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THE KINCAID FAMILY IN MAINE.

Many misty legends and traditions cluster around the name of Patrick Mincaid, the Ancestor of this sturdy family in Maine. But out of these the character of this man looms like some strong lighthouse tower when the fog of a summer's morning has lifted and rolled it away. He was a man of bardy, independent spirit, and the light of his helpfulness and glowing faith shone out to all around him. He helped to make his home neighborhood one from which men were warned away from the dangerous and greedy rocks and shoals of life, and attracted to the deep waters of safe, happy and successful living.

The legends which have been handed down to us in the branches of the findaid Tamily and these: "Ancestor Patrick Kindaid cane to Abdrica from Edinboro, Scotland. His brother John, being the eldest son, inherited the family property. We do not know to low much this amounted, but we suppose that he had a good time with it, for we have never heard anything more about Eim." "Ancester Patrick Kindaid became dissatisfied on account of the partiality shown towards his brothers in Scotland. One of whom became a lawyer of some note, and he boldly stepped out to escape from all wranglings. Penniless, as he was, he felt sure that he could win his way in the New Yorld."

Another cays, for great-grandfather, fatrick Kincaid, because his father only gave him a trade, while he gave all of his property to the older sen, and told to Patrick to go to work, came to A erica. He often said that he could never stay in a country where so such difference was made between two sons in a family. Ancestor Fatrick Hincaid is buried beside his wife Mary in the old Faquoit Cemetery, a few miles from Brunswick. His gravestone states that he died Dec 27, 1817, aged 74 years. This shows that the date of his birth was about 1743. His wife was born in Aug or Oct, 28, 1748, and she died Dec 25, 1821. She is said to have been a dau of David Stanwood and Mary Munt, and thus descended from two very strong old Brunswick, Me., families. She was a woman of great activity and sagacity, while her faith and helpfulness were of a sterling quality.

THE RECORDS OF DAVID KINCAID OF THE 2nd GENERATION.

This wife inherited many noble qualities from patriotic and publicspirited ancestors. "Four generations of the Waldron Family in England are given in Vol 8 of the New England Genealogical and Antiquarian Register, page 78. On pages 55 and 56 of Vol 9, the family of Major Richard Waldron is given. On page 86 is t the statement, "Later generations of the Waldron Family are recorded in the Family History owned by N. Sheafe Waldron, Esqr., Major of the U.S. Marine Corps, he being a great-grandson of Major Michard Waldron." A tradition makes Abigail Waldron a descendant of this Major Richard Waldron, but she may have been descended from his brother William. The brothers and sisters of this Abigail Waldron were all born at Barrington, N.H.
