—IN THE—

UNITED STATES IN 1790

When the First Census of the United States was ordered less than a year of the first administration had elapsed, General Washington having been inaugurated President in New York City, April 30, 1789, and the machinery of the Federal Government just constructed was undergoing its first and most critical test.

The First Census was taken in 1790, and the existing schedules are on file in the Census Office in Washington, D. C., in twenty-seven volumes.

The incomplete and missing schedules are those for New Jersey, Delaware, Virginia, Georgia, Kentucky, the Northwest Territory and the Southwest Territory.

Some of the schedules were destroyed when the British burned the Capitol at Washington during the war of 1812, but the schedules for the most populous states at that period are still in existence.

The total white population was 3,172,444 and the number of families was 410,636, and it is reasonable to suppose that many of the isolated households along and beyond the frontier were not enumerated. The heads of the enumerated families were practically the founders of the Republic.

Only five cities then had a population of 13,000 or more, and these were Philadelphia, New York, Boston, Charleston and Baltimore.

There were 410,636 Heads of Families enumerated and among them were 588 of the name of Perkins (variously spelled), whose families consisted of 3,327 individuals, who settled as follows: In

In New York City there was one family of the name and only eighteen others in the whole state. In Boston there were ten families, while in the towns of Ipswich and Topsfield, where John Perkins and his three sons originally settled, there were thirty-five families.

PERKINS FAMILIES IN NEW JERSEY, DELAWARE, MARYLAND AND VIRGINIA.

The schedules are missing for New Jersey, Delaware and Virginia, but the Perkins families were known to be numerous in those states, and also in Maryland, and the evidence is here presented to prove that some of them were descendants of Isaac and Susanna Perkins of Hampton, N. H.

Among the children of Isaac Perkins of Hampton were:

JACOB, baptized 24th of May, 1640.

REBECCA, married 21st of September, 1659, John Hussey.

EBENEZER, born 9th December, 1659.

JOSEPH, born 9th April, 1661.

1st of July, 1695, John Hussey, "late of HampTown in New Hampshire, near piscatoway in New England," purchased 340 acres of land near New Castle, Delaware, and 17th of July, 1699, administration upon the estate of Susanna Perkins (his mother-in-law) was granted to John Hussey, principal creditor. He died in 1707.

Ebenezer and Joseph Perkins, both late of New England, husbandmen, purchased land in Brandywine hundred, New Castle County, on Delaware, by deeds dated October 14th, 1693. Ebenezer Perkins of the County of New Castle, husbandman, by will dated 20th of July, 1703, and proved 16th of September following, bequeathed all his real estate to his youngest sons, Isaac and Ebenezer, which they sold in 1725, to Thomas Cartmell.

The children of Ebenezer Perkins were:

DANIEL.

ABIGAIL.

ELIZABETH.

JONATHAN.

DAVID.

EBENEZER.

ISAAC, about 1723, married Mary, dau. of Charles Booth, and removed to the Shenandoah, Virginia, where most of their fourteen children were born.

The will of Joseph Perkins, dated 4th of 11th mo. (Jan.), 1706-7, and proved 19 Aug., 1707, gave to eldest son, Joseph, all the real estate, he paying legacies to the other children, John, Caleb, Humphrey, Joshua, Mary and Martha. In 1724, Joseph, Jr., sold the land to Caleb Perkins, blacksmith, who married, 1721, Ann Beakes.

October 28, 1693, Jacob Perkins bought about 330 acres of land on the Delaware River below Burlington, N. J., for £105. This land he divided among his three sons in 1711.

The children of Jacob Perkins were:

ISAAC (the eldest), born Dec. 18, 1671; who had removed to Kent County, Maryland, prior to 1731, and died in or before 1746, leaving a son, Wright.

JACOB, born Dec. 24, 1674; died about 1731.

BENJAMIN, born Aug. 12, 1693.

All three sons were born in Hampton, New Hampshire, and baptized at St. Mary's P. E. Church at Burlington, N. J., 20th of November, 1703.

JOHN PERKINS, SR., OF IPSWICH, MASS.

