### Introduction

This book has been prepared by the following:-

R. Milton Jeinnings, a descendant of Solomon Jinnings.

Mrs. Miles C. Green met with Mr. Foster Handelong who was an historian of the Jennings reunion. Before him, Mr. George Handelong was historian.

The Family records and other papers these former historians had, were lost in some way, so we started anew.

The families who have helped from memories and in their own days were:- Mrs. Joann Strunk, Mr. Charles Lohman, Mrs. Ellen Jennings, Mrs. Elba Kressler, Mr. George Handelong, the Schulster sisters, Mr. Roy Struble, Mr. Whritnour and others.

To every one who helped, we wish to give our thanks.

Note:- We, R. Milton Jeinnings and Mrs. Miles C. Green would like to state that there seems to be no connection in line with this family history.

A family tree, we can say, is like that of a ordinary maple. In the spring it spreads its branches and bursts out into rich green leaves, yet come autumn, these leaves fall from the tree and go their separate ways, just as all families do in a matter of time.

Mr. Franklin Delano Roosevelt gave this line to the Works Progress Adminstration survey thus:-

"To bring together the records of the past and to house them in buildings where they will be preserved for the use of men living in the future, a nation must believe in three things.

It must believe in the past

It must believe in the future

It must, above all, believe in the capacity of its people so to learn from the past that they can gain in judgement for the creation of the future."

### History of Jennings Family

I,(Mrs. Green) have tried to make a brief account of the family tree as I have acknowledged it from year to year. In 1949, I was working on my family history, heard about the Jennings reunion being held annually in Bangor, Pa. as my father's cousins had married in the family of Jennings. I thought maybe the reunion had a history, to learn more of my folks. So I became acquainted with Mrs. Joann Derrick Strunk, whose mother was a Jennings, she told me much about her people and she loved the reunions until she passed away in 1953. She related so much about the Jennings people, where they lived around Upper Mount Bethel township and other places, so I took the notes down. She spoke of her uncle Samuel and his wife Kate who would come and complain about their mother living on the old home-stead. Samuel Jr had three children, one of them who married Mr. Smith of Mt. Bethel, Pa. went west to Kansas, then later their father came out west also. He dealt in farm machinery there till his passing. Joann

loaned me many pictures to show at the reunions. I was elected as an assistant historian to Folter Handelong then learned R. Milton Jeinnings was also helping on the history.

The first year I had of the history begun with John Jennings who was born in 1801, he was the foundation of this family tree that I collected upwards to present time.

The following year I brought working records along to the reunion to show around. Based on this progress put more cooperation from the descendants. After the reunion was over, Mr. Edward Anthony came forward telling that he would show how they used to keep the family records. Here it took me by surprise that it had the family register of Samuel Jennings born in 1776 all time showed John born 1801 in it put me in much progress of getting more information farther back.

Milton Jeinnings would come to my house and we would go out together to talk with people of the Jennings family, we went up to North Bangor, Pa. with Mrs. Elba Kressler to Mrs. Ellen Jennings, mother's farm. This was the homestead of John Jennings (born 1801) which he bought after he married. He came to this region from Butler, N.J. where he could raise the children away from Catholic faith as he did not seem to care for this religion.

There was some mineral in the mountains, but not worth mining, so they found clay and made bricks, pottery, raised bees for honey and beeswax which was used for candles. Then the Civil War broke out in this country and they answered the call. "Honey Bill" William Jennings talked with Abraham Lincoln and sat on his chair. He also saved the life of General Grant by cutting the stirrup to loosen him from the saddle when his horse was shot.

Then at another reunion time, someone spoke up about a descendant living in Clarks Summit, Pa. so Milton and I went up there, we found an elderly lady Mrs. Rhinehart who was kind enough to give us information about John Jennings, the son of James, who was a sign painter for the wagons, etc.

During the fair at Allentown, Pa., my husband and I went to call on Mr. Lohman whose mother was a Jennings and he related about Samuel Jennings Sr who took his second wife Hannah Miller when John of 1801 was 12 years old. Hannah was mean to John's sister Catherine. So one day John threw a swivel tree at her, then ran away from home to Kingston, N.Y. and someone took him in whether a relative or not we do not know. He learned the blacksmith trade when a young man. Then he came back to Butler, N.J. where he courted and married Mary Struble. Later he came back to North Bangor, Pa. at the foot of the mountain where he bought 400 acres of land. Mr. Lohman has a relic of John (1801)'s horn-beck, it is like an anvil used for making chain links. Mr. Lohman also has a beautiful gun made by the gunsmith near Belfast, Pa.

Many of the descendants during the 1850's have been pulling together to put a claim to the inheritance of the wealthy Jennings of England whose estate was escheated to the Crown. They did not think of keeping the family records intact these days, all that they were after was the estate that turned out to be much of a disappointment to them.

On one Sunday, Paul and Elba Kressler, daughter Sonya, my husband and I went to Butler, N.J. to get information and found a descendant of Catherine, daughter of Samuel (b 1776). Next we called on the Sahulster sisters, they showed us a birth record that a school teacher made for Joseph Sahulster that it was done on hand fancy art writing. It looked as if it might have been made by the same person who made the artistic family register record for Samuel (b 1776). Joseph and Elenor might have been brother and sister.

Roy Struble took us to a Sahulster home and there we were told that Sahulster was spelled first without the "a". It was later added to make it more yankee sounding. The blast furnace of Ringwood and Charlotteton called many there to work, and the workers were told to build their own houses that was what Samuel did.

In conclusion, we know that some readers, undoubtedly, will rate this book as lacking on a few points of specific interest. Still others to whom its chapters have proved interesting reading, may wish still more complete information on certain phases of this history.

To all those people we gladly extend an offer of friendly assistance.

The township record shows that publication was taken at a town meeting on the 12th March of 1776.

"We, the subscribers, freeholders and inhabitants of the township of Pequannock, in the county of Morris and province of New Jersey, having long viewed with concern the avowed design of the ministry of Great Britain to raise a revenue in America, being deeply affected with the cruel hostilities already commenced in Massachusetts Bay for carrying that arbitrary design into execution, convinced that the preservation of the rights and privileges of America depends, under God, on the firm union of its inhabitants, do, with hearts abhorring slavery, and ardently wishing for a reconciliation with our Parent state on constitutional principles, solemnly associate and resolve under the sacred ties of virtue, honor, and love of our country, that we will personally, and so far as our influence extends, endeavor to support and carry into execution whatever measures may recommended by the Continental and Provincial Congress for defending our constitution and preserving the same inviolate, according to the resolutions of the aforesaid Continental and Provincial Congress, firmly determined by all means in our Power to guard against the disorders and confusions to which the peculiar circumstances of the times may expose us.

We do also further associate and agree as far as shall be consistent with the measures adopted for the preservation of American freedom, to support the magistrates and other civil officers in the execution of their duty agreeable to the laws of the colony, and to observe the directions of our committes acting."

The terms of the above agreement were with the one hundred seventy seven subscribers signed. One of them was JAMES JENNINGS.

Reference:-History of Morris County, N.J. by E.D. Halsey, published in 1882, page 275.

I am incline to believe that any descendants shown in this book, who desires to join the Daughters or Sons of American Revolution Society would be admitted based on this fact. Military record of James Jennings in New Jersey could not be found. This part should not hamper any one to join the Patriotic Societies.
