gratersford was named for Jacob Kreator, an early settler. Mistakes in the spelling of the name were made in some of the early deeds and some of Jacob Greter's descendants changed the spelling of the name to Crater while others changed to Grater.

FAMILY OF JACOB GRETER JR.

Following is a parallel comparison of the names of the children of Jacob Greter (d.1760) as listed in family Bible, in Jacob Greter's will and in Paul Greter's will. Ages shown in parenthesis following the names are calculated using Bible dates and dates of wills.

Jacob Greter's will leaves some property to his wife and to his sons, John and Paul and to heirs of daughter Mary, late wife of Jacob Meyer; remainder to be divided in 9 equal parts for heirs of Mary and 8 other children as listed above. The will implies that the other children, Barbara to Michael, are not of age and says they are to get part of their legacy when they become of age and the balance when the youngest reaches the age of 12.

Paul Greter's will leaves his property to his brothers, John, Jacob and Michael and to the heirs of his sister Mary, late wife of Jacob Meyer and to his sister Barbara, wife of Isaac Hunsicker and to his sisters, Catherine and Esther, who are not of age.

It would seem from the above chart that Jacob Greter b.1729, evidently died in infancy and that another child was given the same name; that Elizabeth died before 1760 and that Christian died before 1768, both without issue. It is unfortunate that three names were lost from the Bible record; however the fact that Jacob was not of age in 1760 and was of age in 1768 and that Catherine and Esther appear in same order in both wills seems to prove that these three names are correctly placed in the above groups.

GENEALOGY - DESCENDANTS OF JACOB GRETER FIRST GENERATION

JACOB GRETER came to America before 1720; as an inhabitant of Colebrook Valley he was one of the signers of a petition to Gov.Patrick Gordon, dated May 10,1720, asking for protection from the Indians. Nothing further is known of him. His widow, Elizabeth, married Christian Allebach, younger, of Lower Salford Twp., Phila.Co.(now in Mont. Co.) Pa. Christian Allebach died leaving a will dated Aug.6,1746 and proved Sept.10,1746 naming his step-children, Jacob, Martin and Barbara Greder.

SECOND GENERATION

JACOB GRETER (Jacob) who died Feb.19,1760; he was naturalized June 21,1743; m.Mary Friedt (dau.of Paulus and Elizabeth Stauffer Friedt); he was a weaver, miller and farmer and had a mill and a 220 acre farm along the Perkiomen River. There is a house built from the remains of an old mill that is said to have been this mill. Gratersford was named for this Jacob Greter as he is the Jacob Freator mentioned on highway signs at the edge of this borough. Not far from this borough is located the Gratersford Penitentiary of Pennsylvania.
