#### -THREE REQUESTS-

A few years ago I attempted to learn what I could about hereditary characteristics in the Low family and discovered that there was no modern record as to those constituting the Low family. I have therefore compiled this record of the descendants of Seth Low and Mary Porter. Its value obviously lies in its completeness and accuracy, and I would appreciate it greatly if I may be notified of any errors or omissions, and I earnestly request that as further changes take place the information be sent to me (giving always <u>full names</u>, <u>places</u> and <u>dates</u> of births, deaths and marriages, and the full names of "<u>in-laws</u>"). From time to time I will endeavor to distribute supplementary sheets which can be inserted in the book so that it can be kept up to date.

This is merely a bare genealogical reference work. It could be made, however, a matter of very deep interest if the names were translated into living characters. At some future time I should like to be able to publish brief pen pictures about the persons herein recorded and I would be exceedingly grateful if members of the family would be willing to prepare such sketches sending a copy to me. They should concern the living as well as those who have died.

In this connection it would be of interest to "locate" the portraits, miniatures, daguerrectypes, etc. of members of the family, and I would like to suggest that information be sent to me stating the name of the owner and the location of pictures of members of the family (or their husbands or wives) and, if possible, the artists' names.

The numbering system used in this record lends itself readily to the insertion of additional data and also permits relationships to be seen at a glance. For example: 332 is the second child of the third child of the third child of Seth Low. 331 is the eldest sister of 332. 325, for instance, is a first cousin. 32 is an uncle and an elder brother of 33, parent of 332. 3, of course is the grand-parent of 332 and is the third child of Seth Low.

- 203. Jane Lawrence was born in England as was her daughter (101). She was a sister of John and William Lawrence who moved to Long Island and founded the Lawrence family there. She married John Tuttle.
- 142/122. Rev. William Thompson was a native of Lancashire, and matriculated at Brazenose College, Oxford, Jan. 28, 1620; but no degree is found. He came to America in 1637 and went first to Kittery and afterwards to Braintree where he was ordained Nov. 19, 1639. While absent on a mission to Virginia with Rev. John Knowles and Thomas James, begun in Oct. 1643, his wife died. He became melancholy and gave up the ministry in 1646.

124. Thomas Gardner and his son (62) were both born in England.

They and their wives are buried in Roxbury.

100. George Giddings came to America from St. Albans, Hertford-shire, in 1635 in the "Planter." Commoner of Ipswich, 1641; Selectman, 1661-1675; Member of General Court of Massachusetts from Ipswich, 1641, 1655, 1659, 1661, 1663, 1664, 1668, 1672, and 1675. Ruling elder of the first church at Ipswich for many years.

70/60. Joseph Wise probably came to America with George Alcock of Roxbury on his third voyage. Mentioned in Alcock's will of Dec. 22, 1640.

69. Dorothy Harbottle married a second time on Feb. 2, 1652, Thomas Hawley.

- 68. Thomas Lamb came to America in fleet with Winthrop bringing his first wife, Elizabeth and his two eldest children, Thomas and John. He was admitted a freeman of Roxbury, May 18, 1631.
- 66. Thomas Boreman was a commoner of Ipswich in 1641.
- 64. Thomas Low lived in that part of Ipswich, Mass. called Chebacco Parish.
- 50. John Giddings, commoner of Ipswich, 1667; Lieutenant of Militia, 1678; Tythingman, 1679.
- 48. William Haskell was born in England, one of three brothers, Roger, William and Mark. He settled in Beverly where Roger had a grant of land in 1636. About 1643 he moved to Gloucester and was representative to the General Court from there in 1672, 1681, 1682 and 1685. He became lieutenant of militia, March 18, 1680, and later captain of the same company. He was deacon of First Church at Gloucester. By occupation he was a mariner.
- 40. John Chote was known as "Sergeant John Chote." The first mention of him is in Ipswich in 1648. He spelled his name "Chote."
- 35. Mary Wise was the fourth of ten children, and a sister of Rev. John Wise (No. 30).
- 34. Caleb Lamb was a mariner.
- Thomas Low was a deacon of the Chebacco Church. Selectman, 1677, 1685, 1698 1701. Parish clerk, 1690 1696. He, and a few others, with their pastor, Rev. John Wise (No. 30) testified in writing that they could see nothing wrong in a person accused of witchcraft. One of his sons, Jonathan, received a grant of land from the state, it is said, "on account of his father's services against the Indians."

