EDMUND INGALLS and FRANCIS INGALLS came from England to Massachusetts with Governor Endicott's colony, landing at Salem September, 1628.

Tradition says they were from Lincolnshire, but no proof of this has been found. The place of their birth is unknown.

They were the first settlers of Lynn, Essex Co., Mass. (1628-9), where they had a grant of 120 acres of land and followed farming, stock raising, and the tanning of leather.

Francis (b. 1601?) lived at Swampscott (Waldo Thompson's Hist.), where he had a tannery. His will is recorded in the Suffolk Registry at Boston. He left no male descendants, and his daughter Mary married Roger Belknap.

EDMUND INGALLS¹ died from the effects of an injury received by falling through a defective bridge while traveling on horseback from Lynn to Boston. His will, dated Aug. 28, 1648, was presented for probate Sept. 14, 1648, and is on file, with inventory of his estate, in the Essex Registry at Salem, Mass.