JOHN PERKINS was the first representative of the family who settled in New England, and the hazy family tradition of the "three brothers" that lingers in the minds of their descendants might be rendered more clear by tracing their probable antecedents in England, for they were the sons of John Perkins, Sr., who arrived with his family at Nantasket, Massachusetts Bay Colony, February 5th, 1631, in the ship *Lyon* from Bristol, England.

Miss F. M. Caulkins in her *History of Norwich, Conn.*, published in 1845, states that a new ecclesiastical society organized at Norwich, Conn., in 1723, "took the name of Newent in fond remembrance of "a town of that name in Gloucestershire, England, from which the "ancestors of Joseph and Jabez Perkins originally emigrated." She also says "one source of information was tradition and conversation "with aged persons," and she vouches for the reliability and correctness of her work as follows: "Not a fact, name or date has been "given without careful inquiry and examination, but the information on many points was scanty and doubtless in some cases "incorrect; mistakes will probably be discovered." Miss Caulkins, therefore, is the authority for the assertion that John Perkins was from Newent, England.

Authentic records gleaned from various sources go to prove that John Perkins was a native of Hillmorton, Warwickshire, but he could have emigrated from Newent or any other place, and the known facts are here presented for thoughtful consideration.

June 2d. 1635, in the General Court it was "ordered that a "war[ran]t shall be sent to Norton to bring into the nexte Court a "bill of five pounds made by Goodm[an] Perkins to Thomas Wade "yt it may be safely kept till it appeare to whom it is due, the money "being gyven (as the Court is informed) to Jonathan Wade his "brother."

Other records show John Perkins was sometimes called "Goodman Perkins," while William Perkins was never so styled.

Savage's *Genealogical Dictionary* says Jonathan Wade of Ipswich "for a claim on account of sixty pounds put into the common "stock by his brother Thomas of Northampton, England, could not "gain part of Plum Island as he desired." Thomas Wade was a subscriber and promoter of the Massachusetts Bay Company, but nowhere does it appear he ever lived in, or even visited, New England. The indebtedness must have been incurred in England and the bill was doubtless sent for collection by Thomas Wade of Northampton to his brother Jonathan in Ipswich, Mass., to whom the money was "gyven."

The Court Records of Essex County, Mass., record the fact that "March, 1630, John Perkins, senr. being *above* 60 years of age

"[was] freed from ordinary training." This record is applicable to him if he was born any year before 1590.

John Perkins like most of the men at that period was a husbandman of moderate means and required a considerable sum of money to bring over his family, consisting of his wife Judith and their three sons and two daughters; besides he needed for his living in a new and sparsely settled wilderness and for his occupation household goods, provisions, live stock, tools, utensils, etc., and very likely he had incurred the bill in question.

William Perkins on the other hand was a son of a wealthy family, was well educated, twenty-eight years of age, unmarried, fond of adventure, and it is doubtful if he ever visited Northampton.

Consequently it is reasonable to conclude that "Goodman Perkins" was John Perkins.

The Court files of Essex County, Mass., furnish evidence that seems to indicate relationship between the Perkins and Gater families.

Lydia Perkins, youngest daughter of John Perkins, was baptized in the Boston church June 3, 1632, married Henry Bennet about 1650, and they settled on a two-hundred acre farm situated in what is now the southeastern part of Ipswich. In April, 1669, she made the following deposition which was supported by the testimony of a witness who was also present when goodwife Elizabeth Linckhorn was forcibly ejected from the Bennet home by Elizabeth Gater, whose position in the Bennet family is a matter of conjecture:

"The Deposition of Liddua Benit aged 36 yeas who saith that "the last lecture day after I came home I saw Elizabeth Gater take "Elizabeth Linckhorne under her Arme and caried her out of the "house our sonn Jacob about an hour after they scuffleing again went "to part them and Elizabeth gater bad him let her alone or she would "give him as much; so goodwife Linckhorne maid answer to the "boy: She will be the death of my Dame or you: no said the Eliza- "beth gator I will not be the death of them; but I will be the death "of thee."

