PREFACE

In compiling this genealogy of the descendants of Hugh Jones, I have made the utmost use of every source of information available.

This genealogy will be found accurate and trustworthy. At the same time, it is inevitable that some errors will creep in, especially so with regard to dates and spelling of names. In some instances members of the same family reporting a record differ as to dates, in other instances descendants have failed to respond to our requests for data.

The preparation of this volume has involved correspondence with a great many people and has taken several years; my reward lies in the hope and belief that I have performed a real service to the family.

THE EARLY JONESES

This family is descended from an ancient Welch line.

The modernizing of the surname John, which anciently was pronounced with the "o" long as in Jone, into Jones, is a transition quite familiar to genealogists. Thus, ap. John, ap. Johns, ap. Jones, Jones.

Welsh John, succeeding Welch John, and being called John's son, until in the course of time the name narrowed down into that of Jones and the first of the family who emigrated to America was Captain Christopher Jones, commander of the "Mayflower" (1620)—a trading man in the colony of the Pilgrim fathers and a "convinced friend" and subsequently, when the Pilgrims and Puritan colonies were in a prosperous condition, families by the name of Jones settled in America.

The surname Jones ranks first in number among the family names of Wales; one Welch man in seven bearing the name. In England it holds second place.

Being of patronymic derivation, it came into use as a family surname during the fifteenth century. Over fifty colonists bearing the name, progenitors of families, settled in New England before 1700; most of whom came from England, of Wales descent, settling in Massachusetts. They were very serious-minded and religious people, with whom life was a strenuous business.

When Hugh Jones settled in Salem, Massachusetts in 1650, that place was on the frontier, exposed to Indian raids and forays, and was not safe for a great many years. Over two

hundred years our family was, in a measure, on the frontier, and doing the work of frontiersmen and pioneers.

It is from Abraham Jones that the name Abraham, afterwards so celebrated, first came into the Lincoln family. Sarah, daughter of Abraham and Sarah (Whitman) Jones of Dorchester, Massachusetts, married Mordecai Lincoln of Hull.

Capt. Lewis Jones settled in Watertown, Massachusetts, 1640, of whom Calvin Coolidge is a descendant, probably is of this same Jones family.

FIRST GENERATION

1. **Hugh Jones**, Immigrant of Salem, Massachusetts, being one of the earliest pioneers. Was born in Wincanton, England, 1635; emigrated to Salem, Massachusetts in 1650, where he died about 1688.

He married first, Hannah, daughter of John and Margaret Tompkins of Salem, Massachusetts, June 26, 1660. She was born February 21, 1640-1 and died May 10, 1672.

He married second, December 31, 1672, Mary, Baptized March 29, 1649, daughter of John and Martha (Tompkins) Foster of Salem, a cousin of his first wife. She died in Woburn, Massachusetts, May 29, 1717.

November 18, 1661 he received from the town a homestead grant of about three acres of land which he sold April 22, 1673 to William Robinson of Salem.

On April 13, 1674, he bought of Thomas Gardner, five acres of land in the "North Neck".

Hugh Jones was a farmer and reared a large family on his small estate. His descendants for five generations lived mostly in Middlesex and Worcester Counties, Massachusetts, and Hillsborough County, New Hampshire. They were a vigorous, hardy, long-lived race of farmers and blacksmiths. They reared large families; were continually pioneers to new settlements on the advancing frontiers, and most of them were at some period, engaged in the military service.

Mary, the widow of Hugh Jones, removed after 1688, with most of her children, to the northern part of Woburn. They had fifteen children.

SECOND GENERATION

2. **John 2 Jones** (Hugh 1) of Salem, Massachusetts was born August 4, 1667. Eldest son of Hugh Jones. Lived there until 1705 and then removed to Framingham. He served in Sir William Phillips unsuccessful expedition against Quebec in 1690. His name appears on a copy of a list of Petitioners, in 1737, for a grant of land for his service. He married, January 7, 1696, Mary Knowlton of Reading, who was admitted to the Framingham Church May 17, 1717.

His will, dated October 18, 1733, probated December 24, 1753, names his wife, Abigail; daughter Abigail; sons Samuel, Ebenezer, Jonathan and son Joshua, who received the homestead and was residuary legatee and executor. They had five children.

