Genealogy of the Moulthrop Family of Connecticut

First Generation

I. 1—MATTHEW MOULTHROP, b. England. Was at New Haven in 1639; d. New Haven, 22nd December, 1668. Admitted to the First Church of New Haven before 1644. His wife, Jane, who d. May, 1672, was admitted to the same church before 1661. Record of marriage, which took place in England, has not been found. Will in Volume i, page 143, of New Haven Probates, through which he disposes of comfortable estates for that period of time. Jane, his widow, left a will recorded in Volume i, page 156, of the New Haven records.

The family name is thought to be of Danish origin and it seems probable that the family came from Denmark through England. The name is spelled variously in existing historical records as Moulthrop, Molthrop, Moulthrop, Moulltrop, Moltroup, Moultroup, Moultrap, Moulthropp, and the latter would seem to be the original form.

Matthew, the immigrant, moved from New Haven to Stony River, East Haven, in 1662. Of the child Mary no further record has been found.

Matthew and his wife were members of the First Church at New Haven, and in Atwood's History of New Haven, their names are recorded in the seating of the meeting-house, from 1646 to 1665.

The same history contains a map of the early New Haven Colony on which is shown the plot of land owned by Matthew Moulthrop.

Baker's History and Antiquities of New Haven gives authority for the statements of residence.

II. 2—MATTHEW MOULTHROP, (Matthew) b. in England; d. East Haven, 1st February, 1690-1, ae. 53. He was at East Haven in 1638; m. 26th June, 1662 Hannah THOMPSON, dau. of John and Eleanor THOMPSON. Authorities differ as to Matthew's birth. His death record, shown above, places his birth in 1638, but history refers to his birth in England as stated. His will, distributing an estate, was probated 10th June, 1691, and recorded in Volume II of the New Haven Records. Allen Bull and Isaac Bradley were appraisers.

Note 1—Thomas Barnes was in New Haven, 1644. He had Thomas, Jr., b. 1653, who m. Keziah Moulthrop. They Sarah Barnes, b. 1689, who m. Samuel Moulthrop, b. 1679. Thus, Keziah, her mother, may have been unrecorded dau. of Matthew (1) and Jane, or some immigrant relative of Matthew. (See Dodd's East Haven Register).

III. 7—Sergeant JOHN MOULTHROP, (Matthew-Matthew) b. 5th February, 1667-8; d. 14th February, 1713; m. 29th June, 1692; Abigail BRADLEY, b. 9th September, 1671; d. 3rd September, 1743, dau. of Joseph, b. 4th January, 1646; m. 25th October, 1667, Silence BROCKETT, dau. of John BROCKETT, of New Haven. Lived in East Haven. Abigail was admitted to the Church, September, 1743. In Colonial Wars. His estate was probated in 1714, Abigail, his wife, being executrix, and was recorded in Volume IV of the New Haven Probates.

John BROCKETT, son of Sir John, of England, was the young engineer chosen to lay out the village or Colony of New Haven. The "Green" or "Public Square," and its surroundings for two blocks deep, remain practically unchanged in form from that established by the first survey. John d. 12th March, 1689. ae. 80.

Josiah was a veteran of the war of 1812, taking part with Battery at Groton, Connecticut; afterwards sailor, making several voyages to close of war. He and family settled in Otsego County, New York, thence to Elba, Genesee County; thence to Allison, Orleans County, New York; thence to Wisconsin Territory, four miles from Oskosh, Winnebago County, near son Matthias Nelson, who preceded him to the Territory.

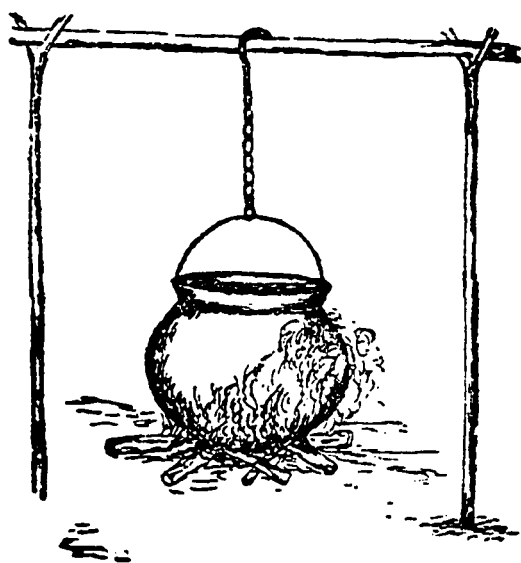

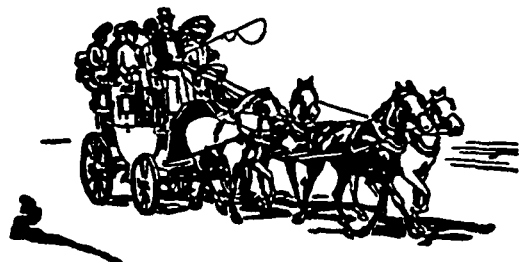

RAYMOND. Moved to Michigan in 1858; thence, 1860, to Elba, Genesee County, New York; commenced teaching there, 1868; moved to Rochester, New York in 1876; Principal Western House of Refuge. Continued there as Principal and Assistant Superintendent until 1887; thence Principal of Washington Public School, Rochester, for thirty-four years, to 1921.