"The testimony of Beniomin Morgin 20 yers being at Henery "Benets house the same time I herd Elizabeth Gater call Elesabeth "Lenckhorne Caren and Jaed and so cared her out of dors and I "herd Elezabeth Gater say she would be the deth of Lenckhornes "wife: after when Lenckhorn's wife was com from Mr. Simonsis "whar she had ben for a warant the said Gatter fell fouell of her "again and so she swounded away and I tocke her up:"

"furder Saith Not.

"Sworne in Court hed at Ipswich

"the 28 (2) 69.

As Attest Rob Lord clerk."

Jacob Bennet, born in 1651, was a youth of 17 in 1669; and it is apparent that Elizabeth Gater was a mature, well developed woman possessing no little physical strength to carry another woman out of the house and threaten a youth of 17 with the same treatment. It was an unusual proceeding for a servant to assume such authority in the Bennet household, but if Elizabeth Gater was a relative of Mrs. Bennet her action might be condoned by the family. After the above described scuffle all traces of Elizabeth Gater are lost and this query naturally arises: Was she a relative, a younger sister or niece, of Judith Gater who, in 1608, married John Perkins at Hillmorton in Warwickshire, England?

THE PERKINS FAMILY OF HILLMORTON, WARWICKSHIRE, ENGLAND.

About fifteen miles from Northampton and two miles east of Rugby, on the highway leading from Northampton to Coventry, lies the village of Hillmorton in Warwickshire, in whose Parish Register are recorded the baptism of "John Perkins, son of Henry and Elizabeth, his wife," 23d of December, 1583, and the marriage, 9th of October, 1608, of John Perkyns and Judith Gater; but no baptisms of their children are entered. The married couple disappeared from Hillmorton, and the question arises: Are they identical with the passengers bearing the same names who embarked aboard the ship "Lyon," at Bristol, December 1st, 1630, twenty-two years after, with their five children?

From wills in the Lichfield, Staffordshire, Probate Registry, supplemented by additional records from the Parish Register, the following account of the Hillmorton branch is obtained: The first representative of the family was:

1. THOMAS PERKYNs of Hillmorton; died April, 1528. His will was dated the 3rd and proved the 21st of April, 1528. He appointed his wife Alys his executrix. Alice Perkyns of Hillmorton, widow, made her will the 31st of July, 1538, and it was proved the 15th of October following; amount of inventory £36 2s. 1d.

Dugdale's History of Warwickshire notices a monument (now gone) in the church of Hillmorton as follows: "In the middle Ile of this Church are two grave stones of marble, each of them having small portraitures in brass of a man and a woman, with divers children. One of them has this inscription:

"Here lyeth Thomas Perkins and Alice and Elizabeth.

"Our Lord save their soules from everlasting death. Amen."

This monument may have been erected about 1528, by Alice Perkyns, the widow and executrix of Thomas, to commemorate her husband and perhaps two daughters who died before their parents and consequently are not mentioned in either will.

The children of Thomas and Alice Perkyns were:

JONE (or JANE), who was probably unmarried in 1528, but married and living, 31st of July, 1538, as the wife of ——— Sleyter.

JELYN (or JULIANA), probably unmarried in 1528, but married and living, the 31st of July, 1538, as the wife of ——— Cumpton.

2. HENRY PERKYNs, son of (1) Thomas and Alice Perkyns, proved his mother's will, Oct. 15th, 1538.

The will of Henry Perkyns of the parish of Hillmorton was proved the 16th of June, 1546, but it is now missing.

The known children of Henry Perkyns were:

JOAN, of Hillmorton; died unmarried in 1578; administration upon her estate was granted to "Thomas Perkins, the brother," the 17th of June, 1578.

3. THOMAS PERKYNS, son of (2) Henry Perkyns, married Alice ——— (probably a sister to Willyam Kebbell). After the death of his sister Joan in 1578, he administered upon her estate, and died in March, 1592, as the will of Thomas Perkyns the elder, of Hillmorton, husbandman, was dated the 16th of September, 1588, and proved the 11th of May, 1592. He was buried March 23d, 1591-2. Besides his children he mentions in his will "my brother Kebbler's wife" and William Perkyns "my brother." Inventory, 29 March, 1592, £192 10s.

