Gaumer family tradition has it that the twin son John (b. 1750) of John Dietrich and Mary Elizabeth (Meinert) Gaumer never married but went to Philadelphia with his brother Jacob to work as blacksmiths. He was never heard from again. The record given under John Gaumer, twin, b. 1750, was taken from the baptismal records of Zion Union (Lehigh) Church at Alburtis, not far from Allentown, Pa.

In "Births and Baptisms of Somerset Co., Pa.," by Dr. E. C. Saylor of Berlin, Pa., Jacob Gaumer, Sr., is recorded under Gummer. It is also recorded that a "John Gummer (Kummer)" married Maria Elizabeth Grissing, sister of Elder Arnd Grissing, in Berlin, Pa., Dec. 9, 1789 and had the following children:

Anna Maria, b. Oct. 13, 1790; bapt. Nov. 26, 1790; witnesses: Hannah Grissing (single)

Susanna, b. Feb. 15, ----; bapt. April 7, 1792; witnesses: John Arnd Griesing and Susanna Bitterin

Hanna, b. Feb. 2, 1796; bapt. Aug. 15, 1796; witnesses: Arnd Grissing and wife

(Could this be the twin John (b. 1750), son of John Dietrich and Mary Elizabeth Gaumer and brother of Jacob, Sr., with Mary Elizabeth Grissing his second wife?)

A Peter Gaumer, Sr., possibly a brother of John Dietrich Gaumer, Sr., is recorded in the 1790 Census for Pennsylvania as living in Macunge Township, Northampton (Lehigh) Co. Males over 16: 4; Females: 2.

"Enleise (Ana Louise?) is born May 10, 1837."

"William ist g- " (On a slip of paper lying between the leaves: "William is born September 10, 1869. Fore(?) Jon is born June 28, 1865.")

Henry Gaumer, 25 years of age, was drowned in the flood of Jan. 26, 1839 while carrying the mail and fording a stream near Allentown, Pa. He is buried at Allentown, northeast corner of 10th and Lincoln. He left a widow. (Roberts' History of Lehigh County, Pa.) His burial record says he was born Jan. 4, 1814; died Jan. 26, 1839.

A Henry Gaumer was a captain of the 8th Co., 2d Batt., Berks Co., Pa., May 17, 1777.

A Mathias Gaumer served with the Associators and Militia, Northampton Co., Pa., Aug. 18, 1781.

As early as 1739, John Mathias Egner secured a warrant for land in Macungie Twp., Northampton Co., Pa.

Mathias Egner is mentioned among the early settlers of Salisbury Twp. (Roberts' History of Lehigh County, Pa., v.1, p. 875) Roberts' also mentions (v.1, p. 904) a Jacob Eagner under Land Warrants, Upper Macungie, 153 acres, May 8, 1750. He gives John Eigner and Matthias Eigner as on the tax list for Macungie Twp. for 1762. (v.1, p. 907)

Hannah Wieder, grand-daughter of John Andrew Strassburger and Eva Yeager, married Thomas Egner. Hannah was "still in her minority" in 1829. (The Strassburger Family, by Ralph Beaver Strassburger. p.111-113)

A beautiful building on Muhlenberg Campus, Allentown, Pa., is the Egner Hartzell Memorial Chapel.

Little is known of Mathias Gaumer, son of John Dietrich and Catherine (Egner) Gaumer. In an Assessment at Easton, Pa., Dec. 27, 1781, of the township of Macungie, Matthias Gaumer is listed as a "single freeman." (Roberts' History of Lehigh County, Pa., v.1, p. 908.) A Matthias Gaumer is listed on the tax assessment for Macungie Twp. for 1812.
