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FOREWORD

The following data on the Kendalls of Connecticut has been collected from time to time, never with the intent of making a serious study of the family, but as more data was accumulated interest in the family has grown. With an exchange of data with Mrs. Ann Wiley of Rockford, Illinois the question arose as to which David Kendall, the husband of Jane Adams or the husband of Abigail Holt, was the son of Isaac Kendall, Senior, of Ashford, Connecticut. At first it seemed quite obvious that the David who married Jane Adams was the son of Isaac Kendall, but on examination, it seemed that the other David Kendall could very easily have been mistaken for the son of Isaac. The following data was then reviewed very carefully and put in order; and it is hoped that the results will be of some aid to those with Kendall lines in Connecticut. It should be stressed that all of the problems have not been solved; especially as to which Daniel Kendall had a wife; the ancestry of John Kendall of East Hartford; and the ancestry of David Kendall of Windham, etc. It should also be mentioned that the Ashford Land Records have not been completely and thoroughly searched. This fact is not due to an oversight.

Volume 39, pages 17-23 of the New England Register contain data of the original Kendalls in Woburn, Massachusetts, but the article merely mentions the branches which removed to Connecticut. Three publications have been printed previously containing data on the Kendalls of Connecticut. In 1908 the Old Northwest Genealogical Quarterly, volume XI, pages 124-127 contained an article by O. F. Monette called "Five Isaac Kendalls". Outside of the direct line of these five Isaac Kendalls there are some serious errors. In 1919 there was published by William M. Clemens the "Kendall Family in America", a booklet of 24 pages which discusses the

Connecticut families, quoting a few births and marriage records without attempting to assign them to any respective family. The latest printed data has appeared in the Woodstock Genealogies, volume 7 page 176 (1943). This data carries only the few lines of descent which deal in particular with residence or connection with Woodstock, Connecticut. In order to be complete, it has been necessary to include much of the data which appears therein, on the first four pages 176-179.

Mention should be made here of the "Descendants of William Kendall of Ashford" by Kenneth Laughlin published in May of 1953 (20 pages), which is concerned with the descendants of William Kendall #50 of this publication; and also the manuscript genealogy of the Kendalls of Massachusetts at the American Antiquarian Society. A second edition of the "Descendants of William Kendall of Ashford" was published in 1955.

I am indebted to and appreciate the interest shown by Mrs. Ann Wiley for her contribution on the family of Phineas Kendall and to Mr. Floyd C. Paine of Pavilion, New York for sending in data which has been used...such data being not readily obtainable.

Abijah Kendall was in the French and Indian War, campaigns of 1757 and 1760, perhaps died soon after.

Rufus Kendall transferred to Ellington in 1822. Buried South Cemetery at Ashford. Thompson Church records say that Isaac Kendall m July 3, 1760 Mary Brissat, which probably should be Mary Russel. The two names when written could very easily have been mistaken for each other, when e's looked like a's in the old writing. The parentage of Mary Russell has not been determined as there were three Mary Russell's born about this time in Killingly (Thompson Parish)

On first examination, it would seem that this David Kendall could be easily confused with the David Kendall #9, page 5, the son of Isaac Kendall; but after examination of Church and Land Records, it seems to me that this David did not remove to Ashford until just a few years before his death, and always seems to be connected with the Holts. There are just a few significant facts which help to separate him from the other David Kendalls in Ashford, but even at that, the dates of both families run so parallel, that it seems more than just coincidence. None of the Davids, except that of Brooklyn, left a will; but one Land Record was made in Ashford in connection with this David Kendall which is rather explanatory and is now presented with the other facts:
