

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
GENEALOGY OF

The Family of Haslewood,

OF OLDDINGTON AND NEWTON IN THE PARISH OF WORFIELD, AND OF
BRIDGNORTH, CO. SHROPSHIRE.

Compiled by REV. FRANCIS HASLEWOOD,

From pedigrees made by the late Joseph J. Morris of Shrewsbury (who d. 1860, now in the possession of E. Cresswell Peele, Esq., of that town, who kindly permitted a copy to be taken), and the late Wm. Hardwicke, Registrar of Bridgnorth, 1829, and verified by reference to wills and parish registers.



According to Morris V., f. 2559, the Arms are—Or, a fess dancetté azure ; Crest—A squirrel eating a nut gules. But this branch have for several generations claimed the Arms and Crest granted to Edmund Haselwood, of Northampton, by Christopher Barker, temp. Hen. VIII. betw. 1536 and 1548. Coll. of Arms, Vincent, 79. Brit. Mus., Harl. MS. 5846, 48.

ARMS.—On a chev. gu. between 3 owls sa. as many lozenges erm. on a chief az. three hazel branches, or.

CREST.—A squirrel sejant az. collared or, charged with three bezants in pale, holding a hazel branch ppr. fructed or.

MOTTO.—“Quod me mihi reddit amicum.”*

That which makes me on good terms with myself, i.e., a good conscience.

Haslewood Pedigree.

MATILDA, called Eudenas, widow of Roger, son of = THOMAS HASELWODE of Oldington, in par. of Worfield, near Bridgnorth, Shropshire. Hard-—. . . . Stephen Bradeneye, and da. of Richard Eudenas, wicke asserts "either he or his ancestors derived their name from their residence near a wood of 1st wife. son of Rob. de Eudenas, younger son of Rich. Lord hazels, probably in or about the township of Oldington, then much covered with wood." But of Eudenas. [M. c. 2 Hen. V., 1414.] 2nd wife. s. p. Morris says he "probably came from Haselwode, near Harpsford, par. of Chetton, Salop."

Richard of Newton in 20 Hen. VI., 1441, was admitted to a messe and half-yard land there, under the surrender of Thos. Richards, *alias* Steward (Tonward), and Agnes his wife.

Edith Richards, da. of Tho. Richards of Stapleford. Edith died 13 Edw. IV., 1473, seized of a messe and half-yd. land in Newton, called Pollaxland.

Thomas of Oldington, s. and h. In 13 Edw. IV., — on the death of Edith, admitted to a messe and half-yd. land in Newton, which he then surrendered to the use of his brother John, and d. 16 Edw. IV., 1476, seized of two tofts, and yd. land in Oldington.

John of Newton, d. 22 Edw. IV., 1482, seized of Alice, d. 2 Hen. VII., 1486, having a messe, toft, and yd. land in Newton, which surrendered a toft and half-yd. land, Alice his wife held for her life, and also of a messe and half-yd. land called Pollaxland.

Thomas of Oldington, s. and h. — Joan, died 14 Hen. VII., 1498, seized of a mesusage and yd. land in Oldington.

John of Newton, s. and h., admitted to the estate 24 Feb., 17 Eliz., 1574, [and in 43 Eliz., 1600; settled a toft and half-yd. land in Sarde upon himself and Elizabeth his wife.] Elizabeth, da. of Hen. Whorwode of Bobbington, by Jane his wife, da. of Wm. Rickthorn. Ped. of Whorwood, Harl. MS. 6128, 46. Shaw's Staffs.

Margery, m. 2 May, 1562, at W., John Potter of Claverley. This is the first Haslewood entry in W. register.
