#### LONGANECKER FALLY HISTORY

Generation

I

"Ulrich Longanecker was born in Switzerland in 1664. When he was 69 years of age; in the year of 1773, he immigrated to America in company with his wife and two sons--Ulrich Jr. 22 years of age and Jacob, 19 years old. He located upon a tract of land of 229 acres lying upon the west side of the Schuylhill River (now in North Coventry Township, Chester County Pa.) and was bought of William Penn. It is traditionary among his descendents that he was a book printer in Zurich, Switzerland. Three other sons preceded him in coming to the new world. David immigrated about 1722. One says it was as early as 1719, but whatever the date, it is quite probable that he sailed in the same vessel in which his Uncle Daniel Longanecker and family came. John came in 1727 and Christian in 1729.

Ulrich, in about 1746, after selling nis lands upon the Schuylkill, went to Lancaster county Pennsylvania with his son Ulrich Junior. He acquired no more lands. It is not known when ne died nor where he is buried. Of his five sons, four--David, John, Christian, and Ulrich Jr.. --died possessed largely of real estate. Jacob, his youngest son, settled near what is now known as Parker-Ford.

Ulrich and Daniel Longanecker, brothers, are the colonial ancestors of the Longanecker family in America. Their descendents are numerous in : Eastern Pennsylvania, in the counties of Montgomery, Chester, and Lancaster. It is probable that some of the Longaneckers were in and around London eight to ten years before sailing for the American colonies.

They were Huguenots, and in Europe as well as here, were Quakers (German Quakers) and affiliated and worshipped with the English Quakers. Their ancestors fled from the Spanish Inquisition and after the massacre of St. Eartholmew, escaped to Switzerland and settled in and near Zurich. They were educated and in literary attainments are to be regarded as progressive, as were those educators who settled in providences along the Rhine, and who were at least 100 years in advance of the other European districts.

Daniel was a Mennonite minister, and Christian, a son of Ulrich, also. And at the time he immigrated, and both upon their arrival in the New World continued active in their ministerial duties. They were persecuted at home and to obtain religious and civil liberty they went abroad. They were co-workers in a common cause, and much that they did was accomplished by associated effort. The biography of Daniel presents an interesting and active life amongst the earlier Colonial settlers in Eastern Pennsylvania. His mission as a minister amongst the Mennonites gave him charge of the Manatawny district. At what time his charge began is not known, but it is known that he and Jacob Bechtle were representatives of the convention of the Quakers held at Germantown in September of 1727. The time of his death is now known exactly, but it is probable that it occurred in 1756. The Longaneckers were mostly tillers of the soil.

Ulrich and Daniel named their oldest sons David. It is not improbable that he who shall search their European pedigree will discover that David was the paternal ancestor. This narrative is all that is known of Ulrich since landing in America.

A grandson of Ulrich in about 1780 changed the name to Longaker and the descendents of Daniel their names to Longacre. The descendents of Ulrica in Lancaster county and their descendents elsewhere generally retained the name of Longanecker. One branch, however, adopted the name Longnecker and under these names their descendents are residing in many of the States and Territories of the United States."

IV. Jacob Longenecker, the son of Jacob and Elisabeth Brenner Longenecker, was born Aug. 13, 1814 and died Jan. 1, 1890. He was married to Lydia Snowalter in 1837 in Lancaster Co. Pa. She was born Aug. 13, 1819, and died April 14, 1916, age, 96 years, 8 mo. 1 day. (At the time of her death she was survived by 8 children, 45 grandchildren, 88 great-grand children, and 6 great-great-grand children.) . They were the parents of 13 children. About the time of Jacob and Lydia's marriage, her parents, (Showalters), sold their in Lancaster Co. Pa., and decided to move to Onio. They made the trip overland in covered wagons.

The parents and ten children and two young men (it is thought their names were Sam Showalter and Christ Witmer) rode in the wagon. Jacob and Lydia, the newly wed's rode in ner fathers cerriage as he decided to take it along to the west. They had bedding with

them and at night they would put up at notels and spread the bedding on the floors and sleep there. It was in the month of April that they make the trip,: it took them three weeks.

Jacob was a carpenter by trade. He had made arrangements with a man by the name of Hearst of Bachman township, Stark County Ohio previously to erect some buildings for him. So when they arrived they moved into a small house of Hearst's. The Showalters stayed with them until they had a place to go. A short time later the Showalters bought an 80 acre farm close to Kt. Eaton and moved there. During the summer Jacob bought an 8 acre lot close by and moved there. In 1847 they moved over to the Sugar Creek. In 1856 they moved north of Orville, Ohio on a farm which they rented from Judge Orr. The next year Jacob bought 110 acres east of Wooster, Ohio. They resided there until June of 1872 when they moved about 8 miles north of Lorrison, Illinois where he had purchased an 80 acre farm from Robert Wallace. The price paid was \$4550. This included the lend, crops, and equipment. It is not known for sure if it included entire equipment, but it is generally thought that it did. He resided here for the rest of nis life. After his death, Lydia kept several rooms in the nouse where she lived for a number of years. The latter years of her life was spent with her children. She died at the home of her daughter Fianna.

Jacob and his wife were of the Dunkard faith. They are buried in the Hennonite Cemetery near Morrison, Illinois. Their childrenwere:- Elisabeth, Flanna, Matelena, Hariah, Leah, Samuel, Nancy, Lydia, Jacob, Julia Ann, Rebecca, Joseph, and Henry.

#### THE INDIAN PERNY

"The face on the cent is not that of an Indian, but of a little Philadelphia girl.

Mrs. Sarah Longacre Keen, who lived and died in Philadelphia, came nearer being the queen of the American Mint than any other woman who ever lived. With the exception of Queen Victoria, whose image was engraved on every coin in the British and Indian Empire, Mrs. Keen was first in the number of metal photographs. Her face as a girl of twelve summars is to be seen on every American cent issued since 1836 up to the coining of the Lincoln cent from Uncle Sam's coin factory.

It is usually assumed that the face on the head side of the copper is that of an Indian, but a close look will reveal that of a Saxon profile. Just borrow a cent and look at it. The setting is that of an Indian.

Between 1828 and 1840, James Barton Longacre was the chief engraver in the United States Mint at Philadelphia. In 1835 a competition was opened for sketches and engravings for the new copper cent that was to be issued and which has since been in service. There were a thousand designs offered. The prize was one thousand dollars. Longacre ricked his brains for some original and singular design that would strike the judges, but for months he field to satisfy himself, says the petroit News--Tribune.

One morning a number of Indians with their chief, who had been to pay their respects to the great white chief in Washington, came to the City and were shown through the Mint. They were introduced to the white chief's picture maker, who was just then showing his young daughter, Sarah, the great concern. The old chief was attracted by the sweet faced maiden and her interest in his for thers and paint. She childishly wondered hew she would look in the feathered headgear. This was told the chief, who solemnly divested himself of his feathers and had them placed on the girl's head. The effect was so striking that the father took time to make a sketch of the picture, finishing it afterward for his cwn amusement.

At the last moment of the period given for sending in the engravings, he bethought himself of the possibility of the combination of Indian feathers and Saxon sweetness. He got it in and much sport was made of the child at the time in the city because of the incident. The sketch passed through the seventh sifting and finally reached the last round. By one vote it won, and ever since Sarah Longacre's young face has served for the humblest of coins, than which ne other coin in the world has such tremendous circulation."
