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### **FOREWORD**

This history of one branch of the McClellan family in America has been in preparation for many years, a fact which explains why many lines end in 1940. Much of the work on these lines was done at that time, and after a lapse of thirty years it is impossible to contact former correspondents and so to trace recent generations.

It has not been my intention to bring all lines down to the present, even if that were possible, but rather to show the beginnings of each branch, and to try to bring female lines down at least three generations from Michael and Jane Henry.

There are several genealogies of the Severance family. The Millers, Smiths, Boltons, Wilsons and McGees will be found in this writer's HISTORY OF COLRAIN, MASS., now in preparation and to be published, hopefully, within two years from this date. It will be available in the libraries of Colrain and Greenfield, and probably several others.

Although I have checked and rechecked the material in this book, I am sure mistakes will be found. I hope they are few. I apologize for them and hope my readers will forgive them.

### ORIGINS OF THE McCLELLAN FAMILY

Material researched by Q.S. McClellan, edited by L.M. Patrie

It has been well established that our family was first heard of among the "wild Scots of Galloway," that region comprising the southwesternmost extremity of Scotland. The name, which has been, and is still spelled in many different ways, is believed to be of Gaelic or Celtic origin. It means "son of the servant of Saint Fillan."

The Ragman Roll of August 28, 1296, a document of fealty to King Edward I of England, contains names which for several reasons may be presumed to be those of early McClellans, and are apparently the first on record. They are those of Cuthbert Makelemwym, Johan de Bundeby (Bomby) and Johan de Gevelstone. The lands of Bomby and Gelston are proved to have belonged to McClellans from 1400 and 1416, respectively.

Shortly thereafter, on March 3, 1305/6, we find the names of John de Gevelstone, Duncan de Gevelstone, and Patrick, son of Gilbert M'Lolan with those of twelve other esquires and men-at-arms who seized the Castle of Dumfries from the men of Robert the Bruce. Gilbert MacLelan, on February 15, 1320/21, became Bishop of Sodor and Man. His signature may be found on several documents in the years following. Cuthbert, mentioned above as signer of the Roll, was no doubt brother to the Bishop, who was probably a direct or collateral ancestor of those McClellans who followed him. (It must be remembered that in those early days of the Church the clergy were permitted to marry.)

We find record of our name in the place name Balmac-lellan as early as Jan. 3, 1380. The Gaelic is Baile MacGille Fhaolain, which means "stead of the sons of St. Fillan's servant," and the Latin signature reads, "Gilbertum McLellane dominum de Balmaclellane." The parish and village of Balmaclellan are located a few miles north of Kirkcudbright, and undoubtedly were a place of early residence of the family, and in which they became so strong that the name was given to both the parish and town. It is located in the area known as the Glenkens, quite mountainous, and the people were heavily in-

volved in the Covenant; Robert of Barscobe being one.

Later, in 1452, we find Patrick Maclellan of Wigtown, Sheriff of Galloway, killed by his overlord, the Earl of Douglas, in a dispute over fealty to the Crown of Scotland. Patrick was tutor of Bomby, NOT, as has been incorrectly asserted, McClellan of Bomby, but probably a well-born relative, undoubtedly McClellan of Gelston, who was chosen as guardian of McClellan of Bomby, who was then a minor.

The family certainly originated in Kirkcudbright, but it has not been possible to identify them with any particular branch. At one time there were fourteen knights named McClellan who owned homes in the Stewartry, and as late as the 17th century there were quite a few McClellan families, and we could be descended from any one of them, perhaps from a younger son of a younger son of an early member of the Bomby or Gelston families—no one knows.

In the fifteenth century the Bomby and Gelston branches emerged and continued to flourish for some time. The House of Bomby produced the first Lord Kirkcudbright, Robert McClellan. From here it is easy to trace this branch in Scot's Peerage. In 1610 Robert acquired extensive lands in Ireland, becoming one of the Adventurers for the Plantation. He was created Lord Kirkcudbright in 1633. He owned lands in Londonderry, and his third wife was buried in the parish church of Coleraine. Our ancestor may have accompanied him to Ireland and remained there. However, it is impossible that we descend from the Lords Kirkcudbright, for the Peerage clearly indicates that there were no descendants in the male line.

The McClellans both in Scotland and Ireland were zealous Presbyterians and Covenanters during the time of Cromwell. Family tradition among the descendants of Michael McClellan and Jane Henry reports that Michael's ancestors came to Ireland about one hundred years before Michael and his family removed to America. It also insists that members of the family married only into other Scottish Presbyterian families.