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4. **Hugh 2 Jones** (Hugh 1) of Salem, Massachusetts. Third and youngest son of Hugh 1. Born in 1683 in Salem, Mass. Went to Woburn with his mother, 1694, and resided in that part of the town, set off in 1730 as Wilmington, for forty years. He married Hannah, born December 24, 1688, daughter of Samuel and Elizabeth (Pierce) Wilson of Woburn. They had eight children.

There he became a prominent man, served as selectman in 1747, and in 1748 was commissioned Captain of one of the local military companies. He died April 3, 1769. He married, May 23, 1722, Susanna, born January 14, 1700, daughter of Capt. Edward and Sarah (Walker) Johnson of Woburn. She died September 17, 1795. They had ten children.

7. **Capt. Ebenezer 3 Jones** (Samuel 2 Hugh 1) of Woburn, Massachusetts. He was born in Woburn, June 18, 1699. Lived in his native town, also in Wilmington, acquiring extensive estate in both places and at one time maintaining a tavern in Wilmington. He was an enterprising and prominent man, but gained his chief distinction in the military service. He served as Lieut. in Captain Joseph Richardson's company in the spring of 1775 and as Captain from September 9, 1755-58. On the first expedition against Crown Point on March 13, 1758, he was appointed captain of a company on another expedition against Crown Point, and while scouting near Fort Edward, on July 20, 1758, his company was ambushed by the Indians at Half-way brook, and he and many of his men were killed. He married first, November 18, 1719, Elizabeth Dale of Woburn, born December 10, 1693. Married second, July 13, 1746, Phebe, born 1702, died 1764, Endecott of Boxford, great grand daughter of Governor John Endecott.

He died there May 24, 1753. He was a farmer and a man of enterprise, acquiring extensive landed property in Wilmington and in Monroe, New Hampshire, and attaining the rank of Lieut. of the local military company. His will, made the day before his death, mentions his wife, Elizabeth; sons, Jonathan and William, who had received their portion; sons Joshua and David to whom was left real estate in Wilmington; sons Caleb and Josiah, who received lands in Monroe, New Hampshire; son Samuel, who was to have a trade and £13.68 when of age, and daughters, Martha, Elizabeth and Mary Jones. He married in Woburn, August 7, 1721, Elizabeth, born June 21, 1690, daughter of John and Elizabeth (Palmer) Russell (a descendant of Edward Russell, the emigrant) of Woburn. They had sixteen children.

Isaac Osgood, in a Crown Point expedition in the Revolution, he served as Lieut. in Capt.

Joseph B. Varnum's Company, Col. Jonathan Reed's Regiment, from September 29, to October 29, 1777, sent to reinforce General Gates army at Saratoga, and was present at Burgoyne's surrender.

He married first, November 10, 1738, Hannah, born January 7, 1714, died after 1770, daughter of Dea. Nathaniel and Hannah (Merriam) Fox of Concord and Dracut. "The Oregon, under the command of Captain Charles E. Clark, was on the coast of California. She was needed at Santiago, Cuba. She left San Francisco on March 19, 1898, steamed the 13,000 miles without a mishap or strain, swung into line

with the other battleships at Santiago Bay, reported ready for action and participated in the naval engagement of July 3, in which the entire Spanish fleet was sunk. That was the finest sailing record ever made by a battleship. The bravery on the part of Captain Clark placed him in the front rank of the nation's heroes.

A bronze statue rests in Memorial Park in Bradford, Vermont to the memory of her native son, the late Captain Charles Edgar Clark of the Oregon during the Spanish American War and later elevated to the office of Rear Admiral.

THE RUSSELL LINE

The Ancestry of this family has been traced to remote antiquity and includes many ancient Royal lineage.

- (I) Sigurd Hring Turstain was King of Sweden A. D. 735.
- (II) Ermengarde, daughter of Sigurd, married Throud, King of Throndeim, Norway 750.
- (III) Eisdan, their son, was King of Throndeim in 780.
- (IV) Halfdau, son of Eisdan, was King of Throndeim, 810.
- (V) Eisdan Glunru, son of Halfdan, was King of Throndeim, 840.
- (VI) Hilda, daughter of Eisdan Glunru, was Countess of Uplands, and married in 850, Iver, Earl of Upland.
- (VII) Eisdan Glunru, their son, was prince of Uplands, 870. A warrior and Viking.
- (VIII) Royvald, his son, was the first recorded Earl of Moers, The first record of him is dated 885. One of his sons was Earl of Orkney's and discovered the use of peat for fuel; another son afterwards became Duke Robert of Normandy.
- (IX) Hrellegur or Droge, son of Rogvald, succeeded his father as Earl of Moers in 896.
- (X) Rollo Turstain, son of Hrellegur or Droge, was Earl of Moers in Norway, succeeding his father in 920.
- (XI) Auslech Turstain, son of Rollo Turstain, was made first Baron of Bricquebec in 943.

