If you have paid for the \$3.00 printed history you will get a nicely printed book. Or if you want a Printed instead of mimeographed history-- Make your check payable only to WALTERS PRINTING CO. If you only paid a dollar you will get two more sections of the history like this and may I suggest that you get a cover at your Novelty or Stationery store--anywhere from 10¢ to 50¢ it will protect your history for years but the 3.00 book is nicely bound--The reason for this cheaper advance edition--IT WAS THE ONLY WAY TO GET ALL DATA to print in better book--BUT it is costing us over 90¢ ninety cents for the three sections. My Dear Cousin:

I do wish you would take time out and read this letter and write me soon. I will appreciate that act of kindness a lot.

Thirty eight years I started to compile the Matteson history--the only complete Matteson-Mattison history in all of the world--I spent much over five thousand dollars in research fees, postage and all that goes with this work and I do not want a cent back-- Several years ago I contracted to have 1000 books printed and I only secured 309 orders so far--Not to be stopped, I arranged to make up branch books--to take a branch chapter from the big history and have it published--but to start printing a chapter when all data is not in is too expensive--and I am sorry to state your William Matteson branch has been to me the hardest group to get data from, a majority have been wonderful-- but do please tell all of your folks why I could not print the history--I did not have all data and printing costs money --but we did something that has given many a wrong impression--to get a form out so that you would know what we had and what was missing --I had what I had mimeographed to be used as a guide to show what we still needed--VERY FEW HAVE UNDERSTOOD THIS and many thought this was the final history, I am sorry about that, Then data is now coming in very fast--I will soon have section #2 of this history ready to mail and ready as soon as those who have not sent data , send it--wont you rush this data to me?

Then stop and figure out the many hours of work it takes to make up copy and even mimeograph this history--another 40 pages is being made up now and as soon as all is in it too will be mailed.

To all descendants of William Matteson the Revolutionary War soldier who married Nehitable Matteson daughter of Zarababel Matteson: I am printing the complete Matteson history comprising 1320 pages and over 110,000 family records dating from 1600 to 1954. - WILLIAM MATTESON son of David of Montville was born 24th. Jan 1762 and died 6 April 1858 at Harmony near Panama, N.Y. Chautauqua County. He is buried in a burial lot of the original Wm. Matteson farm between Stowe and Panama, N.Y. Affidavit to this fact was made in 1930 by A.M. Connelly. Wm. enlisted 6 July 1780, served til 12 Dec. 1780, reenlisted 26 Aug 1781 served until Dec 1781--Lived then at New London, Conn. Applied for pension 28 August 1838. Served under Capt. Elisha Hart and Stephen Betts and in Regiment of Col. Hyllys and Herman Swift and Ebenezer Huntington of Conn. Militia. He married Nehitable Matteson daughter of Zarababel who was a son of Hezekiah and Margaret Westcott Matteson, Hezekiah being a son of the Pioneer Henry Matteson and his wife Hannah Parsons Matteson. They had 13 children:
- I. Sally Matteson born 22 September 1787 married Thomas Matteson son of Thomas who was also a Revolutionary War soldier. This couple went to Texas 1839.
 - II. William Matteson jr. born 27 January 1789; believed to have been drowned in Lake Superior.
 - III. Rev. Estace or Estys Matteson born 42 Feb. 1791 died in Cleveland, Ohio. he married Lydia Phillips; Was in War of 1812.
 - IV. Abigail Matteson born 23 October 1792. Died in Kalamazoo, Mich.
 - V. Olive or Alice Matteson born 23 March 1795 married Cole died in Wisc.
 - VI. Nehitable Matteson born 9 Feb. 1797 married Isaac Carpenter; Died at Blockville, Chautauqua Co. New York. This is another big chapter of the history.
 - VII. Polly Matteson born 6 Feb. 1799 died Unmarried.
 - VIII. Zarababel born 26 April 1801 Went west in the gold rush--He was the grand father of Lewis W. Matteson owner of the MATTESON-SOUTHWEST CO. Houston, Tex.
 - IX. Stephen Matteson born 31 March 1803 --reported as killed by lightning but I found records where he crossed the plains in a covered wagon.
 - X. Betsey Matteson born 24 March 1805. Died in Pennsylvania.
 - XI. David Tompkins Matteson born Wednesday 11 May 1808 at Burlington, N.Y. and died at Eagle Lake, Minnesota. married 13 Feb. 1833 Dorcas Britton.
 - XII. Victor Moreau Matteson born 19 April 1810 in Burlington, N.Y. died 1897 married in Ashville, N.Y. 20 Feb 1840 Marietta Elizabeth Hoag born 18 Sept 1819 died 23 August 1883.
 - XIII. Schuyler born 4 April 1812 died 1879 Joplin City, Missouri. Named for his Mother's brother Schuyler.

II. Sallie Matteson daughter of William and Nehitable Matteson, (her parents were both Mattesons) married Thomas Matteson whose father Thomas Matteson sr was also a Rev. War soldier. The elder Thomas Matteson lived to be 100 years old. Sally and Thomas Matteson lived at Hartsburg Ashtabula County, Ohio, coming there from Chautauqua Co NY -- Thomas sr and Thomas jr were both Justices of the Peace in Ohio. It is there that they met the Alderman families one of the best families in Ohio at that time. I have gathered data for years on how these folks went to Texas and I will give a free book to the one who tells me the most authentic true story about their trip to the Lone Star State. My data shows they came to Ill. (Illinois) and down the river and overland from Shreveport to Macogdoches County but perhaps you Texas folks know it more fully.

Thomas Matteson was born 24 August 1789 died 8 Dec 1841 -- Thomas and Sally had ten children:

4. Lydia Matteson b. 2 Feb 1815 d. 28 Jan 1854 at Windsor, Ohio. Several of the Matteson group did not go to Texas in 1839. Until later.

6. Polly O. Matteson b. 21 Nov 1819 d. 7 Jan 1862
7. William Perry Matteson 9 Oct 1821 d. 26 Nov. 1861

I kept a list of letters I wrote for data starting in 1950 and I kept sending letters trying to get all data--some is still not in the files--but now maybe you folks will help me finish records when you see the vast amount I have-- Any cousin who has stopped here and seen the room full of files 110,000 family records 1600 to 1954--those folks need no urging to send data--they do not question me but go home and start getting me records. I wanted to print this as the big history is being printed not mimeographed but only a few paid for 3.00 books--many ordered but approximately 30 paid the 3.00 and I was to pay 300.00--But I am not a quitter--I will prove we have a history--Do help all you can--my expense comes in sending sections of the history which I would not have to do had all sent data as I asked for it. I will also leave space where data is missing so you can fill when I send it.