# Descendants of Michael McClellan and Jane Henry of Colrain, Mass.

Michael McClellan was born in the town or village of Maghera, parish of Curran, County Derry, Ireland, probably the son of Hugh McClellan, who died in that place in 1739. Michael came to America with his brother John and eight of his ten children in 1749. The McClellan family had emigrated from Kirkcudbrightshire in Galloway, Scotland about a century earlier. John settled somewhere in Maine and no trace has vet been found of his descendants. Michael, his wife and their children spent some time in Woburn or Worcester, Mass, and soon settled in Colrain, where they had friends and relatives. Michael bought a fifty-acre lot from Andrew Smith and built a house on it. At the beginning of the French and Indian War in 1750, when Indian attacks began to be made in the vicinity, he removed with his family and several others to Pelham, a less exposed town. His resources being soon exhausted, he secured work lumbering on the river. The exposure brought on pneumonia, from which he died in 1757. The whereabouts of his grave is unknown. Michael McClellan was said to have been slim, fair-haired and blue-eyed, and to have "been much on the water." He had lived in comfortable circumstances and never had to labor.

His wife, Jane Henry, was also born in Ireland about 1710. She was the daughter of David Henry, who is said to have fought in the army of William III at the Battle of the Boyne.

After the war, David is said to have settled near Londonderry, Ireland and to have married a Scotch-Irish girl. The Henry family is also said to be of Norman extraction and to have originated in Cumberland. Jane had four brothers who came to America a little before the McClellans: Hugh and John, who settled in Colrain, Robert, who went to Albany, N.Y. and is said to have been the first English speaking merchant there, and James, who settled in Deerfield. Jane Henry was small, auburn haired, of a very active temperament, and indomitable will and courage. After the death of Michael his widow was left in very straitened circumstances. Most of her children were very young, the oldest boy, Hugh, was only thirteen, but he and the older girls did all they could for the widow and younger children. They removed to Deerfield, probably to be near Jane's brother James, and the family kept together there until the war ended in 1760. In that year they returned to Colrain, where Hugh began the arduous task of clearing his father's land. Jane Henry lived with her son Hugh and his wife Sarah until her death, August 13, 1777. She is buried in Chandler Hill Cemetery.

JENNET McCLELLAN, eldest child of Michael and Jane (Henry) McClellan, born Maghera, Ireland, 1730, married in Maghera in 1749, Joseph Thompson, who was born there 1720. They came to America with Jennet's parents, settled briefly in Colrain, and went to Pelham with the McClellans during the French and Indian War. Later, Joseph bought land in Colrain, Lot 56 in the second division, where the descendants of this couple lived for nearly two hundred years, in the house that Joseph built. Since that lot was not bought until 1768, it is likely that they stayed with Jennet's family for some years after returning to Colrain about 1760. Joseph died at Colrain, April 9, 1803. Jennet also died there May 10, 1813. Both are buried in the North River Cemetery, their stones being among the oldest there.

#### COLONEL HUGH McCLELLAN AND HIS DESCENDANTS

Hugh, eldest son and sixth child of Michael and Jane (Henry) McClellan, was born in Maghera, Parish of Curran, Derry, Ireland, April 4, 1743. He was six years old when he came with his parents, brother and sisters, to America. After his father's death he became, at fourteen, the "man of the family." Upon the return to the Colrain farm, he cleared the land and began to plant it. He built a new log house for his bride Sarah Wilson, daughter of James and Margaret (McGee) Wilson and sister of Captain David Wilson. They were married Dec. 22, 1768. She was born in Chester, N.H., Aug. 12, 1745. She was said to be tall, dark-haired and robust. She lived to the great age of 93, dying at the home of her son Michael, Oct. 14, 1834.

Hugh was tall, also, heavy, and with his mother's ruddy coloring and reddish hair. He had a long life of distinguished service to his community. He served as selectman of Colrain from 1771 for twenty-nine years following. In 1774 he was elected a member of the Committee of Safety and Correspondence, and in February, 1775, chosen a captain of a company of minutemen. In April, 1775, he led his company of forty-four men on the Lexington Alarm, in August, 1777, to the Battle of Bennington, and in October, 1777, to service at the Battle of Stillwater.