Alice Perkins, probably widow of Thomas, was buried 20th Aug. 1613.

The children of Thomas and Alice Perkyns were:

4. WILLIAM PERKYNS, son of (2) Henry Perkyns of Hillmorton was mentioned in the will of his brother Thomas the 16th of September, 1588. Administration upon the estate of William Perkins of Hillmorton was granted April 10th, 1590, to Elizabeth, "the relict." The inventory mentions "wares at Rugby," where he seems to have been a mercer. Whether he left any children has not been ascertained.

8. HENRY PERKYNS was the eldest son, in 1588, of (3) Thomas and Alice Perkyns, and 29th November, 1579, married Elizabeth ———. He was executor of his father's will and proved same 11th of May, 1592; was appraiser of the estate of Wm. Kebble, 1601; was named as overseer in his brother John's will, 1602; also of the will of Elizabeth Perkins, 1603. He was buried March 2d, 1608. The inventory, dated 22 March, 1608, amounted to £366 8s. 8d.

The children of Henry and Elizabeth Perkyns were:

Three of the daughters were living 29 June, 1603; the other two were born after that date.

All the children except Thomas and John were under 21, 5th April, 1609.

9. JOHN PERKYNS, son of (3) Thomas and Alice Perkyms, married Elizabeth Shawe. The will of John Perkyms of Hillmorton, husbandman, was dated 17th Dec., 1601, and was proved by his widow 6th of June, 1602. After his wife's decease in 1603, administration upon his estate was granted to his brother Thomas, 24th Nov., 1603. The inventory amounted to £154 14s. and was dated 2 Jan., 1602. His widow probably died in July, 1603, as the will of Eliz. Perkins of Hillmorton, widow, late wife of John Perkins of Hillmorton, husbandman, was dated June 29th, the inventory dated 11 July, 1603, and the will proved 13th Aug. 1603. She mentions Eliz. Perkins "my sister" in her will.

The only child of John and Elizabeth Perkins was:

22. EDWARD, living 17 December, 1601, and under 21, 24th Nov. 1603.

10. EDWARD PERKYNS, son of (3) Thomas and Alice Perkyms, married 22d July, 1605, Casia Smyth; perhaps, in entering or copying "Sarah" was transformed into "Casia," as he died in 1619, and administration upon his estate was granted 8th October, 1619, to Sarah Perkins, of Hillmorton, "the relict," who was probably the daughter of Richard Smith of Hillmorton, the surety. The inventory, dated 18 Aug., 1619, was £95 17s. 4d.

The children of Edward and Sarah Perkins were:

11. LUKE PERKYNS, son of (3) Thomas and Alice Perkyms, married Aug. 2d, 1621, Marjorie Pur—, died in June, 1638. Will

of Luke Perkins of Hillmorton, yeoman, was dated the 1st and proved the 28th of June, 1638. He mentions "My cozen" Thomas Perkins. No children are named or referred to in the will, which was proved by his widow, Margaret. One of the appraisers of his estate, 19th June, 1638, was John Perkins.

13. THOMAS PERKYNS, son of (3) Thomas and Alice Perkyms, married Oct. 16, 1586, Mary Bate. He was named among the children in his father's will, dated 16th Sept., 1588, and appraiser of the estate, 29th of March, 1592; also as overseer in his brother John's will, 1601-2, and administered upon the same 24th November, 1603, after the death of the widow.

He was also appraiser of Wm. Kebble's estate, 1615, and of his brother Edward's estate, 18th August, 1619.

The will of Thomas Perkins, senior, of Hillmorton, yeoman, was dated 1st Dec., 1629, and proved June 17th, 1630, by his widow, Mary. In his will he mentions "my cozen" Thomas Perkins and my "cozen" John Perkins. Mary, wife of Thomas Perkins, was buried April 2, 1622; he was buried Dec. 7, 1629.

