THE JAYNES FAMILY HISTORY

The following pages contain the Jaynes family history as I have been able to compile it from the sources listed.

My format was originally developed in an attempt to analyze the material contained in "The Jaynes Family Of Long Island" by Edmund H. Jayne. While I found an abundance of data in that volume, it was very disorganized and difficult to follow. I made no effort to verify his data by independent research of genealogical information. I did find other reports which contained concurring statements, but they may also have been compiled on data also obtained from "The Jayne Family Of Long Island".

Unfortunately, one of the most complete compilations and probably one of the most accurate was that prepared by Mr. Beniah Gustin Jayne of New York City, who died in Lone Tree, Iowa before he published his findings. Upon his death, disinterested heirs disposed of his wealth of information and it has been lost or destroyed.

Likewise, another Jaynes genealogy was compiled by an attorney, Ebenezzar H. Jayne, who is also deceased. If his work has survived, I have not found it, and I have had no response from his daughter, Kathryn.

One of my greatest frustrations was when I compared my data drawn from "The Jayne Family Of Long Island" with a genealogical work done by Ebenezzar C. Jayne, a nephew of Dr. David Jayne. The conflict of information as to dates of birth and death, and the names of the wives of the early Jayne marriages is appalling.

As I do not know which is erroneous, I present my work following with the recommendation that any interested researcher of the Jayne clan should also review the history written by Ebenezzar C. Jayne which I found in The Historical Society Of Pennsylvania library in Philadelphia.

The only line that I have actually researched myself is my own ancestry tracing to Micaiah and Mary Jane Jayne. While my research is far from complete, I am making it available now. I have noted that Beniah G. and Ebenezzar H. Jayne both died before their work was completed to their satisfaction, and their files have been lost, and therefore, done in vain. Furthermore, I may be made aware of my errors, or additional information may come my way.

THE JAYNES FAMILY HISTORY

Guido de Jeanne was a French general in the service of the French Confederation. In 1154 he was assigned to escort Henry the second to England and to secure Henry on the throne. For this service Guido de Jeanne was knighted by Henry and given the manor of Kirkling in Cambridgeshire.

Guido's grandson, Geoffry de Jeanne, took up arms about 1200 or 1204 with Baldwin, count of Flanders, in a successful effort to obtain Jerusalem and contributed to install Baldwin king of Jerusalem. Geoffry later made three pilgrimages to the Holy Land with his son Guy, or Guido. Hence the escallop shells in the coat of arms which commemorate those events. Before his death Geoffry acquired the lands of Botalock in Cornwall through his wife the heiress of Sir Richard Penruddock.

A descendant was Henry de Jeanne, a graduate of Oxford University and a lecturer there on Theology and Divinity.

A son of Henry de Jeanne, William, was born at Bristol, England on January 25, 1618. William was expelled from Oxford University in 1640 as a dissenter. He became a Presbyterian preacher and a follower of Cromwell. In 1660, when Charles the second was restored to the throne, the persecution of the followers of Cromwell became very severe. William de Jeanne fled to Monmouthshire on the border of Wales and changed his name to Jayne to escape ecclesiastical persecution. Between 1670 and 1675 and a widower, William Jayne left three grown sons in England and migrated to America. He first settled at New Haven, Connecticut where he married Anna Biggs on June 10, 1675. By 1678 he had moved to Brookhaven, Long Island where he served as pastor of the Puritan church. He and Anna had five sons and two daughters. Anna died and in 1694 William married Nehitable Jenkins, a widow. This marriage produced one more son, Stephen Jayne. By 1708 William had moved to Setauket, Long Island where he died on March 24, 1714 and was buried there in the Presbyterian cemetery.

In three marriages William had fathered nine sons and two daughters.
