INTRODUCTION

EIGHT years have elapsed since I began tracing out the records of my Harwood ancestors and relatives; and I have now the pleasure of presenting to the descendants of my ancestor, James Harwood, this little History of our Branch of the New England Harwoods.

When I first began tracing the records, I had no thought of writing the family history. I was led to engage in the work simply by a desire to know more of my ancestry in the Harwood line. But as my interest in the work increased, I decided upon the plan of publishing the records in some form, by which the memory of our forefathers might be perpetuated, and we, their descendants, might come to know more of one another.

Being the first to write the history of our Branch of Harwoods, I have had to collect most of the records from original sources, thus adding greatly to the labor of the undertaking. I wish here to acknowledge the kindness of those who have aided me with their letters or orally in tracing out these records. A list of those who have aided me will be found at the end of the book.

In arranging the records in this book, I have aimed to give the facts which I have collected in as plain and contise a manner as possible, and so arranged that the connection may be easily seen. With regard to this arrangement,

Harwood are numbered, beginning with our common ancestor (James,) and carrying the order down through all the generations. An Index will be found in the back part of the book giving the NAME and NUMBER of each Harwood, whose name is enrolled in this book.

I have taken particular care to get the names and dates correct, and I think that all parts of the Record may be relied upon as accurate.

In conclusion, I would say that this has been a work requiring much labor and expense; and I hope it may meet the ends for which it is designed in giving us a better knowledge of our ancestors, and enabling us, their descendants, to become better acquainted with one another. Should this hope be realized, my labor will not have been in vain.

FIRST GENERATION.

1. James Harwood was of English origin. He married Lydia Barrett, at Chelmsford, Massachusetts, in April, 1678. They resided in Chelmsford until about 1717, when they removed to Littleton, Mass., where he died Aug. 1, 1719.

SECOND GENERATION.

CHILDREN OF JAMES HARWOOD, NO. 1.

- 2. Andrew, born in Chelmsford, Mass., Sept. 2, 1692.
- 3. Abigail, twin sister to Andrew, died Sept. 1, 1695.
- 4. James, born in Chelmsford, Sept. 30, 1695. He removed with his father to Littleton, Mass., in 1717. He married, and resided in Littleton until 1727, when he sold his land in that town, and removed to Dunstable, (now Nashua), N. H. In 1747, we find his name in a list of those who voted against settling Rev. Mr. Bird as pastor in Dunstable. Again we find him, in 1754, as one of the signers of a Petition for dividing the Province of New Hampshire into counties.
 - 5. John, twin brother of James, died in infancy.
 - 6. Abigail, born in Chelmsford, May 18, 1699.
- 7. John, born in Chelmsford, May 29, 1703. He signed the deed with his brother James, when they sold their land in Littleton, in 1727, and probably moved with him to Dunstable, (now Nashua), N. H.

THIRD GENERATION.

CHILDREN OF JAMES HARWOOD, NO. 4.

- 8. Andrew, born in Littleton, Mass., July 5, 1722.
- 9. Eunice, born in Littleton, March 21, 1724.
- 10. Mary, born in Littleton, June 6, 1726.
- 11. James, born in Dunstable, N. H., about the year 1730. He signed the Petition, in 1754, for dividing the Province of New Hampshire into counties. He married a Miss Clogston, who was of Irish origin. He was a soldier in the old French and Indian war, and belonged to the company of Rogers' Rangers. They were sent from Dunstable in 1759, and were at the storming of Quebec, Canada. He entered the American army in the war of the Revolution, and was in the first Regiment from Dunstable. He was in the battles of Lexington and Bunker hill. He went to Canada with the army, where he died of small-pox, Dec., 1777, and was buried on Montreal Island.

CHILDREN (probably) OF JOHN HARWOOD,

- 12. John, born in Dunstable, N. H. He served in the old French and Indian war, in the company of Roger's Rangers, and was with James, (No. 11) at the storming of Quebec. He married Abigail Hastings, of Amherst, N. H., and settled in Mount Vernon, N. H., where he died about 1812. He was a farmer.
- 13. James, born in Dunstable, N. H. He served in the American army in the war of the Revolution, and was killed at Hubbardton, Vt., July 7, 1777, on the retreat of the army from Ticonderoga, N. Y.

CHILDREN OF JAMES HARWOOD, NO. 11.
All born in Dunstable, N. H.

