GENEALOGY

OF THE

LONGFELLOW FAMILY.

William Longfellow was born in 1651 in Hampshire, England, and came to Newbury in early manhood. He married Anne Sewall, November 10, 1676, daughter of Henry and Jane (Dummer) Sewall, and sister of the famous Judge Samuel Sewall. He was drowned at Anticosti or Cape Breton in 1690. He was an officer in a company from Newbury on their return from an expedition against Canada.

Note. Other sisters of the Chief Justice married a follows: Mehetabel, William Moody; Jane, Moses Gerrish; Hannah, Jacob Tappan; Dorothy, Ezekiel Northend.