- (XII) Turstain Fastenburgh, son of Auslech Turstain became Baron of Bricquebec about 980.
- (XIII) William Bertrand, son of Turstain Fastenburgh, was with his son Hugh, at the Battle of Hastings, 1066. He was a cousin of Matilda, Countess of Flanders, and also William the Conqueror. He became Baron of Bricquebec in 1028, and was the first to use the family Crest, (a lion Rampant Crowned.)
- (XIV) Hugh, Lord of Barreville and la Rozel, son of William Bertrand, took the name la Rozel from the castle he inherited in England. He was born about 1021 in Bricquebec, Normandy, and accompanied his chief, the Conqueror, to England, taking part in the battle of Hastings, and being allotted large properties in Nottinghamshire and Derbyshire.
- (XV) Richard DeRozel, son of Hugh, was also lord of la-Rozel. He took part in the first Crusade, and inherited a great estate from his father.
- (XVI) Hugh DeRozel, son of Richard DeRozel, was born in 1119, died in 1163. He owned a large estate, the greater part of which he gave away to charity. He served in the first Crusade. His wife was a very wealthy woman.
- (XVII) Robert DeRussell, son of Hugh DeRozel, was born about 1130. He spelled the name Rozel as well as Russell. He was in the command of the Earl of Chester at the Battle of Lincoln. He died about 1201.
- (XVIII) Odo Russell, son of Robert DeRussell, lived on the family estate in Berwick, England.

- (XIX) John Russell, son of Odo Russell. Married 1213, Rose Bardolf, and was one of the Barons present at the signing of Magna Charta by King John.
- (XX) Sir Ralph Russell, son of John Russell. Married about 1250, Isabel de New March. He was sheriff of Wiltshire. He attended King Henry in 1242 in the war with France.
- (XXI) Sir William Russell, son of Sir Ralph Russell, was born in 1257, died in 1311. He married Eleanor de Aulet.
- (XXII) Sir Theobald Russell, son of Sir William Russell, was born in 1304. He was killed in the attack on Helen's Point at the age of thirty-six years. He married Eleanor LaTour.
- (XXIII) Sir William Russell, son of Sir Theobald Russell, was a member of Parliament in 1338 and 1348. He married Lady Muschamp.
- (XXIV) Sir Henry Russell, son of Sir William Russell, was a member of Parliament from 1425 to 1449.
- (XXV) Sir John Russell, son of Sir Henry Russell. Married Elizabeth Barringham. He was speaker of the House of Commons in the second year of Henry VI; and was again in Parliament in the tenth year of that reign, and in 1450.
- (XXVI) John Russell, Esq., son of Sir John Russell, was keeper of the artillery in Chisbrook Castle. He married Elizabeth Foxmors.
- (XXVII) James Russell, Esq., son of John Russell, Esq., was a member of Parliament in the reign of Henry VIII. He married Alicia Wyse.

- (XXVIII) John Russell, Esq., son of James Russell, Esq., was afterward the first Earl of Bedford, and his history is familiar to all students of English History. He died March 14, 1555.
- (XXIX) Lord Francis Russell, son of John Russell, Esq., was second Earl of Bedford. He married Margaret, widow of John Cotick, and died July 28, 1585.
- (XXX) Sir Francis Russell, son of Lord Francis Russell. Married Elizabeth Wyndham, and died at Highgate in 1584.
- (XXXI) Edward Russell, son of Sir Francis Russell, was third Earl of Bedford. Born March, 1575, died May 3, 1627. He married Lucy Harrington December, 1594.
- (I) John Russell, younger son of Edward Russell, and the immigrant, was born in England in 1597. He married first in 1630, and came to Boston Massachusetts in 1635. Was a town officer and clerk of the writs. Was one of the first settlers of Woburn. He was a deacon of the Church. His first wife was Elizabeth, she died December 16, 1644. He married second, Elizabeth Baker, who died January 17, 1689-90.
