EARLY VIRGINIA GARRETTS

While the Garretts came to Virginia early, the records of the counties have been so hurt by wars that it is exceedingly hard to trace relationship where it really exists. The connection of these first families may never be established.

The records show these early arrivals:

- 1607 William Garrett (Garrit) to Jamestown. He was a bricklayer. (Hotten p. 217). Mentioned by Capt. John Smith (p. 24 Cradle of the Republic).
- 1607 William Garrett (Jarrett) landed at time of dissolution of London Company.
- 1619 William Garrett, servant of Abraham Preasley, age 22. (p. 217 Hotten).
- 1619 Edmond Garrett, Parish St. James. Had 4 acres of land.
- 1635 Stephen Garrett, age 19, sailed from England for St. Christophers, on the "Pauls."
- 1635 Owen Garrett, aged 20, sailed for St. Christophers.
- 1635 Thomas Francis Garrett, age 25, for Virginia.
- 1635 Richard West Garrett, age 20, sailed for St. Christopher.
- 1680 Thomas Garrett and wife, Barbedoes; Parish of St. James.
- William Garrett came over 1607, patented land in Henrico.

There was a William Garrett, large land owner in Louisa County, b. about 1710-15, m. Elizabeth Ashton, d. about 1780. His son, Capt. Henry Garrett moved to Albemarle Co., later to Ky., b. about 1750, d. 1815 at Lexington, Ky. Soldier Revolution and Captain.

It is highly possible that these were kin to Stephen and his son, William, b. about 1750-55, d. 1816, m. Mary Branch Coleman, "near Richmond," since both Henry and this later William had sons named Alexander and since two of William's children, Anne and Spilsbary C. married Hacketts in Albemarle County.

Other Garretts in Buckingham County were of the same line but at this time we cannot trace the relationship and may never be able to find it.

Oak Grove, Ky., April 10, 1900.

Dear Miss Gaither:

Your letter of April 2, making inqury concerning our family history was handed to me by my brother, of Elmo, Ky., a few days ago. I am a daughter of the late Isaac Garrett. I have a maiden aunt 77 years of age, to whom I am indebted for my knowledge of my ancestors. She has a fine memory and a great love for her relatives. We are anxious to learn the name of your grandfather, S. C. Garrett. My grandfather, Isaac G., born 1792, died 1868, was the son of Isaac

G., senior, son of Charles G., all of Virginia. My grandfather, Isaac, junior, had four brothers, Pleasant, Hercules, Jacob and Edmond, and two half brothers, George and Charles. Geo. died in childhood and Charles moved to Missouri.

My aunt remembers having some cousins visit them many years ago. Spilsberry Garrett and several children. Also a brother of his, William Garrett of Missouri. She says she has heard her father speak very often of Stephen Garrett of Virginia, but she does not remember how they are related. You will see that we do not spell our names the same way. My grandfather spelled his Garrott, as his father did, while his brother Pleasant spelled it Garrett. But Uncle Pleasant's children did not follow his example, but spelled their name Garrott, as other Christian County Garrotts do.

From same writer under date of May 19, 1900:

"Yes! My aunt tells me that one of grandfather's cousins, William Garrett, built Uncle Pleasant's house. One of Uncle Pleasant's sons, Marcellus G., spent yesterday with us. And he told me that he had lately given a little chair to the baby of his youngest daughter that Cousin William Garrett made for him. He told me, too, of a cradle he made for him. My aunt thinks she was only eight years old when your grandfather visited her father's family. I know that my grandfather and yours were cousins, though I cannot trace the relationship. Aunt Mary——"

(Editor's Note.—This "chair" and "cradle" may have been made by William H. Garrett. The Editor has such a small chair made by this William later. This is entirely possible since Spilsbury C., his father, lived in Todd Co., Ky., in 1832. William H. perhaps till some years later. Pleasant G. moved to Christian Co. from Todd in 1821.

GARRETT FAMILY BIBLE

The Bible is in size 9x12 inches, full leather backs, both show to have been torn loose several times and sewed back, and are now almost off; it bears date of publication, "1816," has the usual leaves between the two testaments for family record. It also bears the inscription, "M. Cary, No. 121 Chesnut Street, Philadelphia" as publisher. Several leaves are missing at the first and it is torn in places. It is now in the possession of J. Crump Garrett, Portland, Missouri.

"HISTORY OF CALLOWAY COUNTY, MISSOURI"

"Stephen Garrett, a Frenchman, settled in Buckingham County, of Virginia.

"His children were: Stephen, John, David, Elijah, William, Mary, Elizabeth.

"William married Mary Branch Coleman, of Virginia, by whom he had: Spilsbury, James, William B., Stephen, Reuben, Allen, John, Elijah, Coleman, Magdalene, Lucy, Mary.

"Spilsbury married Biddie Hackett and settled in Ralls County, where he died. (Not accurate—Ed.)

"James married nancy Brown and settled in Tennessee.

"Elijah married Martha Glover, and settled in Calloway County, Missouri, in 1832.

"James, Ann and Magdalene married and settled in Tennessee.

"Coleman, Mary and Reuben married and settled in Illinois.

"Stephen settled in South Missouri.

"John in Virginia.

"Lucy married and lived in Kentucky.

"William B. Garrett, born Nov. 1, 1795, married Mary Ockerman, June 3rd, 1824. Came in Missouri in 1829.

"When the war broke out in 1812, he was a mere boy, but, carried away by the patriotic fervor of the day, he enlisted and served during the war.

"He settled on Hancock Prairie, in Calloway Co., Mo., in 1832. By industry and economy, united with good business qualities, he made a fortune.

"He built the first steam saw mill in Calloway Co., from which he derived a good income.

"His children were Wilson, Jane, Linneus B., Amanda C., John A., William H., George W., Benjamin F., and James M."

This record was sent to Miss Mary E. Gaither by John A. Garrett on Sept. 3rd, 1900.

"Mr. Clyde B. Garrett, Crockett, Texas.

"Dear Sir: I am glad that you found my last communication interesting. I have been trying to gain other information in regard to the parties you ask me to. But so far have failed, as all the OLDER people are dead that knew anything regarding the Garrett family. Now I did know a little something of Uncle Jack (John) Garrett as he lived not very far from Buckingham Courthouse not long after the Civil War

"And I will say that I have frequently heard my mother say:

that BOTH of my GRANDFATHERS was in the Revolutionary War. Grandfather Nixon never returned, but I do not remember particulars _ _ _ _ ."