- 14. James, born in 1760. He married Patty Sanders, and settled in Unity, N. H. In the spring of 1800, while at work cutting ice out of the flume of a saw-mill, the ice gave way, and he was carried over the dam and killed almost instantly. He was a farmer. His wife was born in 1759, and died in 1839. She was a member of the Congregational Church.
- 15. Archibald, born Aug., 1762. He entered the American army in the war of the Revolution, in 1778, when only 16 years of age. He was one of those who were sold to the British by the traitor Arnold. After the war was over, he went to Weathersfield, Windsor Co., Vermont, where he married Susannah House, who was born Feb., 1762. He was a carpenter and mill-wright by trade. He removed to Eden, Lamoille Co. (then Orleans Co.), Vermont, about 1802, to build the first mills ever built there. After that he resided in Constable, Franklin Co., N. Y. He died in Eden, Vt., in 1837. His wife died in 1848. She was a member of the Methodist Episcopal Church.
- 16. John. (He is said to have had a family; but I have been unable to find any trace of his descendants, though I have been at considerable expense in trying to do so.)
- 17. Rosannah, married John Burlingame. They resided in Weathersfield. Vt., where they had children.
- 18. Lydia, married, Jonathan Ordway, and they had three children. She married, for her second husband, Jei-EDIAH HUTCHINS, and they had four children. She died in Constable, N. Y.

CHILDREN OF JOHN HARWOOD, NO. 12. All-born in Mount Vernon, N. H.

- 19. John, married Mary Carlton, in 1799. He lived and died on the old farm at Mount Vernon.
 - 20. Joseph, resided in Bennington, Vt.
- 21. William, born in 1770. He married ASENATH MILLS, in 1800. They settled in Warner, N. H. He died in 1847, and she in 1868. She was a member of the Congregational Church, at Mount Vernon, and afterward belonged to the Free Will Baptist Church, at Warner.
- 22. Edmond, married a Miss Jacks. They resided in Plainfield, Vt., where he died.
- 23. Andrew, born in 1777. He married REBEKAH CRAM, in 1804, and settled in Lyndeborough, N. H., where he died in 1860. He was a farmer.
- 24. Abigail, married WM. CARSON, and they had two children. Her second husband was ASA STILES; they had three children.
- 25. Betsey, married a Mr. Lynch. They had one child. Her second husband was Asa Carson. They had six children.
- 26. Mary, married MATTHEW JACKS. They resided in Plainfield, Vt., and had children.

- 28. James, born Dec. 28, 1789. He married Hannah Webster, of Unity, N. H., Feb. 25, 1809. They removed to Eden, Vt., where they lived two years; then returned to N. H. In 1824, they settled in Wilton, Maine. He was a farmer, and died Jan. 12, 1850. His wife died March 15, 1874.

- 29. Archibald, born Apr. 16, 1791, in Unity, N. II. He served in the war of 1812, as a teamster. He married Phebe Wells, of Peru, N. Y., and lived there for a time; then he moved back to Unity; and from there to Claremont, N. H. He was a farmer. He died Sept. 29, 1868, and his wife Dec. 18, 1866.
- 30. Simeon C., born July 4, 1794, in Unity, N. H. He married Parrilla Leavitt, Sept. 1, 1816. She was born May 22, 1799, in Rupert, Vt. They settled in Dickinson, Franklin Co., N. Y., in 1820, where he was a farmer many years. He was also a Postmaster in Dickinson, and a Justice of the Peace. He now resides in Moira, N. Y. He is a member of the Congregational Church, as was his wife, who died Sept. 12, 1872.
- 31. David, born in 1797, in Unity, N. H. He married Mrs. Philenda Orcutt, Aug. 15, 1829. They resided in Lynn, Mass., where he died May 3, 1843. His wife died Dec. 5, 1845.
- 32. Polly, born in Unity, N. H. She married Dea. John Worthley, and resided in Antrim, N. H. Their children were: John O., Mary, and Marian.

CHILDREN OF ARCHIBALD HARWOOD, NO. 15.

- 33. Jesse, born Oct. 15, 1786, in Weathersfield, Vt. He married Sally Scofield, Eden, Vt., about 1806. She was born in Conn., in 1788. They settled in Hadley, Saratoga Co., N. Y., where he died Oct. 18, 1824. His wife died at Floyd, Ia., Feb. 7, 1868. She belonged to the Congregational Church.
- 34. Sally, born in 1790, in Weathersfield, Vt. She married Charles Whittemore, in 1808. They resided in Eden, Vt., where she died Apr. 23, 1870. Their children were: Jerusha, Kingsbury, Richard, Lovica, Russell, Phila, William, and Ira.
- 35. Annis, born in 1792, in Weathersfield, Vt. She married CLARK ELY. They lived in Eden, Vt., where she died in 1868. They had two children: Samuel and Robert.

