INTRODUCTION.

AT the solicitation of my wife whose maiden name was Martha Anna Rowley, the compiler has undertaken to gather a record of the descendants of her ancestors, being Moses Rowley on her father's, and of George Warner on her mother's side, so far as they relate to her immediate relatives.