In 1779 he was chosen to represent the town in the General Court, as the Massachusetts legislature was called. At this time, Colrain was in the process of annexing Bernardston Gore, east of the town. In the legislature Capt. McClellan was successful in having the east boundary of Colrain fixed on the west bank of the Green River, instead of in the middle of the river, as the inhabitants of Bernardston ardently desired. Thus, over the years Colrain has been saved a considerable sum of money for maintenance of bridges. From 1779 to 1810, at which time he declined further honors, he was elected to the Legislature thirty times—twenty-one to the House and nine to the Senate. He usually made the journey to Boston to attend the sessions, on horseback, and in warm weather pastured his

horse on the island which later became East Boston. For many years he rode the same horse, called "Pomp." Once, during the latter years of his service, the horse, with others, was sent over to pasture. On the boat someone asked the old Negro in charge if he knew whose horse that was. "Yes, sah!" was the reply. "Dat Colonel McClellan's hoss. Know'd dat hoss dis forty year."

In 1781 his house was burned and a frame one built on the site of the present one. This building (which also burned in 1815) he set out and largely framed himself, as he was a first-class carpenter as well as a surveyor of land. In July, 1781, he was commissioned Colonel of the 5th Massachusetts Militia. As Colonel, he rose from a sickbed where he was confined with an attack of quinsy, to take command of the regiment at the Battle of Springfield during Shays' Rebellion, in January, 1787.

He was commissioned a justice of the peace March 21, 1782, an office which he held until the time of his death. During this time many cases were tried before him. Although he had no opportunity for the formal study of law, his knowledge was very thorough, since he had had a hand in formulating and voting on the state laws during his many terms in the General Court. In politics he was a staunch Federalist.

The fire of 1815 came so swiftly that it not only destroyed the Colonel's satin short clothes and silver shoe buckles, but also his personal papers, a loss which has been a serious one to his descendants. It has been said that this fire also destroyed town records, but this is very unlikely, for the Colonel was never town clerk, and would have no reason to have such records in his possession. The house was promptly rebuilt by his son Michael, no doubt with the Colonel's expert advice, and still stands today, with very little alteration.

The following year, Aug. 13, 1816, this venerable soldier and statesman, "fell on sleep" in the seventy-third year of his age. He and his wife are buried in the old cemetery on Chandler Hill.

# LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT OF HUGH McCLELLAN, ESQ.

In the name of God, Amen, I Hugh McClallen Esq. of Colrain in the County of Franklin and Commonwealth of Massachusetts, being infirm in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be given to God therefor, calling to mind the mortality of my body, & knowing that it is appointed for all men to die. Do make and ordain this my last Will & Testament - That is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of God who gave it and my Body I recommend to the earth, to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Executor, nothing Doubting but that at the general resurrection. I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God, and as to such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me with in this life I give devise and dispose of in the following manner, Viz First I give to my Beloved Wife Sarah the Improvement of one-third of all my real estate, and all my Household furniture and the said furniture to be at her disposal at her decease, and also two Cows and six sheep to be kept Winter & Summer and Forty pounds of Flax yearly as long as she lives, and also one-half of my now dwelling house during the life of my wife. The above mentioned Cows & Sheep to be at the disposal of my wife Sarah at her decease.

I give to the heirs of my beloved Son Robert McClallen Decd. Viz Mary Jenny Samuel Sally and Robert, Fifteen Dollars to be equally divided. --- I give to my beloved Son James McClallen Fifteen Dollars. --- I give to my beloved Son John Fifty Dollars --- I give to my beloved Son Michael McClallen Seventy five acres of Land after the decease of my Beloved Wife Sarah and also all my Farming tools Provided the said Michael shall pay out the sums he shall be ordered to pay. I give to my Beloved Daughter Jane Bolton Fifteen Dollars.



furniture I leave to her disposal. I do also give and bequeath to my daughter Miranda Johnson the sum of two hundred dollars. I also give and bequeath to my second daughter Jane Browning two hundred dollars. I also give and bequeath to my two younger daughters. Sarah McClallen and Ann McClallen the sum of four hundred dollars apiece and that they shall have beds and beding & household furniture equal to what their two elder sisters had when married. I also give and bequeath to my youngest son John McClallen the sum of eight hundred dollars to be paid to him when he shall arrive to the age of twentyone years. I also give and bequeath to my eldest son. Hugh McClallen, all my Real and freehold estate situate lyeing and being in Colerain & lastly, as to all the Rest, Residue and Remainder of my personal estate whatsoever, I give and bequeath to my eldest son, Hugh McClallen, whom I hereby appoint sole executor of this my last will and testament, hereby Revoking all other wills by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal the twenty-fifth day of February in the year of our Lord one Thousand eight hundred and forty-two.