- 36. Cyrus, born in 1793, in Weathersfield, Vt. He married Mary Lee, about 1823. He studied law, and was admitted to the bar at Sandy Hill, N. Y. He removed to Orleans Co., N. Y., where he practiced his profession, and is said to have been appointed a Judge. In 1836, he removed to Michigan, where he died soon after.
- 37. Heman, born Dec. 19, 1794, in Weathersfield, Vt. He was in the American army in the war of 1812. He married Mary Stowell, at Eden, Vt., about 1819. She was born Dec. 3, 1794, in Winchester, N. H. They resided in Eden, until the spring of 1824, when they removed to Bangor, Franklin Co., N. Y. He was a farmer. In Oct. 1834, he went to Niagara, Upper Canada, to work; and in Aug., 1835, he wrote that he had been sick, and was coming home. That was the last his family ever heard of him; and it is supposed that he was either murdered for his money, of which he had a considerable sum, or drowned while on way home. His wife was a member of the Methodist Church, and died in Todd Co., Minn., Feb. 13, 1874.
- 38. Luke, born Apr. 6, 1797, in Weathersfield, Vt. He married Lucinda Leavitt, in 1820. She was sister to his cousin Simeon's wife, and was born Aug. 30, 1796. They resided in Franklin Co., N. Y., until 1832, when they removed to Wayne Co., Mich.; and from there to Ionia Co., Mich., where he died Apr. 16, 1863. He was a farmer. His wife was a member of the Presbyterian Church, and died Sept. 26, 1870.
- 39. Amanda, born in 1799, in Weathersfield, Vt. She married ROYAL CHAMBERLAIN. They had children.
- 40. James, born Jan. 13, 1801, in Weathersfield, Vt. He married Arvilla Sartwell, at Eden, Vt. They settled in Perry, Allen Co., Ind., in 1836. He is supposed to be dead. His wife is again married, and lives in Allen Co., Ind.
- 41. Phila, born July 8, 1803, in Eden, Vt. She married Reuben Adams, Dec. 12, 1822. They reside in Crete, Ill. Their only child, Laura A., was born Feb. 18, 1828, and died March 12, 1850.

- 42. Amy, born in 1807, in Eden, Vt., and died in 1833 aged twenty-six years.
- 43. Riley, born July 4, 1810, in Eden, Vt. He married Orrilla Stowell, May 13, 1830. She was sister to his brother Heman's wife, and was born in Eden, Vt. Jan. 21, 1810. He was a farmer, and resided in Bangor, N. Y., where he died July 3, 1863, and where she still resides.

H., and was Colonel of a Reg't. of Mass. Militia. He was Deputy Sheriff of Worcester Co., Mass., several years, and he also held various town offices in Ashburnham. He died Sept. 7, 1858, and his wife May 16, 1868.

- 96. Oliver P., born Feb. 17, 1820. He married Jan-ETTE IDE at Stockton, N.Y., Oct. 15, 1842. She was born at Corinth, N.Y., Apr. 14, 1820. He was by profession a lawyer, though largely engaged in other pursuits. There they organized a bank, and had a well established business. He died Jan. 10, 1879.

- 102. Oliver, born July 21, 1824, in Bangor, N. Y., and died July 8, 1825.
- 103. Oliver, born Feb. 6, 1826, in Bangor, N. Y. He married Elizabeth Steenberge, Sept. 24, 1850. They removed to Wisconsin, in 1855. He was in the Union army. He enlisted Feb. 10, 1862, in Co. I, 5th Reg't, Wisconsin Infantry, and was in the army of the Potomac. He was in several battles during the two years for which he at first enlisted. He re-enlisted Feb. 28, 1864, and was taken prisoner in the battle of the Wilderness, May 5, 1864. He was confined in the rebel prison at Andersonville, Ga., until Sept. 12, 1864, when he was removed to the prison at Florence, S. C., where he was kept a prisoner till Feb. 16, 1865, when he was released, and sent to the Union lines. The story of the sufferings of those confined in these prison pens is well known to all. He returned to his home in Wisconsin, where he married, for his second wife, Lucy E. CUMMINGS, Aug. 25, 1867. They reside at Oasis, Wis., and are Free Will Baptists. He is a farmer, and has been a Justice of the Peace,
