### **PREFACE**

The desire to know something of our ancestors is very general, and the greater the knowledge acquired the more interesting the subject becomes.

Daniel Webster stated: "Those who do not look upon themselves as a link connecting the past with the future do not perform their duty to the world."

If it is deemed necessary to write up the pedigrees of certain animals and register them, is not the record of a worthy family much more important?

The preparation of a genalogical record is a work the magnitude of which is realized by few who have not had experience in such work. In the collection of the material necessary to make this record, the author has spent a number of years. It has necessitated the writing of thousands of letters and the deciphering of information contained in many thousands of old documents dating back to the early history of this country. The author has travelled thousands of miles searching these old records.

In presenting a work of this kind, one of the discouragements one meets with is the failure of those uninterested to answer letters seeking information, and the information thus sought at first hand frequently has to be obtained from some other source. This indifference on the part of many greatly increases the work to be done, and it also increases the possibilities of errors creeping in. No doubt there will be some who will be disappointed because the record of their families is not given in more complete form or because of errors in it, but in almost every instance of this kind the reason for such errors or omissions will be found in the failure of those uninterested to answer letters of inquiry.

This pamphlet is to preserve in lasting form the record of the family before the destroying hand of Time has rendered such a record impossible. Notwithstanding my earnest labors, I am not unmindful that my work is far from complete. My ardent hope, however, is that some person in the near future may take up the subject where I leave it and give a more full and interesting history of the family than it has been possible for me to do at this time. At the suggestion of the Library of Congress, Geneological Division, the author has tried to follow the New England method for compiling a geneology. This method is most easily followed by the reader.

First the name is listed followed by date of birth, date of death, date of marriage, name of person married, their birth and date of their death. The children listed by Roman numerals. If five or more children they are listed giving only the date of birth, if known. The ones who have married or who married and have children will have an Arabic numeral before the Roman numeral. This indicates that further information will be given in its proper place under the same Arabic numeral.

In most instances, I have endeavored to bring the history up to date far enough so that the present generation can fill in back to their listed ancestors.

## THE INBODY FAMILY

The family name is spelled several different ways: Inbody, Enbody, Inboden, Imboden, Imbody, and others - originating in Switzerland - because there were no surnames until the ninth and tenth centuries. There became so many John's, George's, Henry's, etc. that something had to be done. A law was enacted making it compulsory to acquire a surname, and it was done this way: The John, who was a carpenter, became John Carpenter; the John, who was a stonemason, became John Stone or John Mason.

The name Inbody, Imboden, etc., was defined as "the man residing on flat lands" as by a lake or river.

During the sixteenth century, Switzerland recorded four families by these names and were located in the following places: one at Bern, one at Biel, one at Basel, and one at Interlaken.

Kasper Imboden, born 1612, died 1670, was principal of schools at Biel, also a minister at Ernen, Firch and Glis.

John Peter Imboden, born 1686, died 1764, was an author of a large number of popular dramas, he also was a minister.

Several other members of these family occupied positions similar to that of our national senators in the legislative branch of Switzerland.

Many families were driven from Switzerland by the Catholics during the religious wars of the sixteenth century. Some went to Germany and settled along the Rhine River. Others went to the Netherlands, and some to England.

The above information was given by Mr. Faesch, of the Swiss Embassy, Washington, D. C., and was taken from a large book on Swiss family names.

The Inbody family that came to America, John Adam Inbody's, sailed from Rotterdam and landed in Philadelphia,

Pennsylvania, about 1740, or before, and settled in Berks County, Pennsylvania.

Another family that spelled their name Imboden, came to America after the Inbody family. John Adam Imboden came to America on the ship "Two Brothers" commanded by Captain Thomas Arnot, landed in Philadelphia September 15, 1752. Approximately 19 years old, and not even having money to pay his fare, John Adam Imboden was sold into bondage (not uncommon in those days) to a family by the name of Sweigert. He was so fond of these people that he changed his name to John Sweigert Imboden. He settled in Annville, Lebanon County, Pennsylvania. He married Eleanor Diller, and they had eleven children.

John and Eleanor's oldest son, John, moved to a place near Staunton, Virginia, married, and he also had eleven children.

The eighth child of John and Eleanor's, George, married Isabella Wunderlick, and they had eleven children. The first child of George and Isabella, John Daniel, was a general in Lee's army and covered Lee's retreat from Gettysburg, saving his wagon train and many of his men. The seventh child, George W., was a colonel. The ninth child, Francis Marion, was a captain. The tenth child, James A., was a major — all in the army of General Robert E. Lee.

The two families were related. An old uncle of the author related to him that he had visited relatives in Lebanon County, None of the Inbody family lived in Lebanon County at that time It would appear that John Sweigert, born 1733, was a nephew of John Adam, born 1709, and came to America after John Adam

John Adam Inbody's father's name was Daniel, who probably did not come to America.

I - John Adam Inbody, born February 27, 1709, died June 27, 1790, and is buried at Hill Church Cemetery in Berks County, Pennsylvania. The author visited the cemetery, and the thirteen oldest gravestones were weathered so badly that he could not distinguish the grave. The records (in German) are preserved in Berks County Historical Society and is the only record of John Adam's father, Daniel.