A Brief Biography of Michael McClellan, son of Col. Hugh

Michael McClellan was a selectman in Colrain in 1817, 1818, 1826, 1827, 1828 and 1829. He was also a representative to the General Court prior to 1857. Edward R. McClellan wrote in 1939:

My grandfather, better known as 'Uncle Mike' was an outstanding man, both physically and mentally. He was the referee of all neighborhood disputes. He took life clamly, was temperate, never used liquors or tobacco. That was the time when everyone drank more or less, and when the preacher made his call my father [John] would be sent to a neighbor who had a still for a jug of rum. A neighbor of his who wanted to make a loan came to man of welath with a note bearing six signatures. He was told to go to McClellan and have him sign and he could have the money.

After the Revolution there was a company of artillery and one of infantry in Colrain. He was a member and saw action in 1812. He died in his eighties, death being caused from a broken limb. When he was well into his seventies a neighbor had an ox which had the shell of his horn broken off and was almost mad with pain --- They sent out an s.o.s. for Uncle Mike. He walked in, grabbed the ox and held him by his good horn and nose while they put a tar bandage on.

My grandmother, Jane Patterson, was an outstanding woman. --- She had an athletic turn and could jump over a set table. Her youngest daughter Ann could outrun and outjump any girl in Mt. Holyoke. Her grandson, Edwin Browning, could outjump any man in Banks' army of 80,000 men. Roy Browning, her great-grandson, at one time held the high jump record of the State of Massachusetts. She had eight children, considered a small family at that time. My father John was the youngest and she used to box his ears for whistling on Sunday.



practice of law 1860 in Troy as a partner of James Lansing. He authored a legal guide for executors and also a treatise on Practice in the Surrogate's Court and the duties of executors, administrators and guardians. He married 1852, Elizabeth Tobey. She was born Jan. 22, 1832; died Dec. 5, 1901. Robert H. McClellan may be credited with making the first researches into the family history and trying to find his ancestors in Ireland and Scotland, apparently without results. I have letters written by him on this subject as far back as 1857. Eventually he turned over his material to his cousin, Charles H. McClellan, who continued the investigations. (See #78) Robert H. McClellan died in Troy, Apr. 21, 1893.

### ROBERT McCLELLAN AND HIS DESCENDANTS

ROBERT McCLELLAN, son of Michael and Jane (Henry) McClellan and younger brother of Hugh, born Maghera, Ireland, Jan. 5, 1747, was ten years old when his father died. At the close of the French and Indian War, he was taken by Hugh through the forest and over the mountains to Albany, N.Y., where he was placed in the care of their uncle, Robert Henry, their mother's brother, who was a merchant in that city. He later went into business with his uncle, and at one time Robert McClellan had a store in Troy, also. Apparently he never returned to Colrain. He married Jane Williams in Albany Apr. 29, 1771. She was born in Albany Oct. 23, 1750. Robert was Treasurer of New York State 1798 to 1803. He died in Albany Oct. 8, 1817. He seems to have had few, if any, grandchildren.

MARTHA McCLELLAN, daughter of Michael and Jane Henry, born 1749, married Colrain, Dec. 1782, Asahel Atherton of Shelburne. He was born at Greenfield, Nov. 9, 1747, the son of Shubel and Sarah (Allen) Atherton. Shubel was killed and scalped by Indians Aug. 23, 1756, according to Thompson's History of Greenfield. Shubel's father was an early settler of Deerfield. His name was Joseph Atherton, and his father was Rev. Hope Atherton of Dorchester. Asahel served at Cambridge in 1775 in Capt. Moses Harvey's Company, Col. John Brewer's regt. Martha Atherton died Apr. 1788.

ELIZABETH McCLELLAN, daughter of Michael and Jane (Henry) McClellan, born July 21, 1752; died May 5, 1825. She married, Jan. 10, 1783, Jonathan Severance of Greenfield, son of Jonathan and Thankful (Stebbins) Severance. He was born Greenfield, Apr. 11, 1750; died Truxton, N. Y., May 15, 1845; aged 95. The Severance family is one of the oldest in Massachusetts, going back to John Severens, a settler at Salisbury in 1639. The following is a quotation from "Genealogical History" by Rev. John F. Severence, published in 1893.

"Before the outbreak of the Revolution his [Jonathan's] father built a grist mill in Springfield, the first one in the region, and it fell to the lot of this son to act as miller. During the war he was drafted into service, and his father, in order to keep the mill running, procured a substitute. He was a man of medium height, broad-shouldered, fine physique, very supple, would turn a somersault at the age of 75, to the perfect disgust of the boys."

The family lived in Greenfield until 1800, when Jonathan moved them to Truxton, purchased a farm of Elnathan Benedict, and lived there until his death.
