BEAVER COUNTY RECORDS OF INMAN FAMILY

DEED BOOK 85, Pages 11 to 13:

SARAH INMAN and heirs sell a tract of land to JOHN ALEXANDER, land located in Racoon Township, Beaver County, date of transaction February 24, 1874. Names SARAH INMAN, widow of WILLIAM INMAN, dec'd and also lists their children and heirs as follows:

NANCY M. INMAN

ELIZABETH INMAN ( who with Ezekiel gives Allegheny City as residence )

JAMES B. INMAN, who signs for himself and as Atty and representative of

JOHN INMAN, of Racoon Twp, Beaver County, and James of Hancock Co. West Va.

EZEKIEL INMAN, signed by his attorney, James Cameron.

This tract of land included one fourth part that the Admr of the estate of RACHEL INMAN, dec'd, sister of WILLIAM, had sold to SARAH INMAN, Jan 5, 1869.

DEED BOOK H, page 103: names John Thatcher and Elizabeth his wife late Elizabeth Hill, widow of Daniel Hill.

DEED BOOK H. page 100, date Nov 15, 1827, JONATHAN HILL, Admr, and ANN HILL, as children of DANIEL HILL, dec'd.

Four Articles of Agreement are recorded, made between DANIEL HILL, and various persons to which he sold land located " on Big Road leading from McIntosh, ( Beaver) to Eunion Williams Mill, between Brady Run and Big Beaver Creek".

These are dated between June 3, 1796, and October 26, 1801; one of the articles names DANIEL HILL as living in Allegheny County. ( Beaver Co. set up in 1800 a lot of what was Allegheny County made into new Beaver County.)

The JOHN INMAN in Deed Book 85, pages 11 to 13, in JOHN ALEXANDER INMAN, of Racoon Twp, Beaver Co.

DEED BOOK H, PAGE 100: Property in Beaver County sold by JONATHAN HILL, to JOHN AND ELIZABETH INMAN HILL THATCHER.

DEED BOOK H, pages 102-3: SAME PROPERTY sold in Beaver County by John and Elizabeth Inman Hill Thatcher to Robert Darragh.

Note: Johnathan Hill, son of Elizabeth, would have become of age in 1821 1821.  
This property is where Henry Inman lived and his family still live. So far, no proof of relationship of Henry Inman to Elizabeth Inman Hill Thatcher.

REVOLUTIONARY

WAR

RECORD

Born in Frederick County, Maryland, September 25, 1758

Pension January 18, 1834

Died 1845 in Beaver County, Pennsylvania

Entered service March 9, 1775, from ALLEGHENY COUNTY, six months under Henry Haglan, John Haglas, Lt. Henry Nelson, Ens. (Wilson?) in spying in northwestern part of said state of Pennsylvania, to wit: Allegheny, Westmoreland, Washington, Fayette, Green, Beaver, Butler and Mercer Counties; marched from Allegheny in pursuit of Indians..to Fort Pitt..to Montures Fort about ten miles below on the Ohio River; returned home to Allegheny County at end of discharge. March 1776 volunteered under Capt Simms, the Lt and Ens names not recollected. GEORGE ARMSTRONG, Sgt, and marched from Allegheny County to Montures fort, which was at the point of Long Island ? and Logstown fort on Ohio River ....My brother was killed by Indians as he was descending the river in a canoe.....discharged on Sept 26, 1776 by Simms...mentioned Col Gibson during above tour..moved to Westmoreland between first and seventh of November, 1776..where volunteered under Capt Ralph Cherry, Henry Woolery, Lt, and John Cunningham, Ens Penn Militia; marched from Westmoreland County 16 of October, 1776, up the Conemaugh river to Conemaugh fort; left and spied thru Allegheny & Westmoreland Counties. Discharged on 18 of December; saw Col Campbell and Tennery and Major Kilgore. I THEN MARRIED AND SETTLED MYSELF, but in the year 1781 the Indian hostilities became so grear that I again on June 10, 1781 volunteered under Capt James \_\_\_\_\_ Ens John Beers, James Clarke, Sgt; spied down to Ft. McIntosh..to Crooked Creek, to Ft Pitt; discharged Aug 10; 1781; MOVED TO BEAVER COUNTY IN 1796.

Henry Inman was born in Frederick County, Maryland, September 25, 1758; he died May 27, 1845 in Beaver County, Pennsylvania.

Esther Powers Inman was born September 30, 1767 and died December 29, 1830 in Beaver County, Penn. They were married January 25, 1784. ( Rev War record 1781 ?)

HENRY AND WILLIAM INMAN both appear in 1790 census of Mt. Pleasant Twp of Westmoreland County, and are related, and perhaps children of ABRAM AND NELLIE INMAN. ( This from Don Inman of Beaver Penna, descendent of Henry Inman .)

Henry Inman was a member of the Old Stone Methodist Episcopal Church of Northern Chippewa Twp, Beaver County, Penn, which was started initially by a group of Quakers. His gravestone still stands there stating age of Henry Inman as:

86 years, 8 months, 2 days.

ABRAHAM POWERS INMAN

son of Henry and Esther Inman, was born in Beaver County 1802, killed by a train in 1878 on a railroad bridge on a line between Cannelton and Beaver Falls.

Elizabeth Thatcher, daughter of John & Elizabeth Thatcher, was born in Beaver County 1808 and died between 1853 and 1871. They were married about 1828.

Nelson Inman married 1867 to Elizabeth Jane, dau Thomas & Nancy Ayers Small.

John Wesley Inman born Ohio Twp, Beaver Co, Aug 14, 1840; died Aug 14, 1913 at Cannelton, Pa; Married Hanna Young Edwards, born June 23, 1843 and died August 6, 1906. Daughter of William and Margretta Edwards. Married March 6, 1862;

Maude Barbra Hayes, who was born in a log cabin in South Beaver Twp, Beaver Co.

Pennsylvania March 6, 1876, died December 23, 1965 at Beaver Falls, Pa. They were married July 31, 1893 at Cannelton, by Rev. Daniel White. Six Children:

In Third Series Volume 22 of Pa Archives: page 433

County of Westmoreland, 1783:

WILLIAM INMAN 40 acres one horse

HENRY INMAN Single one horse.

This would be the Henry Inman who went to Westmoreland County and married 1784 ? 1784 ?

January 9, 1794 WILLIAM INMAN AND SARAH HILLIAR were married at Philadelphia, Pennsylvania in the First Presbyterian Church.

1790 Pennsylvania Census of Mt. Pleasant Twp of Westmoreland County:

ABRAHAM POWERS 2-4-5- He was later listed in Beaver County Tax Records 1802-6

HENRY HINEMAN 1-2-1 This is Henry Inman, who did have two sons in 1790 and lived in Westmoreland County until 1796 when he went to Beaver County with his wife Esther Powers, daughter of Abraham Powers.

.....

EZEKIEL INMAN of Moon Twp, Allegheny County, Penn had two sons and two daughters in 1790. William and his sister Sarah, see will 1874; also sister Rachel, see will 1874. The other daughter was probably Elizabeth, who married Daniel Hill and John Thatcher. She was out of Ezekiel's household by 1810 census. Ezekiel was in Moon Twp 1790, 1800 and still in 1810. Ezekiel Inman was also on tax list of 1792 in Moon Twp.

In 1880 census:

Bartholomew Thatcher, eldest son of John & Elizabeth Thatcher states that his mother was born in Virginia ( the part of Penn which was claimed by Virginia at the time of her birth ? 1780 ca) He states that his father was born in Penn. A daughter, Rebecca Torrence, states her mother was born in New Jersey and her father in Kentucky.
