COAT OF ARMS



The Ivey family Armorial Coat as recorded in Burke's General Armory:

ARMS: Gules, a lion rampant, or (gold).

CREST: A demi-lion, or (gold) supporting a staff raguly, vert (green)

EXPLANATION OF THE ABOVE ARMORIAL COAT:

GULES—Red denotes Military Fortitude and Magnanimity. This is the background color of the shield (shown as vertically hatched lines close together).

LION—Symbol of deathless courage.

RAMPANT—In walking position, with right paw held high.

OR—Yellow or gold denotes Generosity and Elevation of mind (shown as dotted surface).

DEMI-LION—Half lion.

RAGULY—When the staff is uneven or ragged, like the trunk or limb of a tree lopt of its branches.

VERT—Green signifies Hope, Joy and, sometimes, Loyalty in love (shown as diagonally hatched lines close together, right to left).

MOTTO—Esse quam videri (shown on ribbon). Translation: "To be rather than to appear."

INTRODUCTION

DURING the crusades, and for a number of years afterward, many families in Europe put the prefix St. to their names in order to indicate that they had taken part in these holy wars. This seems to have been the case with the Ivey family. Many of these families went over to England after the Norman conquest and we find St. Ivo and St. Ives in a number of counties. There is documentary evidence that Ivo, Ivey, Ivi, Ivy Ivie and Ivey are all of the same family. At a time when there were no dictionaries, the art of spelling was not highly developed. Sir Walter Raleigh spelled his name a dozen different ways, and the father of the writer spelled his name Ivy until about 1880, since which time all his children have spelled it Ivey. However, both his grandfather Benjamin and his great-grandfather Adam, spelled their names IVEY.

While in some parts of the country the name is unusual, there must be in the aggregate many thousands bearing this name. For instance, Adam Ivey, 1700-1762, had nine children, but we have record of only one, Benjamin who had seven. If his other eight children had large families, it can readily be seen that there are many who are unknown, so far as their descendants are concerned. This is the case of many other families where there were perhaps half a dozen children with only one known to posterity. When the first U. S. census was taken in 1790, there were twelve families in Virginia, as many in South Carolina, and twenty-nine in North Carolina. Outside of these three states only two families are recorded—one in Pennsylvania and one in Maryland.

In the Revolutionary War the names of six soldiers are listed from Virginia and nine from North Carolina. In the Civil War there were hundreds, some of them in almost every Southern state.

This treatise is in no sense of the word a history of the family, but rather a genealogical chart. Abundant material is at hand to write a history, but we will leave this task to other hands. Several tracts have been published, among which we will mention "Colonists of Carolina," by Blanche Humphery Abbe; "Men of the Burning Heart," by Plyler; "William and Mary College Quarterly," Volume 7, by W. Mac Jones, and "The Media Research Report." Many wills, deeds, grants, and other information are available, taken from the records of a score of counties, but many

important records were burned by the northern troops in 1860-1865.

Until about 1800 practically all of the family lived in Eastern North Carolina and Virginia. About this time Benjamin Ivey sold the land he had inherited from his father, Adam Ivey, in Edgecombe County, and settled in Randolph County. There are now many descendants of this family scattered throughout the Piedmont Section of North Carolina.

The oldest home is located near Seven Springs, Wayne County, N. C. It is more than a hundred and twenty-five years old, and is now occupied by Mattie Ivey West, a granddaughter of John Ivy, 1817-1893. To this shrine the eastern branch of the family gathers every year on the second Sunday in July. The fact that in 1940 there were 156 present shows that the family spirit is strong.

WILL OF ADAM IVEY, 1700-1762

IN THE NAME of God Amen; this tenth day of June in the year of Lord Christ one thousand seven hundred and sixty-two, I, Adam Ivey of Edgecombe County, being sick and weak of body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given unto God, therefore calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make and ordain this, my last Will and Testament, in manner and form following.

That is to say first and principally that I give my soul unto the hands of God who gave it me. My body I recommend to the earth to be decently buried in Christianlike manner at the descretion of my executors hereafter named. Without doubting but at the General Resurrection I shall receive the same by the mighty power of God and touching such worldly estate wherefore it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I bequeath in a manner and form following.

Once, it is my will that all just and lawful debts be paid, and funeral expenses.

I give and bequeath to my son Francis Ivey five shillings of sterling by bearer I have addrest to him already as much as my ability will afford. Item

I give and bequeath to my son Adam Ivey five shillings of sterling by bearer I have addrest to him already as much as my ability will afford. Item

I give and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth Ivey one side saddle and one spinning wheel which is called Nern, one box iron and twenty pounds of proclamation money. Item

I give and bequeath to my daughter Sarah Ivey twenty-five pounds proclamation money. Item

To her and her heirs I give and bequeath to my daughter Martha Ivey twenty-five pounds proclamation money to be paid to her at her arriving at the age of twenty-one years. Item

I give and bequeath to my son Lewis Ivey the old plantation that I bought of Wm Register containing two thousand acres of land and one young horse and saddle and all cattle with half moons in a ear and fifty pounds proclamation money to be paid to him at the age of twenty-one years and one rifled gunn. Item

