Rebecca Ogden, dau. of Robert Ogden 1st and Hannah Crane; b. 16th June, 1729; d. 31st March, 1806 (Eliz. Tomb. 1784); m. Sept. 16th, 1744.

Caleb Halsted, b. 8th July, 1721; d. 4th June, 1784 (Eliz. Tomb. 1783).

Note.—The latter was a son of Caleb Halsted of Hemstead, L. I. Letters of administration on the latter's estate were granted to widow Jaan Halsted, 26th March, 1721, at Perth Amboy (A of wills, pg. 229). She probably m. 2d husband, John Clauson, on whose estate she took out letters of administration 24th March, 1728 (B of wills, pg. 115), Perth Amboy. She afterwards m. Thos. Ogden and d. Dec. 8, 1760, in 66th year of her age (Eliz. Tomb. No. 32). Caleb Halsted, Sen., was son of Timothy Halsted, who settled at Hemstead, L. I., from England as early as 1660. Timothy Halsted d. at Elizabethtown; his will, dated May 23, 1734, proved April 14, 1735, names sons Timothy, John, Jacob, and Jonas, daus. Hannah (wid. of Jacob Mitchell), Abigail Painter, Charity Haywood, Rebecca Higgins, Amy and Elizabeth (who m. Jonathan Allen); does not name Caleb, probably because he had died before testator. Caleb Halsted, Jr., lived at Halsted's Point, Elizabeth, N. J. His children:
