Note: The above records were copied for the Eli Miller branch of the family by Harriet Theresa Kinne Barnett of Lexington, Kentucky. Mrs. Barnett is the daughter of Hela Estelle Miller Kinne Fogg.

The following data on the Eli Miller family, and on the earlier family in Indiana and Ohio, has been obtained from Henry Miller, son of Eli Miller, who resides in Baldwin, Michigan, and from Grace Miller Gloster, (daughter of Victor and Emma (Constock) Miller) of Chicago, Illinois.

The Eli Miller Family

Eli Miller was born January 16th, 1839 in Adams Township, Allen County, Indiana. Shortly after the Civil War he moved to Logan Township, Mason County, Michigan, and was one of the first settlers of that area. He was married twice and was the father of eight sons.

Children of the first marriage:

George Miller Died in infancy

Arthur " Married but had no children of his own. Moved to southern Michigan, thence to Indiana where he died

Isaac " Married Elizabeth Gillinger and resided near his father. If there were children they did not live to adulthood.

Edward " May have been one of the older brothers. Married but there were no children. He died in Detroit, Michigan where he had resided for a number of years.

Eli Miller married as his second wife, Hannah Valeen, who had recently arrived from Sweden to make her home in America.

Children of the second marriage were:

Ida Miller Step-daughter of Eli Miller - she married Perry Tyndall and resided on a farm near her mother and step-father.

Victor Miller Married Emma Constock and resided on a farm near the Miller homestead, but just over the county line, the location being in Lake County, Michigan.

Martin Miller Was a career soldier - never married

Henry Miller Resides near Baldwin, Michigan - never married

Frank Miller Married Frances Tyndall, a niece of Perry
Tyndall. They reside near Scottville, Michigan.

Note: Many of the children and grandchildren of Victor Miller, Frank Miller and Ida (Miller) Tyndall, still live in Mason and Lake Counties in Michigan.

Further research, mainly in County histories and census records, has revealed the following which is additional to the Zacharias Miller Family Record.

John Miller married Susannah, daughter of Abraham and Magdeline (Whitehead) Studebaker and had at least three sons, Jacob, David and Abraham and were probably the parents of Elizabeth Miller who married Phillip Hartzell in Montgomery County, Ohio December 29, 1811.

John Miller died in Montgomery County, Ohio, his estate papers being filed December 8th, 1810. His widow, Susannah, married in Montgomery County, Conrad Kreitz. The date of marriage was June 6, 1813.

In about the year 1827 Susannah Kreitz and her sons David, Jacob and Abraham Miller moved to Adams Township, Allen County, Indiana.

In the 1850 census of Adams Township (Allen County) the "Widow Kritz" is listed as being a member of the Jacob Miller household. She is aged 73, and her place of birth is given as Pennsylvania.

David W. Miller married Rachel Townsend in August, 1828. Abraham Miller married Ann Tilberry in Allen County August 8, 1830. It is believed that all three brothers lived the rest of their lives in Allen County, Indiana.