I give and bequeath to my well beloved wife one side saddle and one spinning wheel which she calls Honoras and one wooling wheel

and six hundred pounds of pork and four hundred wait of beef and ten pounds of Indian Corn. I leave also to my well beloved wife one feather bed and furniture untell my son George comes of age and to be divided to him also. I give the insurance of my dwelling house and as much cleared land unto my son George as he shall tend during five years if no longer. Item

Also I leave to my beloved wife fifty pounds proclamation money untell my son George comes to the age of twenty-one years then thirty pounds to be paid to him and other twenty pounds at her decease to become due to my son George Ivey. Item

I give and bequeath to my daughter Mary Ivey twenty-five pounds proclamation money to be paid to her at the age of twenty years. Item

I give and bequeath to my son Benjamin Ivey the plantation we dwell on containing two hundred eighty-five acres of land and after all this is included the remains of my estate to my son Benjamin Ivey and his heirs forever and of this Will I make constitute, ordain and appoint my well beloved son Benjamin my whole and sole executor, revoking all and annulling all former and other wills by me hereinafter made, ratifying, and confirming this, and no other, this my last Will and Testament.

Witness my hand and seal this the date first above written.

This shall be declared by the said executor to be his last Will and Testament in the presence of us.

IN THE NAME of God Amen! I, Benjamin Ivey, of the County of Randolph and State of North Carolina, being of sound and perfect memory, thanks be to Almighty God! and calling to remembrance the frailty and uncertainty of human life, have made this Last Will and Testament, in the manner following:

I give and commit my soul into the hands of my merciful Creator, hoping for the remission of my sins through the merits of my Blessed Redeemer, Jesus Christ.

My body I leave to be buried at the discretion of my Executors, hereafter named, Imps., and as to my estate, both real and personal, I leave in the following manner after my just debts are honestly paid:

Item: I leave to my wife, **Sally Ivey**, during her natural life, my negro woman named Eady and my negro man named Bob, one feather bed and furniture, one cow and calf, one sow and pigs, one black walnut chest, one table of her own choice, one pewter dish, and six pewter plates, and at her decease to be divided among my children, and then I give it to them and their heirs forever. Except Bob, at wife's decease, I give to my son, **Isaac**, to him and his heirs forever. I also leave the Tract of Land whereon I now live, containing one hundred and ninety acres, with all the improvements thereon during her widowhood, and at her death or marriage I give it to my son, **Isaac**, to him and his heirs forever.

Item: I give to my son, **Kinchen**, 200 acres of land on Tom's Creek, one negro girl named Raney, twenty dollars in cash forever.

Item: I give to my daughter, **Rebecca Kearns**, one negro boy named Sam, I give it to her and her heirs forever.

Item: I give to my daughter, **Betsy Nance**, one hundred acres of land on the waters of Jackson's Creek, one negro boy named Reddick, I give it to her heirs forever.

Item: I give to my daughter, **Prisey**, one negro boy named Amos, one feather bed and furniture and twenty silver dollars. I give it to her and her heirs forever.

Item: I give to my daughter, **Sally**, one feather bed and furniture, and if so be there should be increase of any more negroes in the family, her choice of one, or 100 silver dollars and twenty silver dollars.

Item: I give to my **daughter, Sukey**, one feather bed and furniture, and if any more increase, she may have, as was said of Sally, choice of one negro or one hundred silver dollars, also twenty dollars, to her and to her heirs forever.

Item: I give to my **son, Isaac**, one feather bed and furniture and twenty dollars in cash, also my land whereon I now live, containing one hundred and ninety acres, at the death or inter-marriage of his mother, to him and to his heirs forever.

Item: I give to my **son, Benjamin**, 300 silver dollars due from Marshall Nance, when it becomes due my Executors to let it out upon interest until he comes to the age of 21 years, then deliver both interest and principal. I give it to him and to his heirs forever. And as to my negro Jude and Stephen, I leave to my wife until my daughter, Sukey, comes to the age of eighteen, except she should marry again. All the estate, with Stephen and Jude, is to be divided at the marriage and if not married when Sukey comes to age of eighteen, then all to be sold unwilled and divided between my wife and children, she to have an equal part with each child. I give it to her and her heirs and their heirs forever.

Lastly: I nominate and appoint my beloved friend, Benjamin Steed, Executor, and my loving wife, Sally Ivey, Executrix of this my Last Will and Testament and as Trustee to see this will duly executed, hereby revoking all other former wills by me made, declaring this only to be my Last Will and Testament.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal
Seventeenth of October 1801.

According to the cus-
toms in early Mormon
history, many of his
sons had three or four
wives, and while we
have the record of only
six of his nine sons and
none of the daughters,
the six sons had an
aggregate of 102 chil-
dren, one son having 24
and another 25. If we
had a complete record it
is safe to say that this
one man had more than
200 grandchildren.

It is estimated by Lloyd
O. Ivie, Salt Lake City,
Utah, who has kindly
furnished this material,
that there are not less
than a thousand people
living in Utah and sur-
rounding states who are
direct descendants of
this one man, and the
work they have done in
developing the western
country is incalculable.

It was originally intend-
ed to publish a complete
record of all the known
Iveys (the spelling Ivie,
we think has no bearing
on the case), but this
material coming in after
the rest of the book was
ready for the press, and
the unexpected number
of descendants, make it
impracticable to include
all the material at hand.
It is deeply regretted
that all the data can not
be recorded, but the
work has already taken
several years to com-
pile, and it seems un-
wise to defer it longer.
