## INTRODUCTION.

---

THE compiler of this Genealogy, in the year 1854, visited Simsbury, Conn., the former residence of John Pettibone, from whom are descended all of the Pettibone family in the United States. He was for several days a guest of John Owen Pettibone, who was graduated at Yale College in 1805, who owned the farm formerly in the possession of the first John Pettibone, and who lived in the house where that John Pettibone died in 1713. John O. Pettibone was then nearly seventy years of age. He had an excellent memory, a great fund of information respecting the early settlers of Simsbury, and a mass of data concerning the Pettibone family. Much of this was written on fragments of paper, but no attempt had been made to reduce it to order or put it in shape for preservation. Had the compiler not met this John O. Pettibone and secured the fund of information in his possession, probably most of it would have been lost. He added to that fund such facts as he could find in histories of various towns and counties in Connecticut, and in 1855, assisted by Roswell G. Pettibone, Esq., of Ogdensburg, N. Y., had all of it in shape for preservation. Of the two copies then made he has kept one in his possession during a long residence abroad, the other has remained here and has been extensively copied by members of the Pettibone family in various parts of the United States. Additional materials, as well as some imperfections in the volume prepared in 1855, have rendered a revision necessary, and the present volume is the result.

Search has been made in England, especially in the British Museum, for information concerning the European origin of the family, but none has been found. The name *Petribuoni*, occurring in Venice, Italy, lends some support to the tradition that the name Pettibone is a corruption of Peter-bon—Good Peter.

For the sake of reference two numbers are attached to each name. The first number designates the *number of the generation*, John Pettibone, of Windsor, being of the *first*, his children of the *second*, etc. The second number is arbitrary, and helps the reader to trace through the volume the name to which it is attached.

This Genealogy contains the names of only the first five generations of the family in America. A large number of names in the succeeding generations have been collected, and when the list is complete these additions may be published in a revised edition.

**1, 1.** John Pettibone was married at Windsor, Conn., Feb. 16, 1664.

One tradition says he came from Wales. He was a member of the first church organized in Simsbury, as were also his wife and several of his children. He was a farmer. In his old age he lived with one of his sons. He died July 15, 1713. The house where he died is on the main street of the Village of Weatogue, in Simsbury, and in 1876 was in good preservation, and in possession of the Pettibone family. Simsbury is a part of the old *Windsor Colony*.

Sarah Eggleston was a daughter of Begot Eggleston, who was first a settler in Dorchester, Mass., and removed thence to Windsor. She died July 8, 1713, just one week before the death of her husband.

Many of the above mentioned facts are gleaned from Phelps's History of Simsbury.

He was a farmer and a member of the first church in Simsbury. He lived on the east side of the Farmington river, near or in the Village of Weatogue.

- 2, 2.** Sarah Pettibone's children were John, Joseph, Benjamin, and Sarah Mills, and John, Benajah, Michael, Daniel, and Hannah Humphrey. The Mills family of Norfolk, Conn., were their descendants.

Jonathan Pettibone, but died and was buried at Rye, near White Plains, in New York. A stone was erected to his memory in the Cemetery at Simsbury. His widow died October 7, 1796. aged 85.
