EXPLANATION.

Style of type used for a person's number, and the column in which that number is found, both show that person's generation, thus: A Roman number in first column is second generation, a heavy face number in second column is third generation, an ordinary number in third column is fourth generation, and an italic number in fourth column is fifth generation. Numbers showing each person's descent are understood as being in each column before each person's number where such numbers are omitted.

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CHICKIES ROCK, PENNSYLVANIA.

From information believed reliable, it appears that BENJAMIN LONG was born in a stone house owned in 1896 by Hon. Simon B. Cameron and about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles west of Maytown, Lancaster County, Pa., on the road from that place to Bainbridge. Also that he was the twelfth of sixteen children of Harmon Long, late of that place. Also that MARY HERSEY was born near Chickies Rock in that county. It seems probable that her early life, courtship and marriage were near this romantic spot. It is said that the highest point of this rock is about 300 feet above low water of the Susquehanna River that flows southwardly on the south-west. Westwardly is Chickies Creek running southwesterly into the river, and a canal and railroad are now between creek and rock. The westward side of this rock, a part of which side is shown in the above picture, is nearly perpendicular and is said to be about 200 feet high above canal bank. Westward about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles is that part of Marietta formerly owned by them, and around are hills and lovely valleys. They removed to Tonawanda, N. Y., in Dec. 1828.

All of the pictures in this work, except the portraits, are made from photographs taken by the author, and all are made under his direction.

Since the first edition each date as herein given has been carefully verified, and although records admitted to be wrong have been found that conflict with some of within dates, this work is believed to be correct.