The children of Thomas and Mary Perkins were:

25. ISAAC, eldest son, living 1601; proved his father's will 17th June, 1630; inherited property in Hillmorton, 1630.

26. FRANCIS, second son, baptized —, 1604, unmarried 1st Dec., 1629.

27. EDWARD, third son, baptized in April, 1607; living 1st Dec., 1629; married, Sept. 14, 1637, Alice Harding.

MARY, living, 1601; unmarried 1st Dec., 1629.

ALICE, living, 1603; unmarried 1st Dec., 1629.

14. ISACHE PERKYNS, son of (3) Thomas and Alice Perkyms, was appraiser of his brother Edward's estate, 18th Aug. 1619. Alice, wife of Isaacke Perkyms, was buried June 22, 1603. He probably married a second time, in 1603 or 4, as the baptism of a son is recorded Mar. 23, 1605. Was living as late as 1st Dec. 1629.

The children of Isaacke Perkyms were:

ALICE PERKYNS, baptized —, 1613, and buried Aug. 20th, the same year, might have been a daughter of Isaac.

15. THOMAS PERKYNS, yeoman, son of (8) Henry Perkyms, administered upon his father's estate 5th April, 1609; was appraiser of the estate of Thomas Perkins the elder, of Hillmorton, 29th

March, 1592; also of the estate of Edward Perkins of Hillmorton, 18th Aug. 1619; witnessed the will of Luke Perkins of Hillmorton, 1st June, 1638, and was named as overseer of it, and appraiser of the estate. He was also a witness to the will of Thomas Perkins, senior, of Hillmorton, yeoman, 1st Dec., 1629; also to the will of Edward Perkins of Hillmorton, 31st May, 1643, in which with title of "Mr." he was appointed overseer.

16. JOHN PERKYNs, "son of (8) Henry and Elizabeth Perkyns," was baptized at Hillmorton, 23d Dec., 1583; a marriage is recorded 9 Oct., 1608, of John Perkyns and Judith Gater (probably daughter of Michael Gater, one of the appraisers of the estate of William Perkyns of Hillmorton, 10 April, 1590), and 1st Dec., 1629, Thomas Perkins, senior, brother of (8) Henry of Hillmorton, mentioned in his will my "cozen" (frequently used for "nephew") John Perkins.

These authentic records apparently concern the same person and do not conflict with the theory that the individual named was the New England settler of 1631, but indisputable proof to that effect is lacking.

The obstacle to the acceptance of this theory being the truth is this:

19 June, 1638, the estate of Luke Perkins of Hillmorton was appraised by "Thomas Perkins, John Perkins and Edward Perkins of Hillmorton, yeomen," possibly the three sons of (8) Henry Perkins, and if they were it precludes the possibility of the New England settler being the son of Henry.

There were other representatives of the Hillmorton family named John, whose parentage, antecedents and history are unascertained, and while the known facts here set forth point to Hillmorton as his native place and where he married, additional evidence is needed for satisfactory and indisputable proof that the New England settler belonged to this branch of the family in England.

Possibly some of the facts here cited concern different persons of the same name, but Hillmorton seems to be the best field for further exploitation, as the tentative pedigree here given may eventually prove the true one.

23. EDWARD PERKYNs, yeoman, son of (10) Edward and Sarah Perkyns, was under 21, October, 1619. Was appraiser of the estate of his uncle Luke Perkyns of Hillmorton, 19th June, 1638. His will was dated 31st of May, 1643, and proved by his widow Saray, 30th May, 1643, in which he mentions "my brother" Francis Sarge "and my brother Wm. Bromwich." The inventory of his estate was taken 5th June, 1643, and Jacob Perkins was one of the appraisers; amount £45 16s. 2d.

The child of Edward and Saray Perkyns was:

Perhaps, one born about 29th Sept., 1643.

The following extracts from the original Parish Register of Hillmorton, excepting the first one, which was made by the late Mathew A. Bloxam and taken from his account of the parish of Hillmorton, which appeared in the Rugby Family Almanac, 1873, were made by the rector, the Rev. R.