30. Rev. John Wise is said to have been the first man in America, so far as is known, to oppose the idea of taxation without representation. He became deeply involved in Sir Edmund Andros' levy of a tax on all towns in the Colony, and together with Col. Appleton was fined and imprisoned for words spoken in denunciation of tyranny. On Dec. 24, 1689 in accordance with a vote of the General Court, he drew up a narrative of the incident of his imprisonment which was sent to England to substantiate the charge against Andros. After the overthrow of the usurpation he was one of the two representatives from Ipswich to meet in Boston, May 9, 1689, for the purpose of reorganizing the Legislature.

In accordance with an invitation of the Legislature, extended in July, 1690, he went as chaplain in Phipp's expedition against Quebec. For this service the Legislature, on Jan. 8, 1736, granted his children 300 acres of unappropriated land in the Province.

Upham in his work on Salem Witchcraft speaks of him as "a learned, able and enlightened man" and as "perhaps the only minister in the neighborhood or country who was discerning enough to see the erroneousness of the witchcraft proceedings from the beginning." On July 8, 1703 he was one of the signers of an address to the General Court to remove the infamy and reproach cast on the name and posterity of those who had been accused and condemned of witchcraft.

In 1721 he took a firm stand in the exciting controversy then waged as to inoculation for small-pox, and was one of the few ministers who, against bitter prejudice and opposition and even personal violence, were strong in its advocacy.

He remained pastor of the Chebacco, or Essex, Church until his death, and his funeral sermon was preached by his son-in-law, Rev. John White (No.14). His tomb-stone still stands in the church yard in Essex.

- 26. Richard Hubbard represented Salisbury in the General Court 1694, 1695, and 1706. He moved to Boston in 1697 but returned to Salisbury and died there.
- 24. Mark Haskell lived in Gloucester, Mass.
- 20. Thomas Choate was known as "Governor Choate" from his owner-ship of Choate Island. He was Captain of militia prior to March 12, 1733. Deputy to the General Court in 1723, 1724, and 1725. He married (2) Mary Calef, and (3) Hannah Burnham.
- 16. David Low was a member of the expedition against Canada which sailed from Boston Aug. 9, 1690 under Sir William Phipps. He was a carpenter.
- 14. Rev. John White was a graduate of Harvard in 1698. He was ordained April 21, 1703 and was pastor of the Congregational Church at Gloucester (the First Church) for 58 years. He married (2) Mrs. Abigail Blake, daughter of Rev. Increase Mather, and (3) Mrs. Alice Norwood.
- 12. William Haskell was representative from Gloucester to the General Court in 1736. Selectman of Gloucester and deacon of the Second Church there.

10. Thomas Choate was lieutenant of militia prior to Nov. 17, 1729. Commissioned captain of Chebacco Company in Third Regiment of Essex Militia, Colonel, Daniel Appleton, August 8, 1761. Commissioned captain of Fourth Company of Ipswich, June 16, 1764. He was the second of nine children. His brother, Francis Choate, the sixth child, was the father of William Choate who was the great-grandfather of Rufus Choate.

8. David Low was an ensign in the militia prior to June 4,
1756. After that date he was Captain in 3rd Regiment,
Essex County militia, in the expedition against Crown
Point, 1756. His brother, Lieutenant Stephen Low, went
with the Essex Company to the army under Abercrombie
and was killed in the ill-advised assault upon

Ticonderoga.

7. Hannah White was ninth of eleven children. Her eldest sister, Lucy, married Rev. Joseph Moody of York. Their son, Samuel Moody, was the famous "Master Moody" of Old Dummer Academy.

6. Nathaniel Haskell was deacon of the Second Church in Gloucester for more than fifty years. Selectman in 1751 and

Abigail Choate was the youngest of eight brothers and sisters. Her brother Stephen Choate, married Mary Low

a sister of David Low (No. 4).

4. David Low was chosen on Dec. 20, 1774, Lieutenant of the Chebacco Military Company of Foot and responded to the Lexington Alarm. On May 7, 1776, he became Captain in the 3rd Regiment, Essex County Militia. He served under General Gates after the capture of Burgoyne. He still commanded his company in 1779.

Hannah Haskell married (2) on Dec. 31, 1805, Colonel John Eaton of East Weare, N. H. Her sister, Judith Haskell, married (1) Jonathan Low, brother of David Low (No. 2).

2. David Low settled in Gloucester and later in Haverhill. He enlisted on May 3, 1775 as sergeant in Capt. Dodge's Company of Ipswich, 17th Regiment of Foot, Continental Army. He was at Bunker Hill. Afterwards, in May, 1776, he went with his regiment, brigaded with Hitchcock's and Varnum's Rhode Island regiments, under General Greene, to Brooklyn, where they built the lines into which the Americans retreated after the battle of Long Island in August, 1776.