John Adam Inbody had four sons of record:

- 2 ii. Adam, born 1746, in Berks County, Pa., lived there until his death 1806. Henry and Adam were probably twins. Adam first married Catherine in 1767, and after her death, he married Maria. To these marriages thirteen children were born.
- i. Catherine, born 1768, married and had several children. She died before her father, Adam, filed his Will, which is dated May 12, 1805, and all thirteen children are mentioned in the Will. Copy furnished to author by Mrs. Steinmetz.
- ii. Johannes, born 1770, married Elizabeth Engel on March 29, 1792. They had four children.
- iii. Marie, born 1772, married Peter Geres on July 2, 1795.
- iv. Daniel, born 1775, first marriage was in Berks County, Pa., and had one son. Later he moved to Hocking County, Ohio, where on March I, 1827, he married Lydia Hostler.

Ann Margaret Lynn's parents were Peter Lynn who came to America, Sept. 26, 1737, from Hanan, Germany. He died 1761. He married Ann Margaret Bruner who was the daughter of Felix and Anna Barbara Bruner. Their seven children were:

The widow married George Schantzenbuck and had two children, George and Catherine, who married Casper Rumfield Reference Lehigh Co., Pa. History, Mrs. C. M. Steinmetz, Reading, Pa., and record of St. Gabriels Episcopal Church, Douglasville, Pa.

Nicholas, served in the Revolutionary War under Captain Lentz, in 1777 and 1778, as recorded in the Pennsylvania Archives, Third Series, Volume Six, page 275. Any female descendant can use this service record as an aid in proving her eligibility for admission to the Daughters of the American Revolution.

Mrs. Bessie Harley Eagle was Vice Chairman Eastern District National Society Daughters of American Revolution and was a descendant of Nicholas' daughter, Catherine, and was admitted on the service of Nicholas Inbody. This too could be cited as an aid in proving eligibility to become a member of the D.A.R.

Nicholas and Ann Margaret Inbody were parents of six children:

Nicholas' daughter, Catherine, married Captain Lewis Sinsendorfer, and with one son, Martin, moved to Berkley County, Virginia, near Martinsburg, (now West Virginia) in 1799.

In the early 1800's, Nicholas Inbody, and the remainder of his family moved to Berkley County, Virginia. All of the sons of Nicholas married women of this area. Later, all except Catherine, moved to Ohio. Nicholas first settled in Fairfield County, Ohio, about 1814 or '15. Later in Hocking County. Record of deeds of Hocking County, Vol. A, p. 469, shows that President James Monroe, granted to Nicholas Inbody (note spelling) one-half section of Section I, Township 14 Range 17, 361.85 acres of land. This land included that on which the old Hocking County fair grounds once stood and on which the large General Electric plant is now located, and

extended from Logan, Ohio city limits for more than a mile on Route 75 towards Webb Summit. The date of this grant and purchase was April 1, 1816.

Both Nicholas and Ann Margaret are buried in the old Bright Cemetery on land Nicholas owned, and is located immediately after turning off Route 75 on to Route 15, and is on the right side of the road up against a hill, and is grown up with brush and trees. There are several gravestones standing, but the author has been unable to find any for Nicholas or Ann Margaret, or any record of who is buried there. Nicholas, died between November 12, 1823, the date of final settlement No. 41, General Land Office, and July 26, 1827, the date of the record of Partitions and Settlements Common Pleas Court, Hocking County, Logan, Ohio, pages 18-27. Ann Mary's name does not appear in this record. She probably died before that time. Record of marriages of Nicholas sons, was taken from Court House records of Marriages, Berkley County, West Virginia, and furnished the author by Bessie Harley Eagle.

The names and approximate ages listed in settlement of estate of John Inbody, who died March 4, 1859. Recorded in Elkhart County Court House, Elkhart, Indiana.

After the death of Nicholas, Mathias inherited that part of land next to the Logan, Ohio city boundary and built a log house. This house was pointed out by the father of the author when he was young, and he was also told that when built it was one of the finest between Zanesville and Springfield, Ohio, a distance of more than 100 miles. It was a four-room, chunked and daubed log house. The logs were hewn smooth inside and out, the corners notched, and the space between the logs filled with pieces of wood and clay mud in and around to keep it warm and wind proof. The author was born in a similar built house near where this farm is located.

In 1836, Mathias and all of his children, except i. John, iii. Joseph, and v. Margaret, moved to Elkhart County, Indiana, and settled near Goshen on the Elkhart River. (See Chapman's History of Elkhart County, Indiana, page 962.)

Mathias and Catherine are buried at the Inbody Community Church near Goshen, along with at least 125 members of the Inbody family. The author visited the church several years ago and found that Mathias Inbody and Catherine Imbody (note spelling) are buried side by side to the right as you enter the gate to the cemetery.

Jane married Joseph Inbody during 1853, and to them eleven children were born.

Jane was born May 28, 1825, and died May 26, 1882. She is buried at Pleasant Hill Cemetery in Marion Township, Hocking Co., Ohio.
