John Robinson IV, was a soldier in the Revolutionary war. Was a private in Capt. Nathaniel Carpenter's company, in Col. Thomas Carpenter's regiment. Served at Rhode Island on the Alarm of Dec. 8, 1776. Time of service 16 days. Company marched from Rehoboth, Mass., to Bristol, R. I. Mass. Rev. Rolls. Vol. 1-156. Also enlisted, with rank of Matross, in Capt. Winslow's Co., Col. Crane's regiment. Service from January 6, 1777, to Dec. 31, 1779. Credited to town of Rehoboth, Mass. Reported served 11 months, 25 days as Matross, and 24 months as Bombardier. Vol. 17, part 1, page 81.

Also enlisted with rank of Bombardier, in Capt. Lillie's Co., Col. Crane's regiment. Served from January 1, 1780, to June 20, 1780. Vol. 17, part 2, page 129. Also enlisted as private under Lieut. Samuel Brown's Co., Col. Thomas Carpenter's regiment, for service at Rhode Island on the Alarm of Aug. 1, 1780. Time of discharge Aug. 8, 1780. Time of service 8 days, company marched from Rehoboth, Mass., to Tiverton, R. I., and there did duty under General Heath. Massachusetts Rev-

Darius Robinson, brother of Cyrus, has left this on record, to wit: "My father removed to New Hampshire in 1776 or 1777, into the town of Winchester. We lived on a hill known in that vicinity as 'Pudding Hill.' We lived there about 14 years. In 1791 my father moved into York state, in the county of Otsego, Schuyler patent. He bought 600 acres of land, lot 6, for 9 shillings per acre."