Later in life he became a master mariner and died at

sea on a voyage from the West Indies.

His youngest son, William Henry Low, brother of SETH LOW, was the first of the family to go to China, sailing from Salem. The next was Abiel Abbot Low (No. 3 of the record) followed by his brothers William Henry Low (No. 6 of the record) and Edward Allen Low (No. 7 of the record).

- 466 Thomas Jordan Lived in Dorsetshire, England.
- 464 John Fitzpen lived in Weymouth, England.
- 122 Henry Skerry lived in Salem, Mass.
- 117 Sarah married (2) George Hull, of Fairfield, Conn.
- David Fitzpen apparently was the first of the family to use the spelling "Phippen." Rev. George Fitzpen, his brother, refers in his will dated July 20, 1650 to the sons of his brother David "Phippen" then living in New England.
  - 68 William Hathorne lived in Birefield, Berks, England.
  - Anstiss Colley came to Salem about 1680 with her children:
    Nicholas, Anstiss, Margaret, Jacob, Thomas and Sarah
    (No. 31). Her daughter Margaret married Walter Palfrey,
    and their child, Margaret Palfrey, married Nathaniel
    Phippen, grandson of Joseph Phippen (No. 58).
  - 62 Richard Manning was baptized in 1622 in Dartmouth, England.
    He died there.
  - Joseph Phippen took a grant of land at Hingham in 1637.

    Later he moved to Boston, then to Falmouth, and then to Salem.
  - Thomas Dorman was admitted freeman at Boston, March 4, 1634.

    Later he went to Rowley, and still later removed to Topsfield, Mass.
  - 34 Major William Hathorne came to America with Gov. Winthrop in the "Arabella" in 1630 and settled at Dorchester. In 1636 he moved to Salem and was admitted freeman in 1644. He was deputy to the General Court from Salem, 1635-1657, and was Speaker of the House of Deputies, 1644, 1645, 1646, 1650, 1657, and 1661. He was delegate to the Congress of the United Colonies of New England in 1644, 1650 - 1654, and 1673. He was Governor's Assistant (one of the Council) 1662 - 1679. On May 6, 1657 he was appointed magistrate for Salem, Lynn, Marblehead and Manchester. In 1646 he was appointed one of the three commissioners to define the treaty between the French in Canada and the Massachusetts Bay Colony. In 1659 he was appointed commissioner from the United Colonies of New England to the Dutch government in Nieu Amsterdam. On October 1, 1645 he had been appointed Captain of the Salem Company, and in 1656, Major. On October 19, 1658 he was granted one-fourth of Block Island, the other three-fourths being granted to Governor John Endicott, Deputy-Governor Richard Bollingham, and Major-General Daniel Dennison. In 1659 he was granted a plantation ten miles square about fifty miles west of Springfield.
  - John Porter was representative to the General Court of the Colony from Hingham in 1644 and from Salem in 1668. At the time of his death he was the largest landholder in Salem, owning property in Salem, Danvers, Wenham, Topsfield and Beverly. He was called "Sergt." John Porter.
  - 28 George Hodges had married (1) on Sept. 16, 1663, Mary Hudson, who died Nov. 20, 1665. They had a daughter Catherine, born August 20, 1664, who married Benjamin Deland.
  - 20 Nathaniel Clark lived in Wells, Maine.

- 17 Anne Hathorne had a brother, John Hathorne, ancester of Nathaniel Hawthorne.
- 16 <u>Joseph Porter</u> was a brother of Israel Porter, grandfather of General Israel Putnam.

14. Gamaliel Hodges lived in Salem, Mass.

- Ruth Hodges had married (1) Israel Gardner, who was baptized Oct. 5, 1707, and died December, 1754 or January, 1755.
- 6 Captain Edward Allen came to America from Berwick-on-Tweed, England, in 1757, and settled in Salem. He married (2) in 1778 Margaret Lockhart of North Carolina.
- 4 Elijah Porter was representative to the General Court of the Colony from Topsfield. He was clerk and treasurer of the town.
- 3 Ruth Allen's sister, Alice Allen, married Captain Josiah Orne.
- Thomas Porter was in Revolutionary service. He was Sergeant in Colonel John Baker's Regiment from Topsfield on Lexington Alarm; Second Gunner, Captain John Symond's Company, raised in Salem for sea-coast defence; Second-Lieutenant in Captain John Dodge's Company at Winter Hill in 1778.

  He took leave of his family October 30, 1792 and sailed November 11, 1792 for Baltimore and was never heard of again.
